Clare has a wealth of natural resources, geographic advantages and infrastructural pluses which distinguish it from its competitors and enhances its competitiveness.

Considerable scope for further development of its strategic assets exists and Clare County Council is working with many public and private organisations to make progress in a number of priority areas.

Transhipment

The proximity to global shipping lanes and the large European market makes the estuary an ideal location for manufacturing and value-enhancing activities.

The Shannon Estuary itself forms the largest estuarine complex in Europe covering an area of 500km2 of navigable water and extending for 100km from Limerick City to Loop Head in County Clare. The estuary is Ireland's premier deepwater port, routinely catering for ships up to 200,000 deadweight tonnage, while Shannon International Airport has a dedicated fuel terminal.



Green Energy

Wind

Wind speeds in County Clare are excellent by international standards. Onshore wind speeds of up to 9.5m/s onshore and 11m/s offshore on 75m turbines and up to 11m/s onshore and 13m/s offshore on 100m turbine.

Wave

Wave technology resources have been identified as over 25,000 MW of which 12,000 MW could be harnessed and brought ashore. Clare has been identified as one of the best locations for future test sites. One of Ireland's best tidal energy resources is located in the Shannon Estuary - the resource potential is 110 GWh per annum over three locations in the estuary.
