## 1.0 Introduction

This socio-economic evidence base for County Clare provides a profile of the County taking an approach that is inter-generational (1981-2011), gender-based (Female/Male) and spatial (County, Municipal District and Electoral Division). While generally drawing on Census of Population Data, the most recent point-in-time data, (e.g. Live Register) is also presented. A number of topics are examined using this approach, namely, Population, Employment/Economy, Education, Poverty Reduction and Energy.

Diagram 2.1.1. Clare Population Trends 1981 -2011

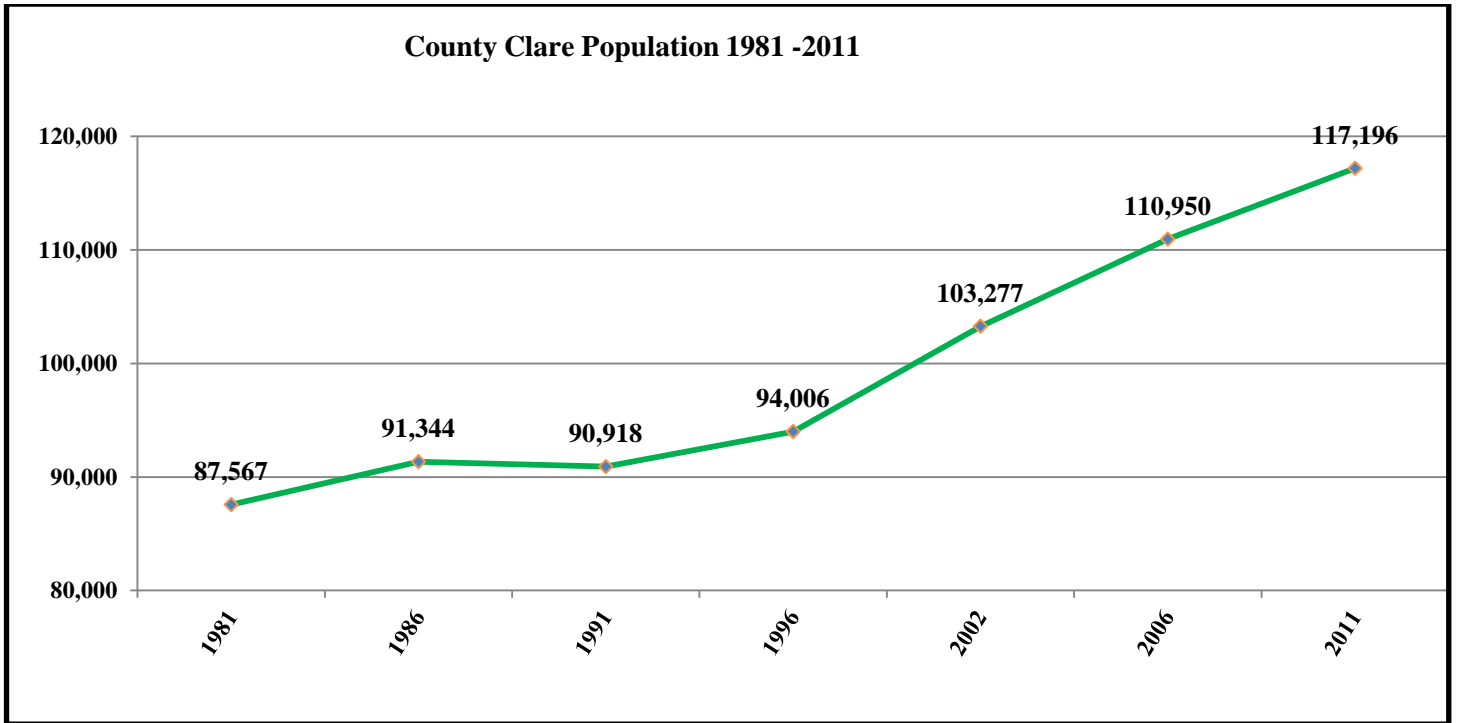


Diagram 2.1.2. Trends in Population in Ireland and Clare 1981 - 2011

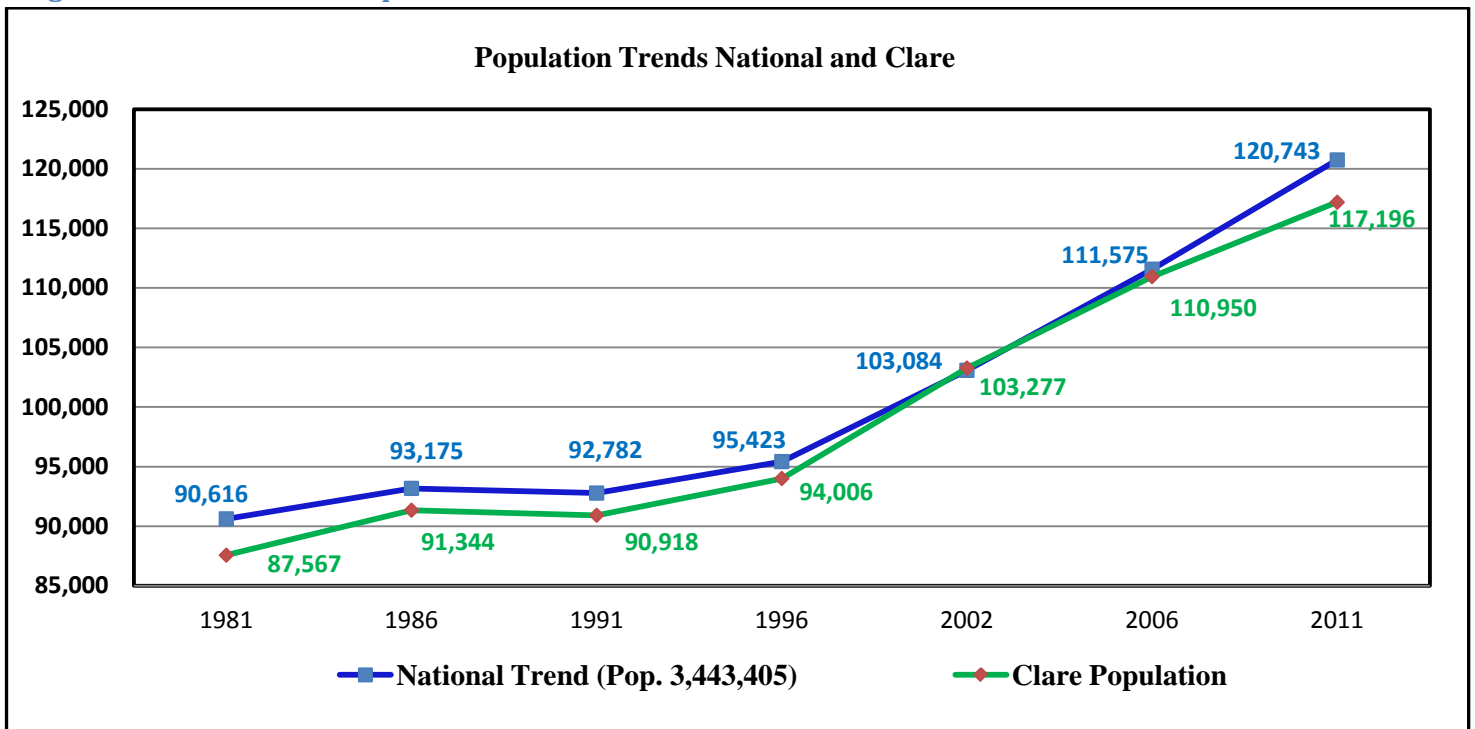


Diagram 2.1.3. Clare Inter-censal Change in Population

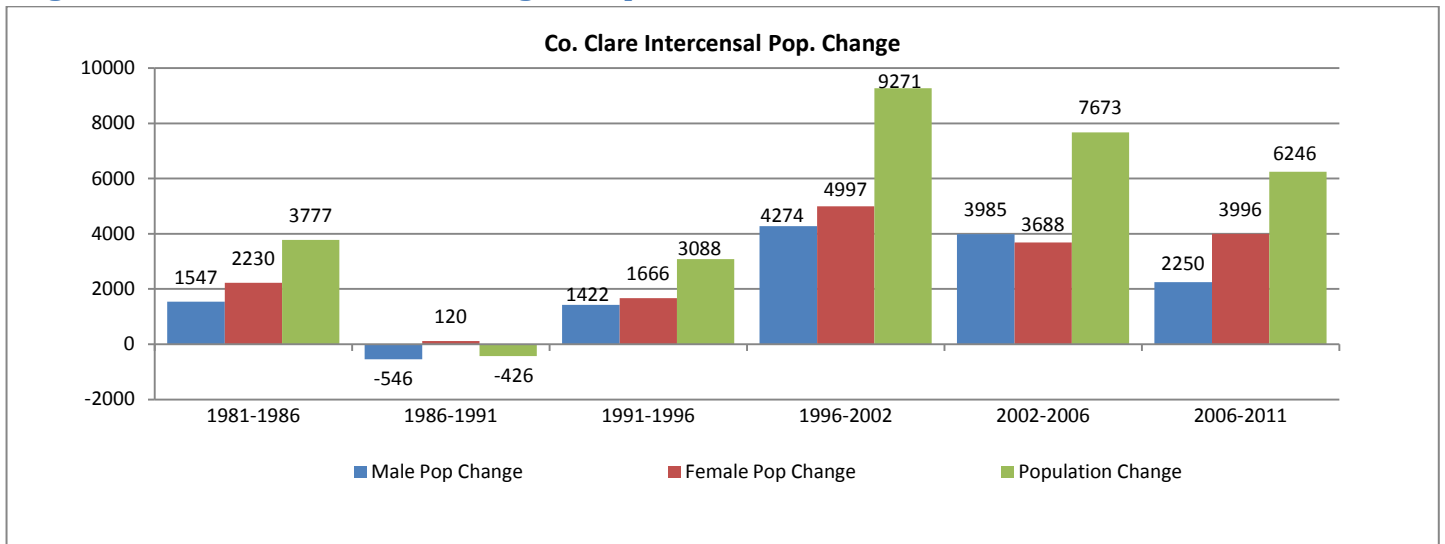


Diagram 2.1.4. Clare Population Trends Male & Female 1981 - 2011

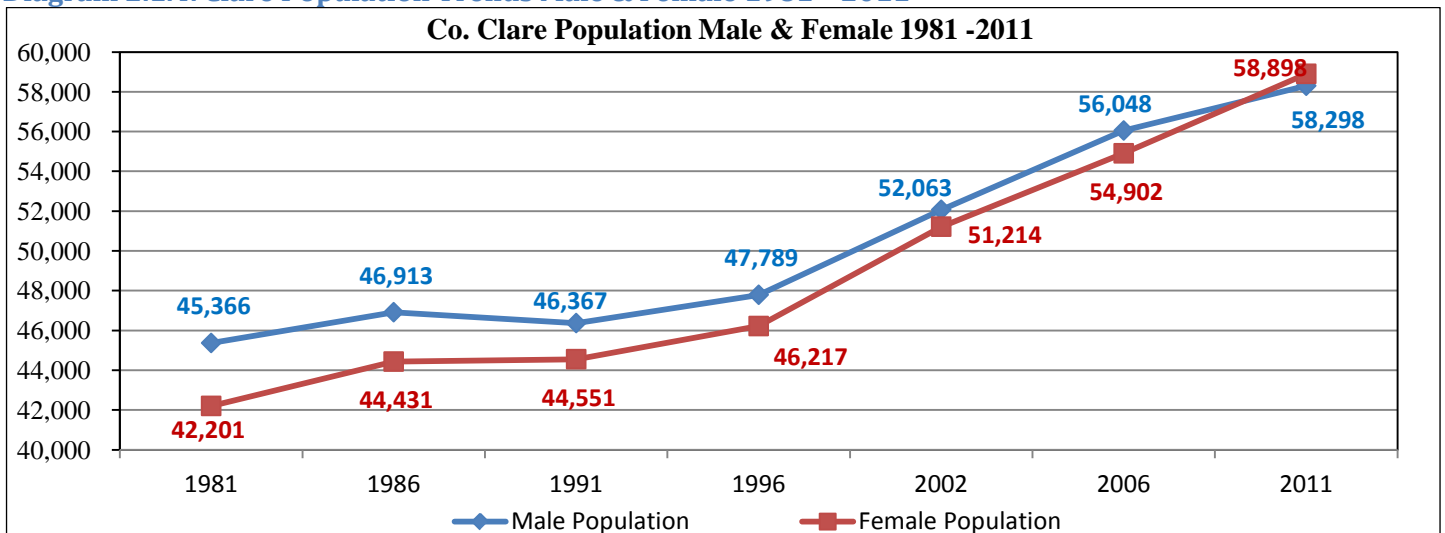
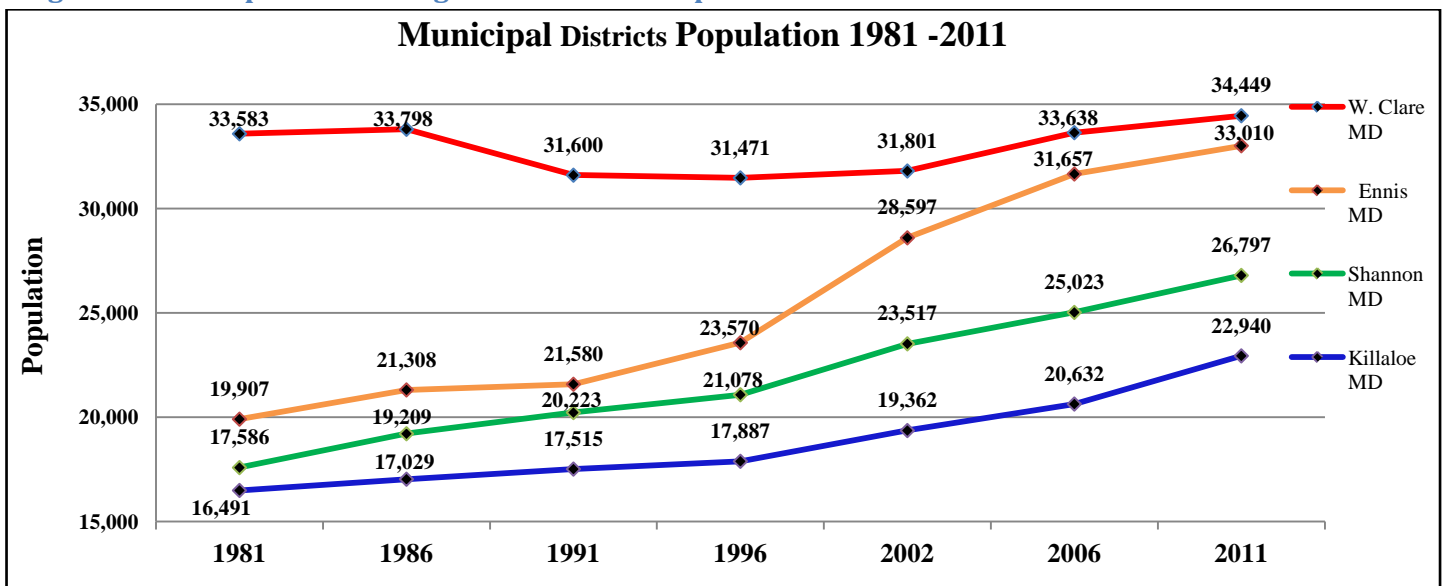
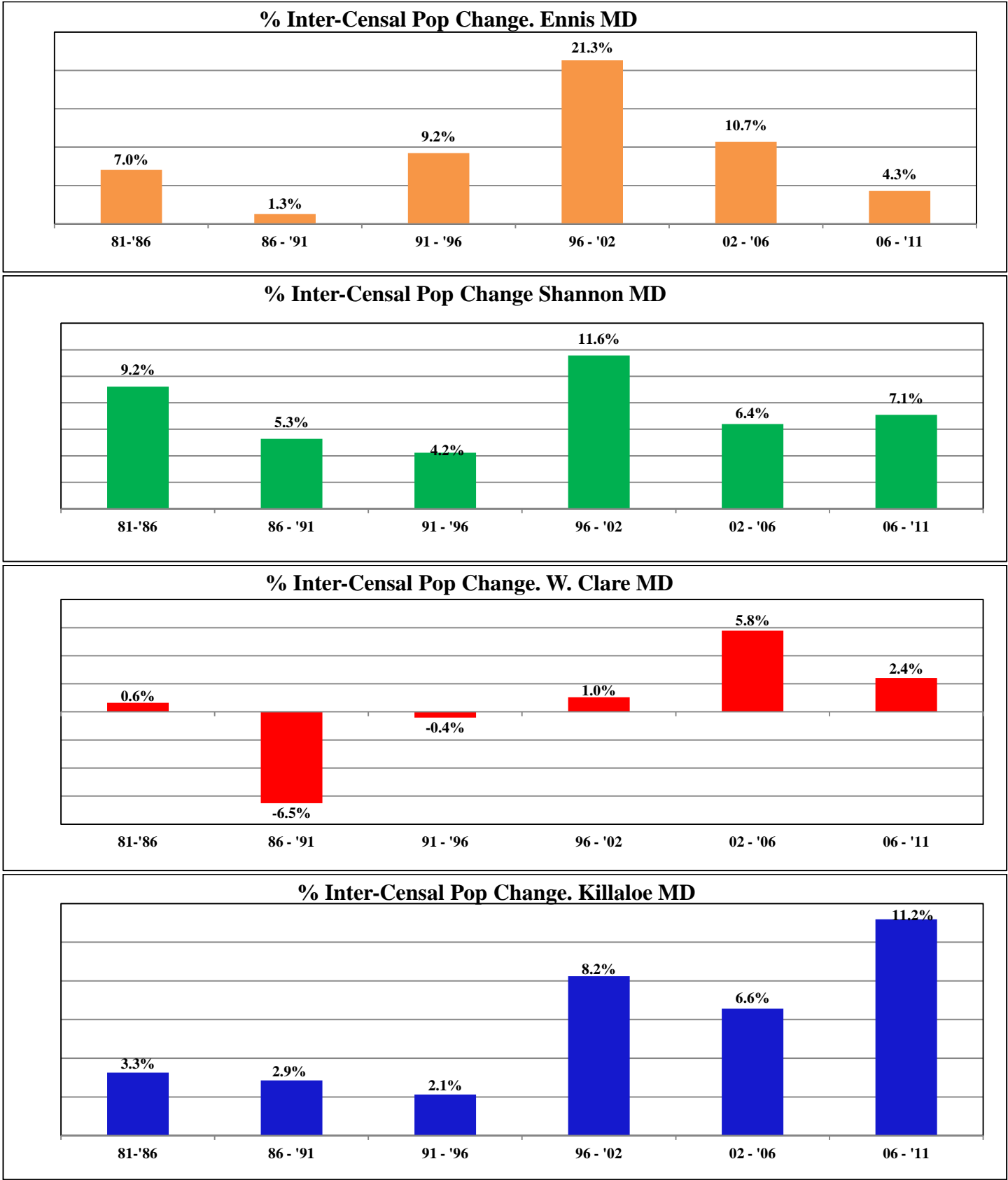


Diagram 2.1.5. Population Change in Clare's Municipal Districts 1981 - 2011



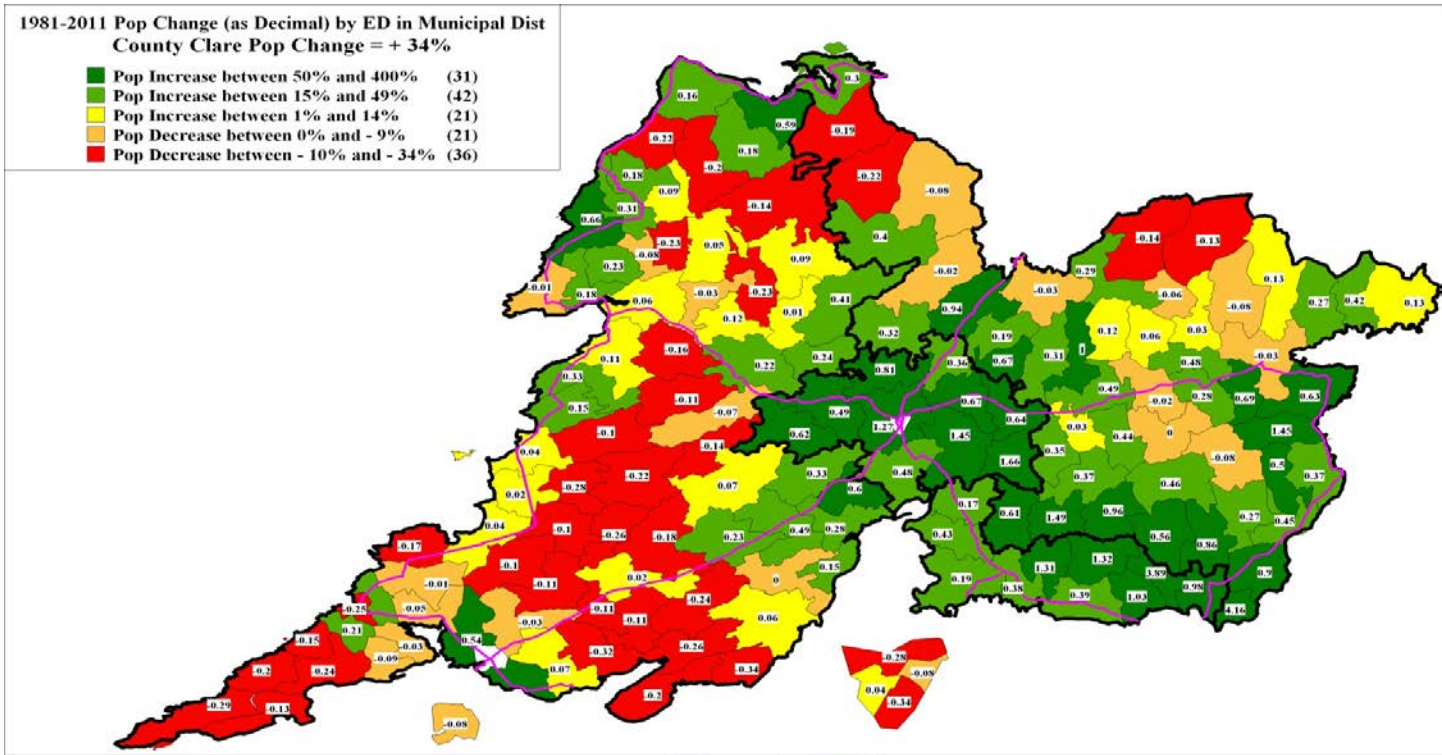
Diagrams 2.1.6. Percentage Population Change in Municipal Districts 1981 - 2011



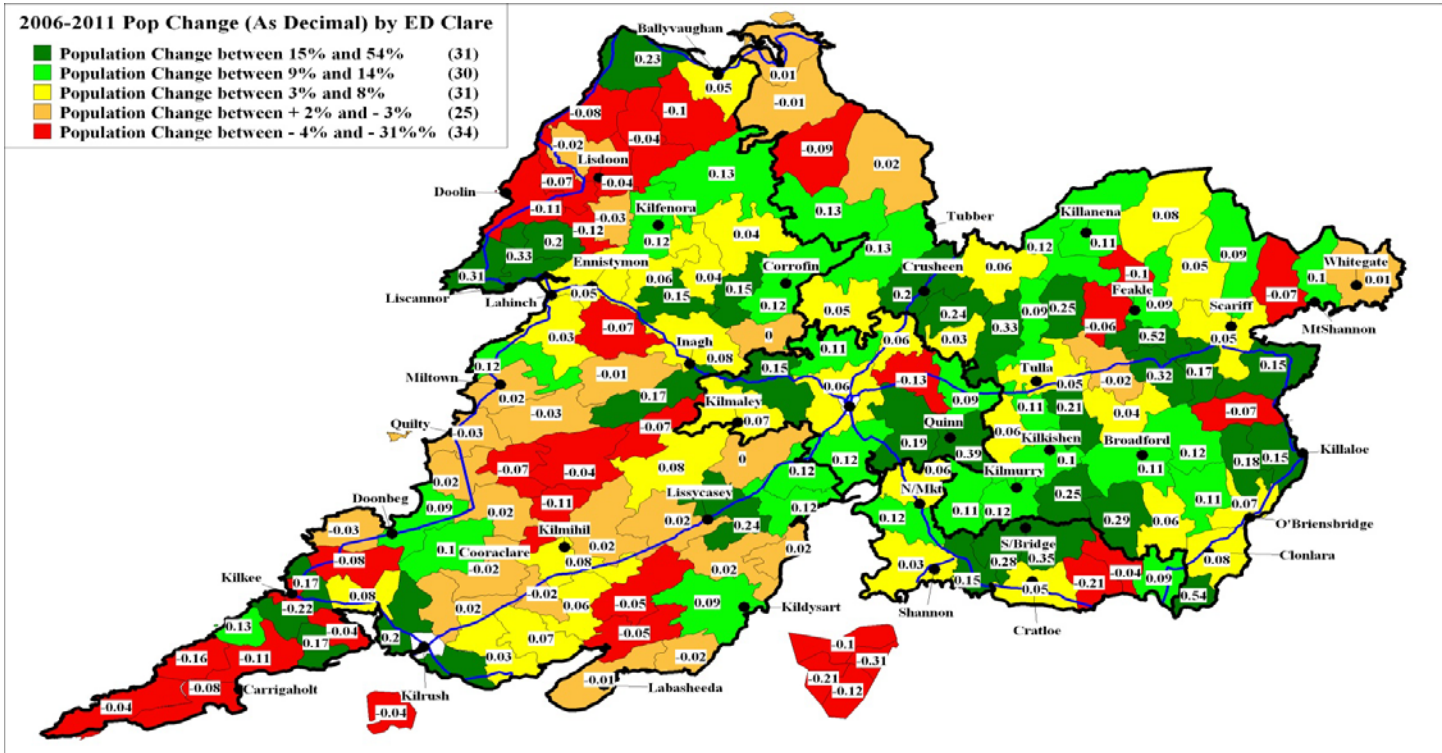

Map 2.1.2. Population Change 2006 – 2011 by Electoral Division (ED)





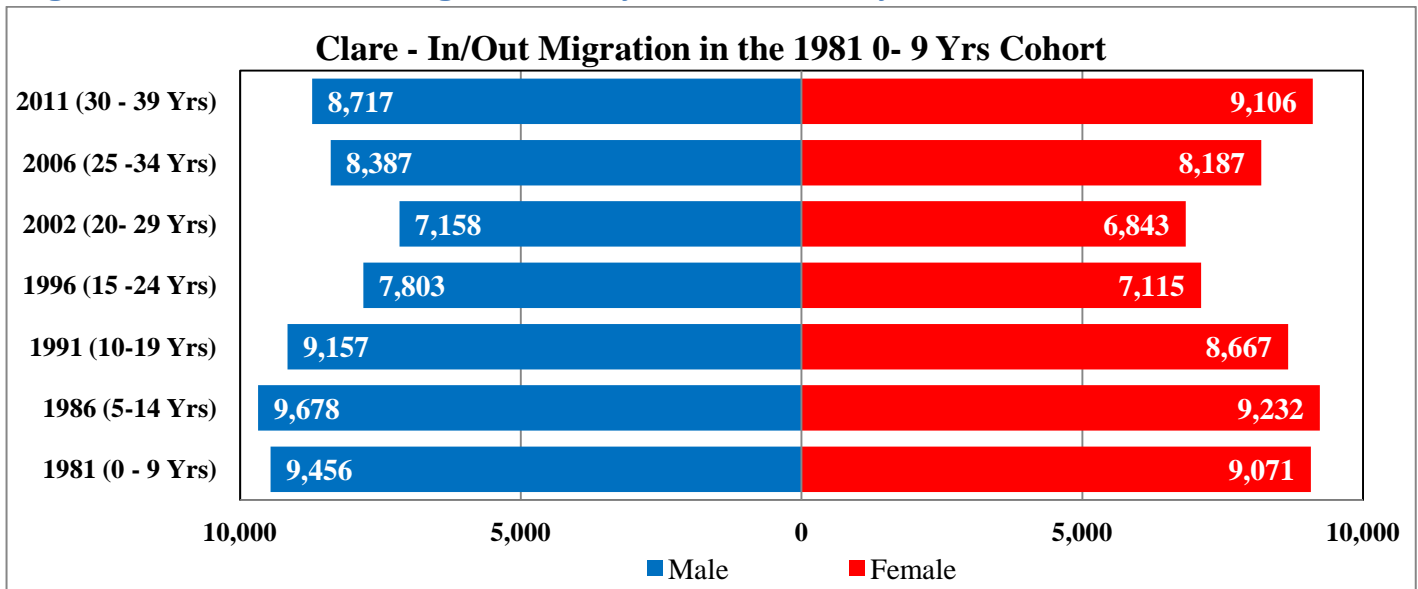
### Map 2.2.1 Population Density (People per Ha.) 2011 by Electoral Division (ED)

Diagram 2.3.3. Clare In/Out Migration of the Working Age Population 1996 - 2011

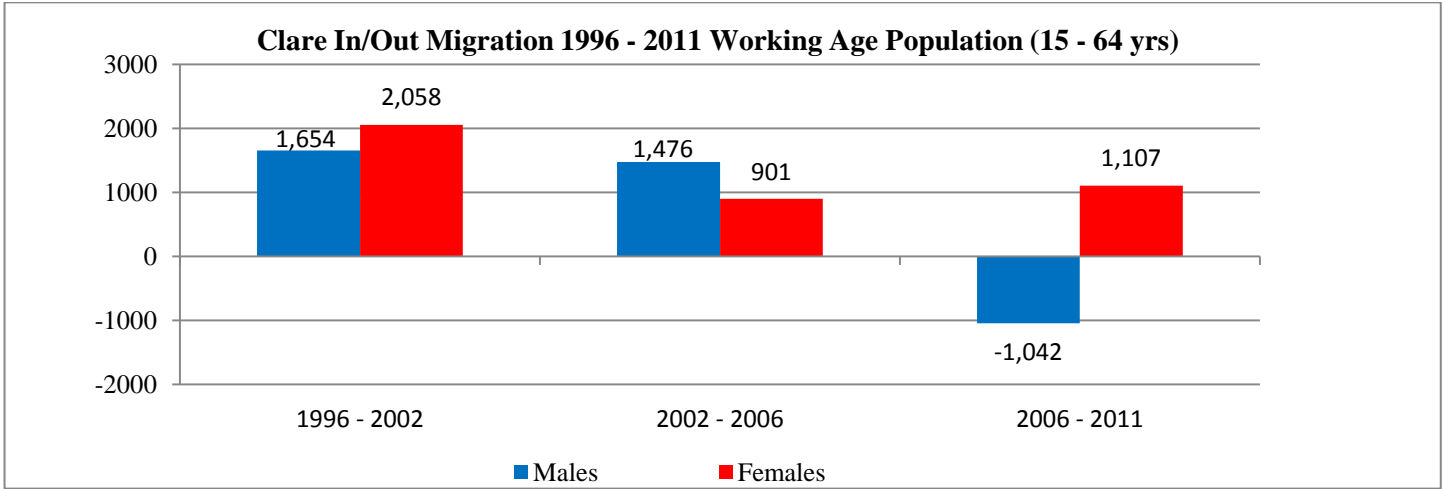
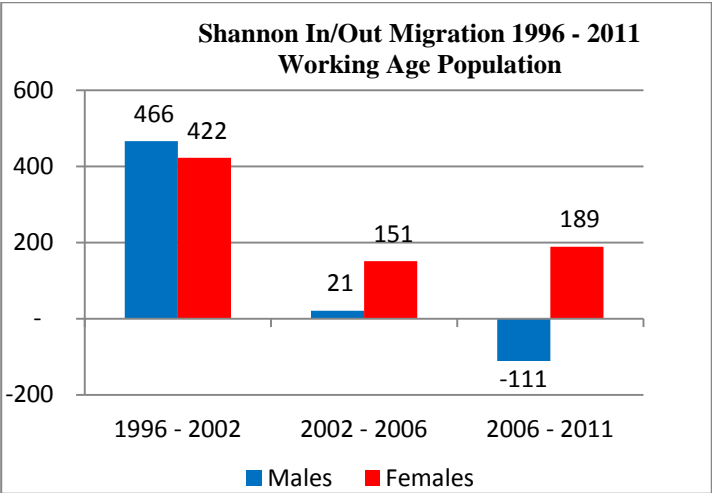
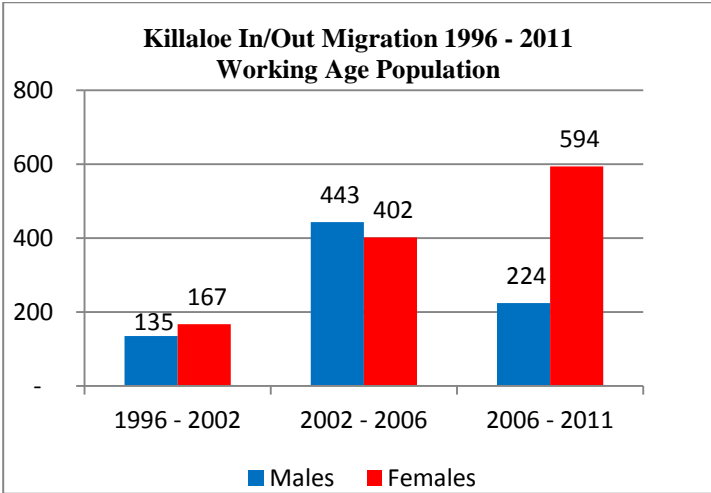
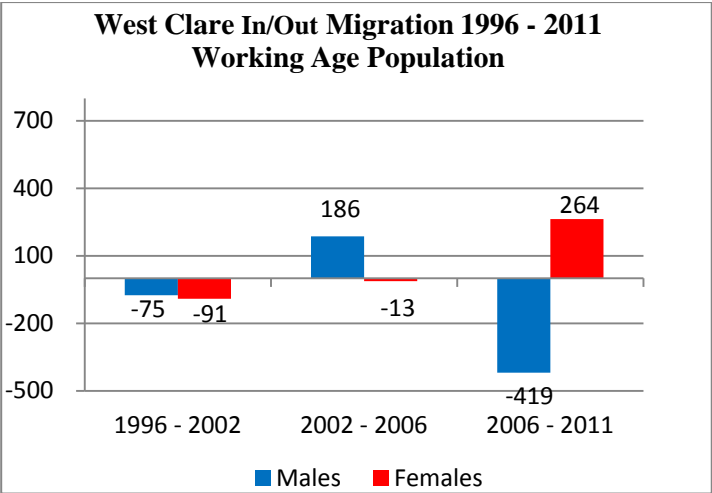
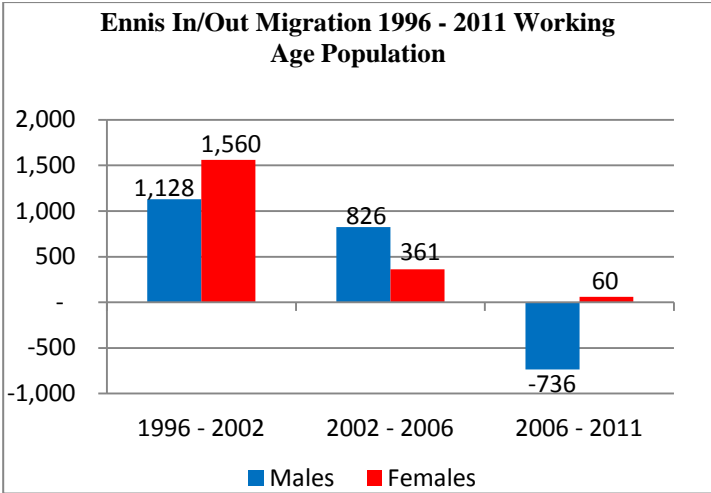


Diagram 2.3.4. Clare MD s In/Out Migration of the Working Age Population 1996 - 2011

Diagram 2.4.1. 2011 % Population Pyramid of Co. Clare by 5-year age groups and by Sex

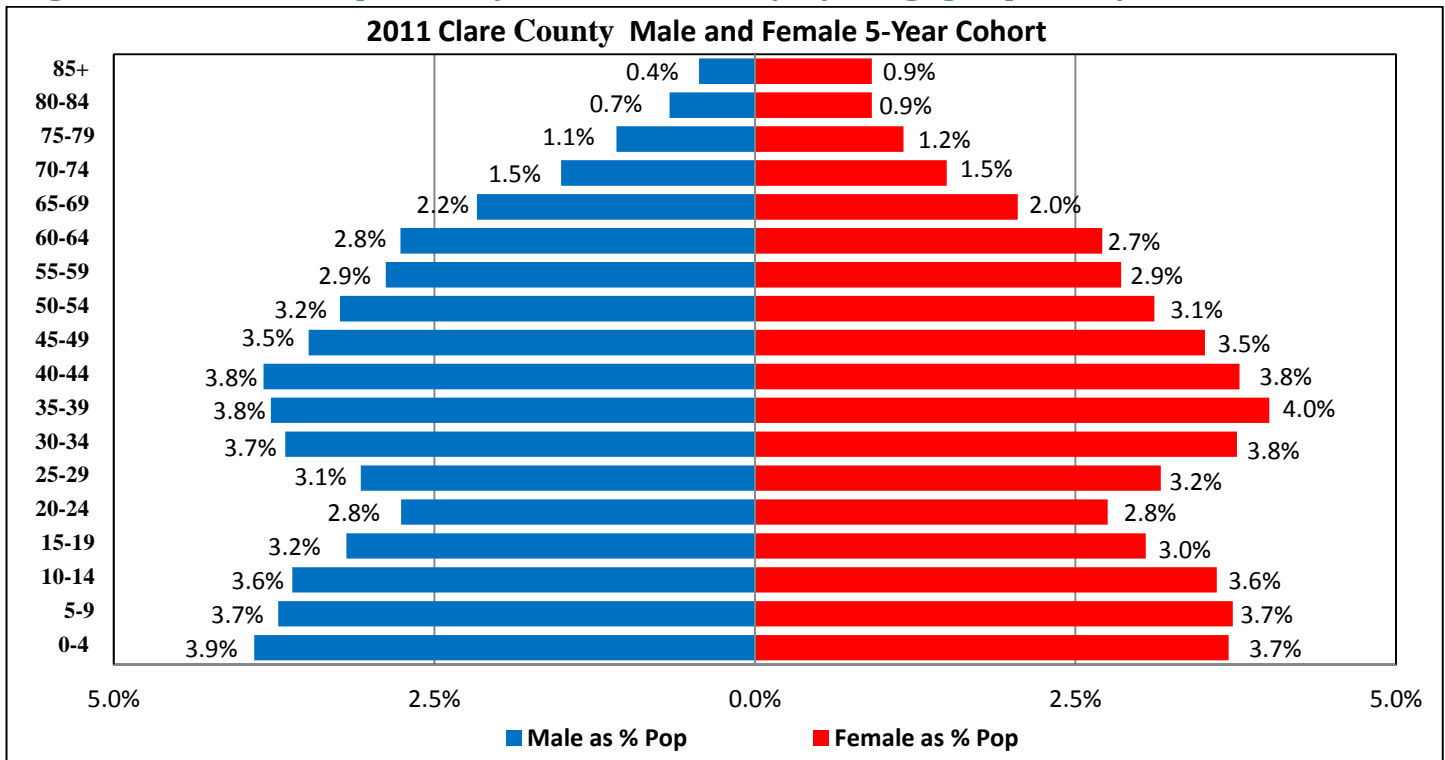
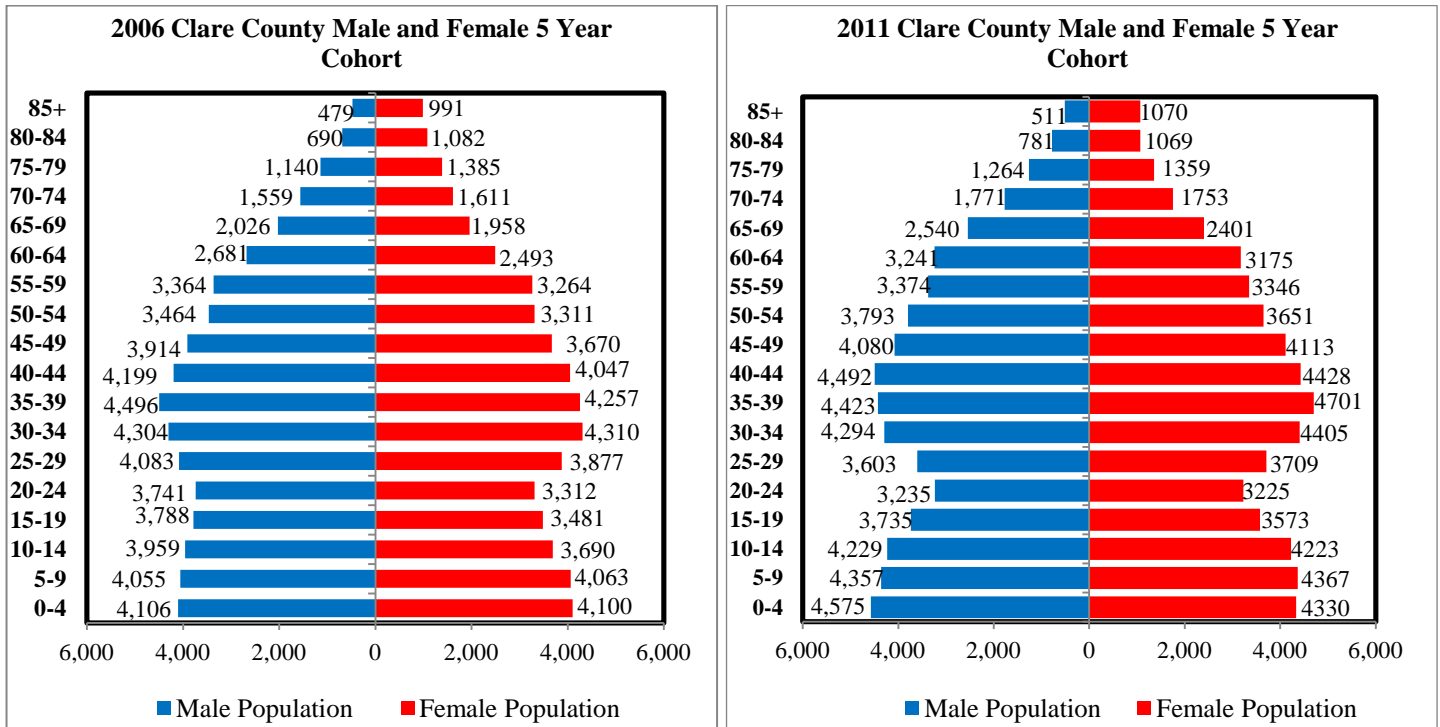


Diagram 2.4.2 2006/2011 Comparison of Population of Co. Clare by 5-year age groups and by Sex

Diagram 2.5.1. 2011 Population Pyramid of Ennis MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

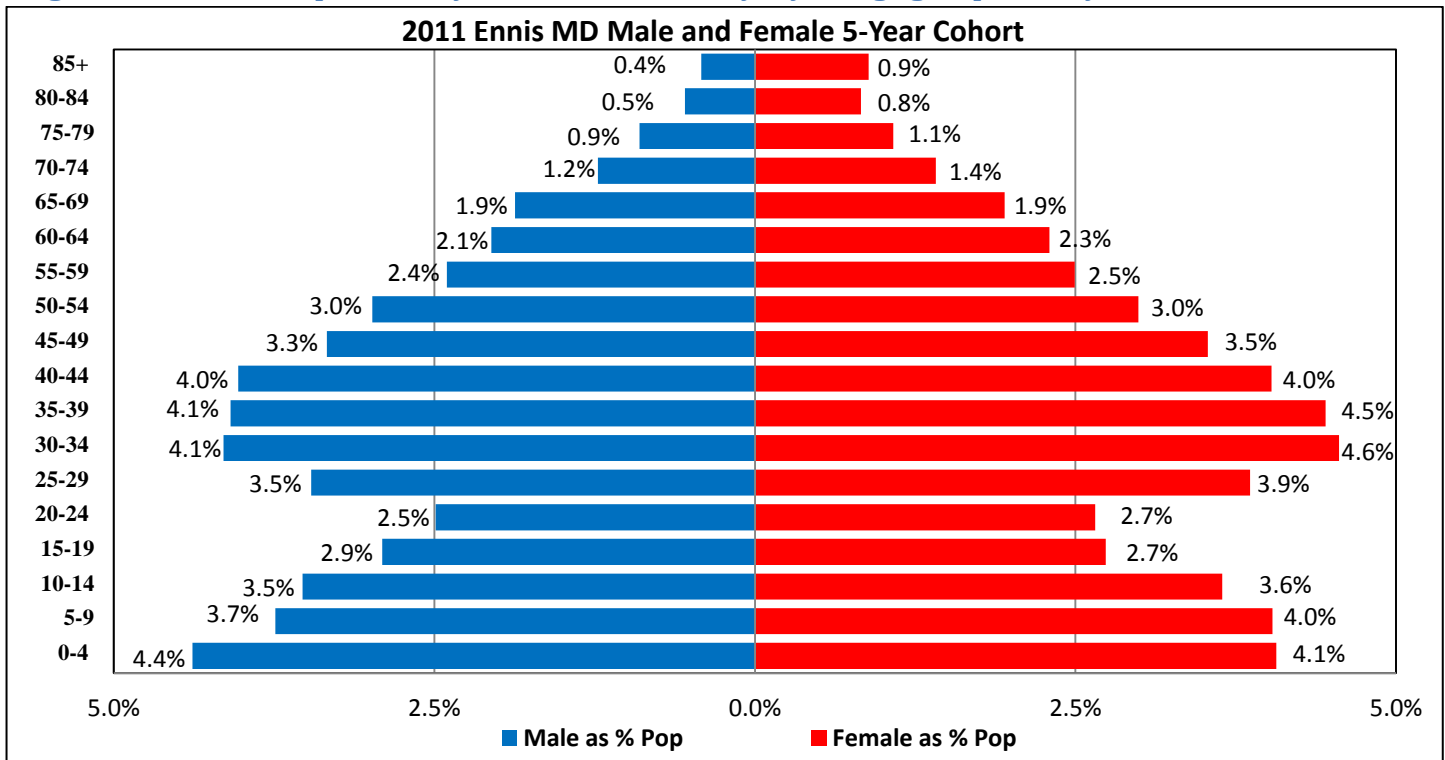


Diagram 2.5.2. 2006/2011 Comparison of Population Ennis MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

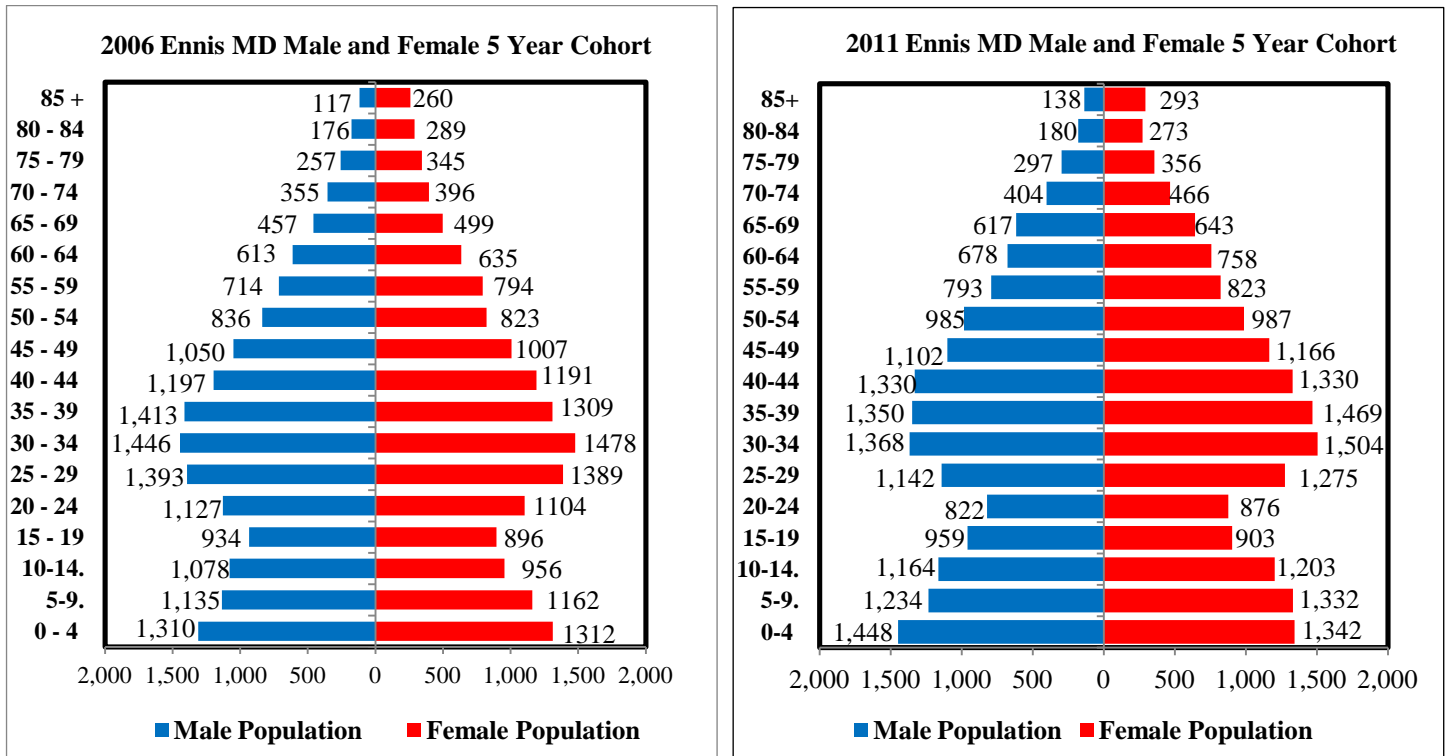


Diagram 2.5.3 2011 Population Pyramid of Shannon MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

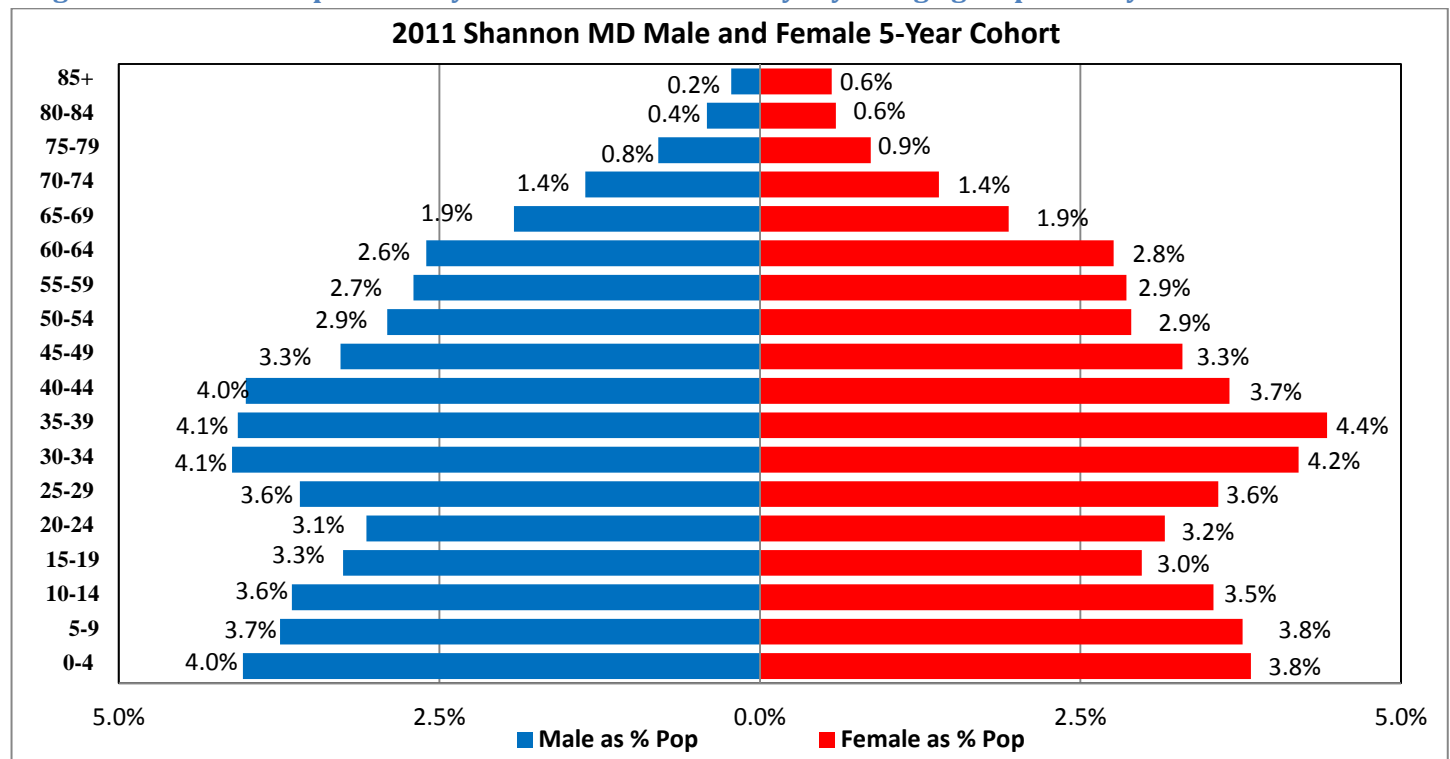


Diagram 2.5.4. 2006/2011 Comparison of Population Shannon MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

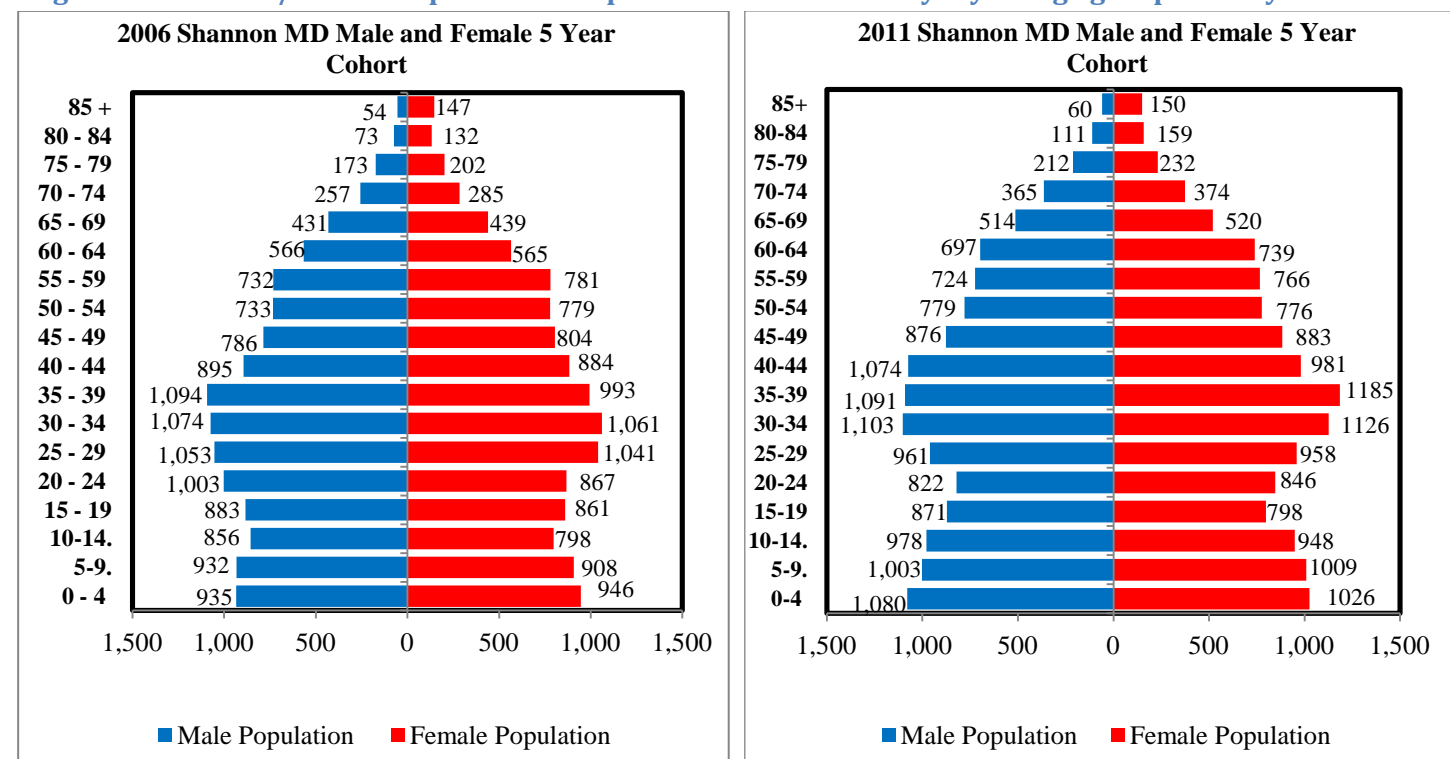


Diagram 2.5.5. 2011 Population Pyramid of Killaloe MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

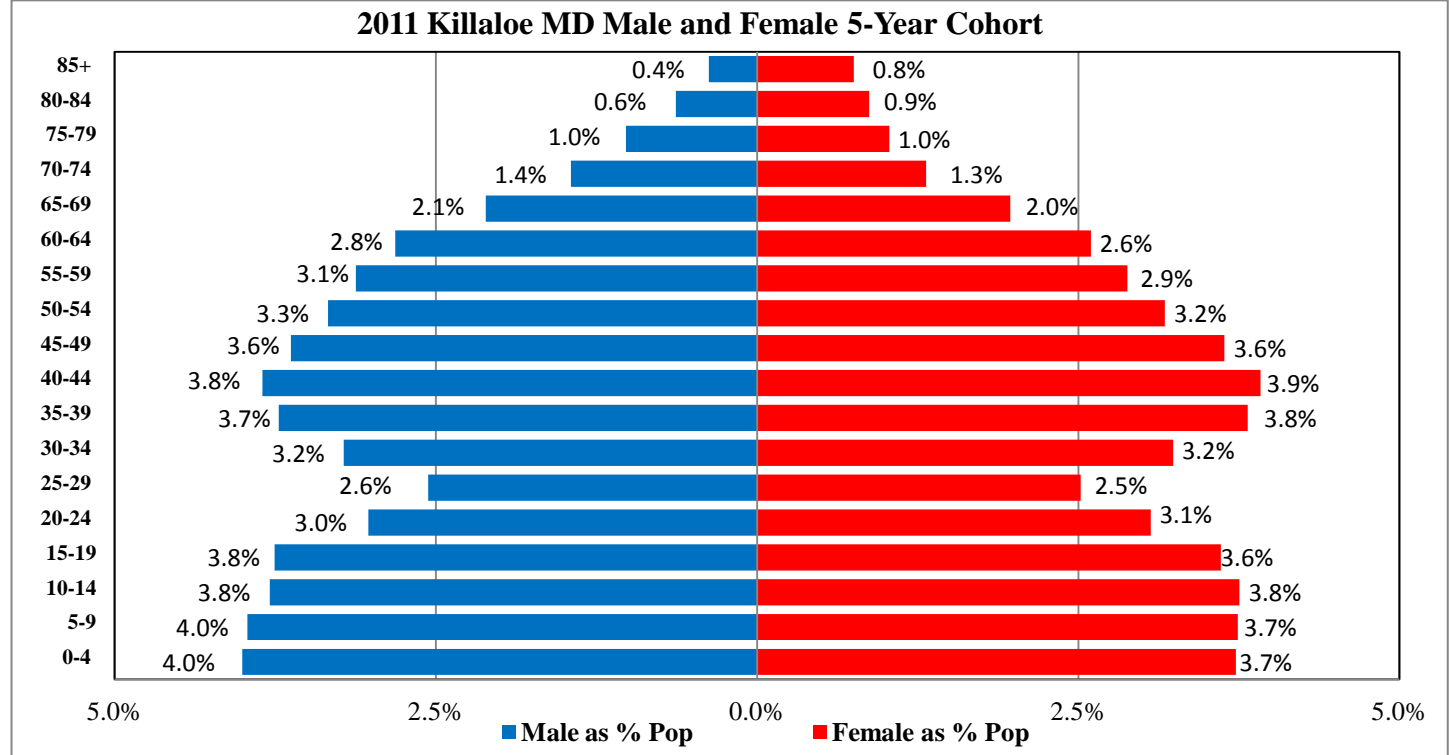


Diagram 2.5.6 2006/2011 Comparison of Population Killaloe MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

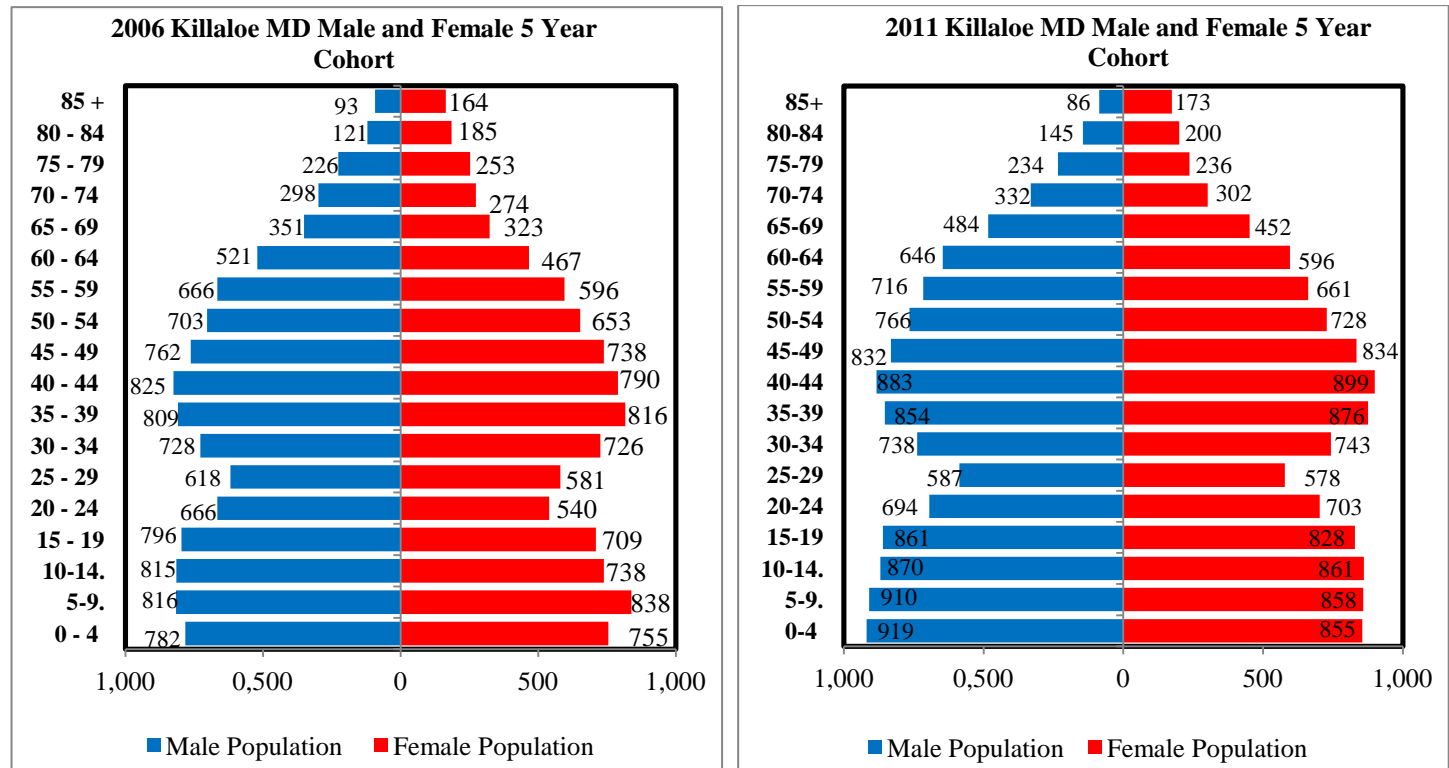


Diagram 2.5.7. 2011 Population Pyramid of W. Clare MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

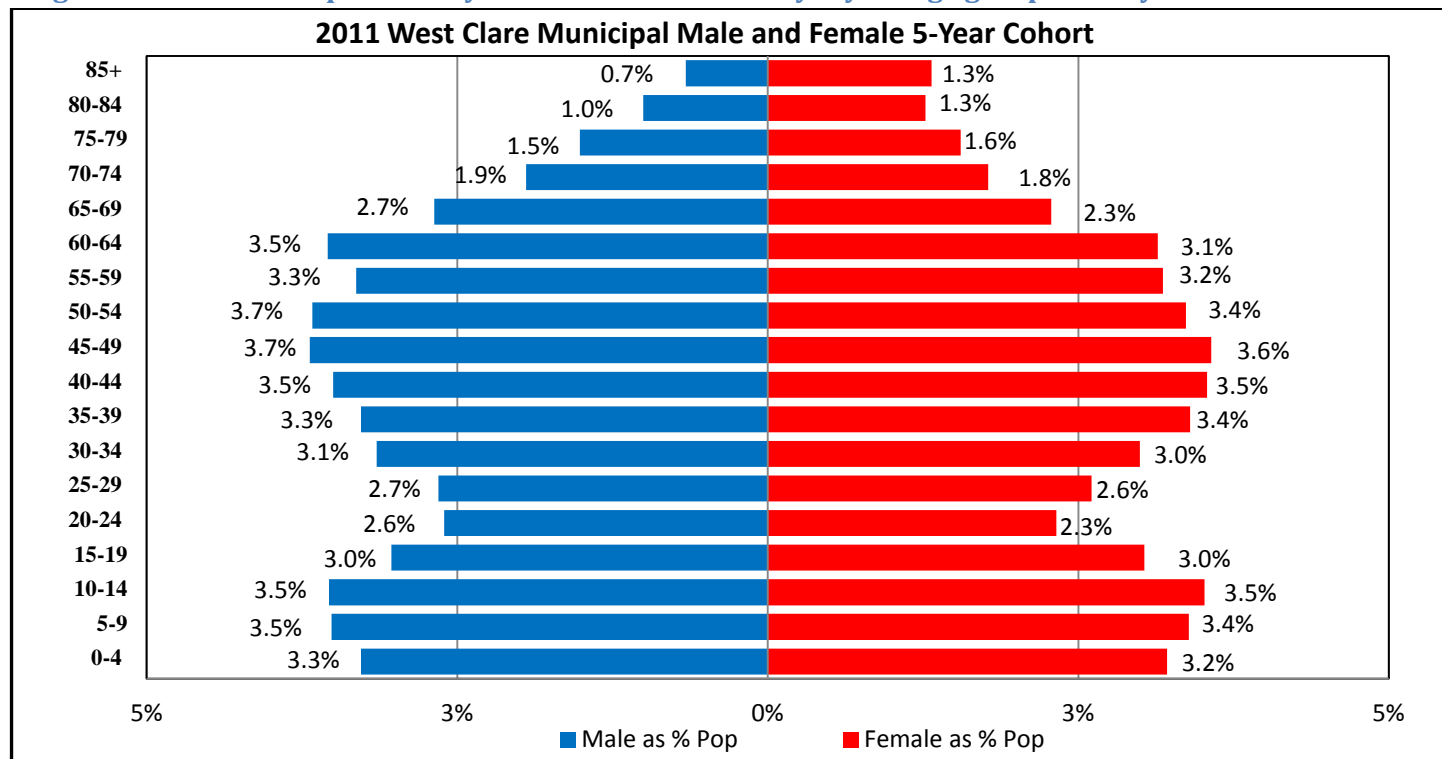
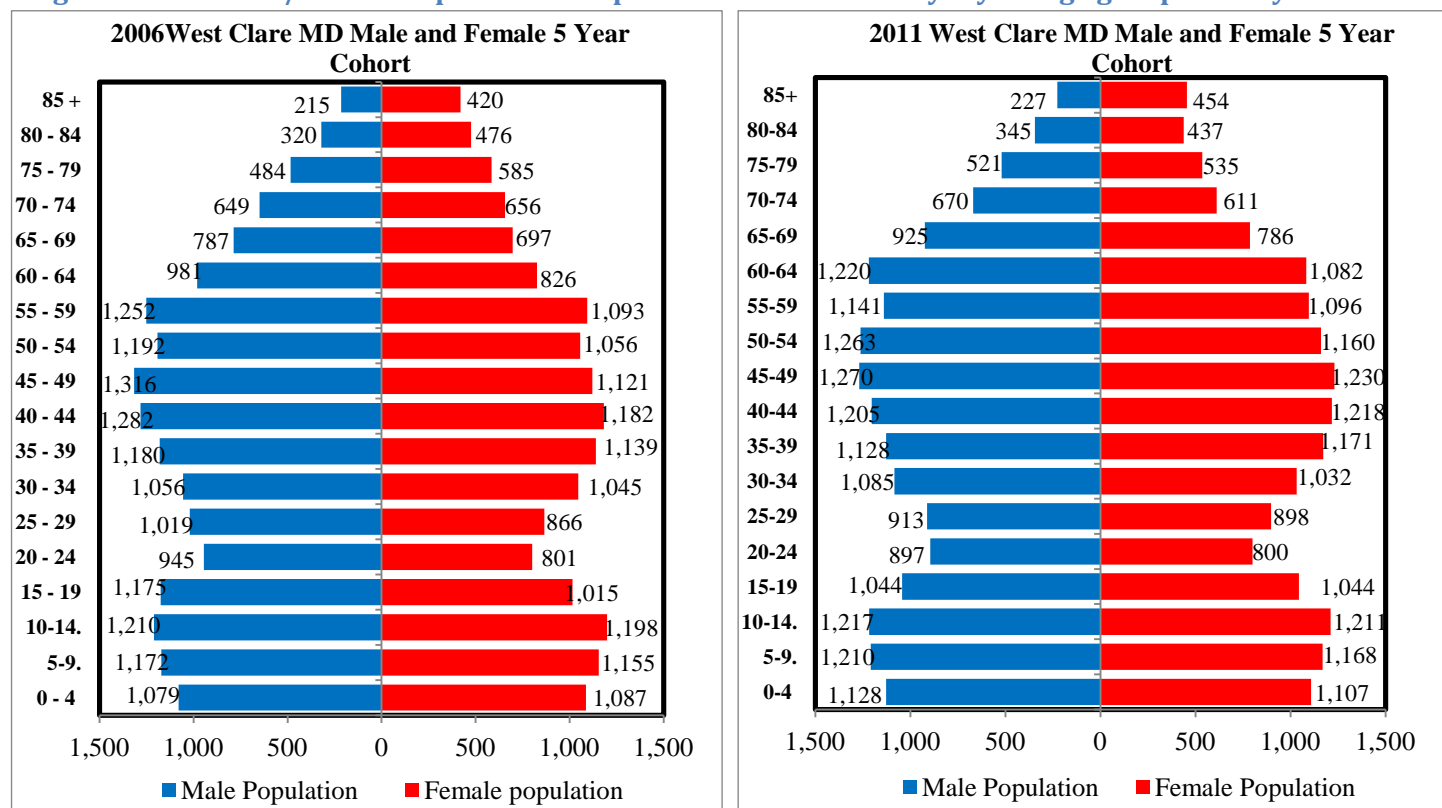


Diagram 2.5.8. 2006/2011 Comparison of Population W. Clare MD by 5-year age groups and by Sex

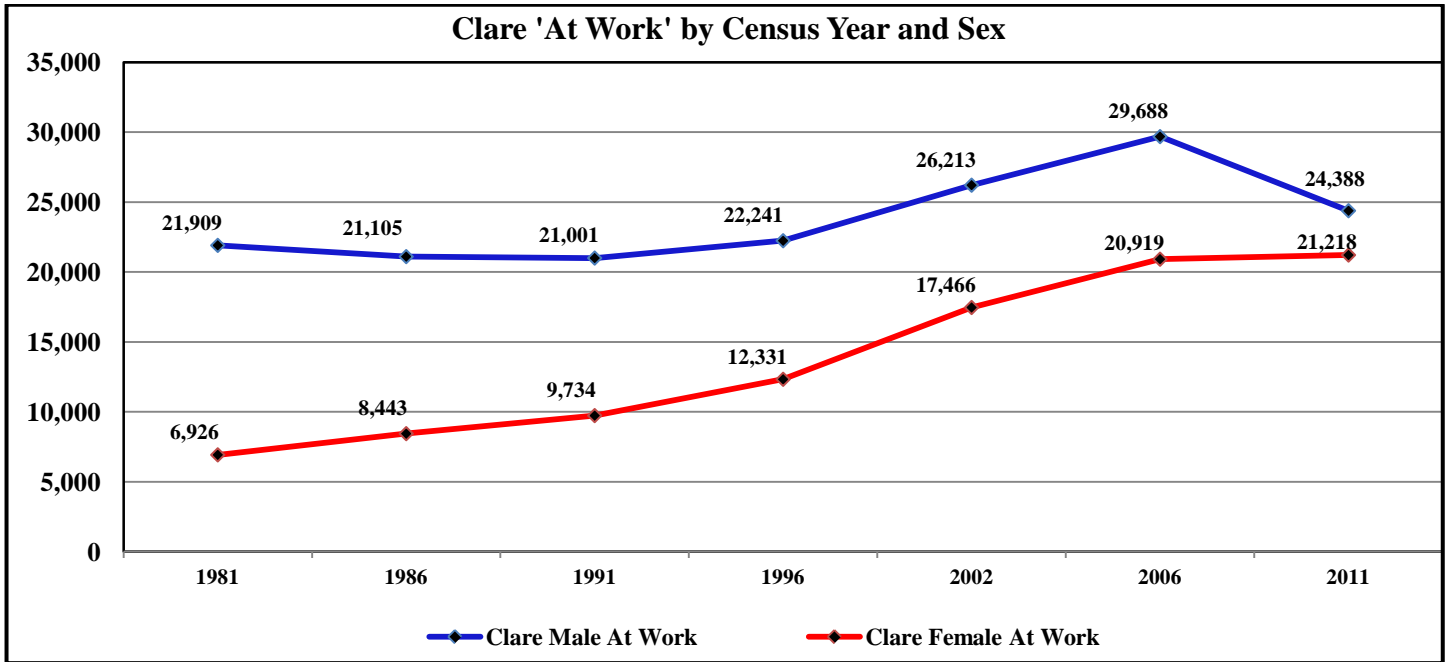




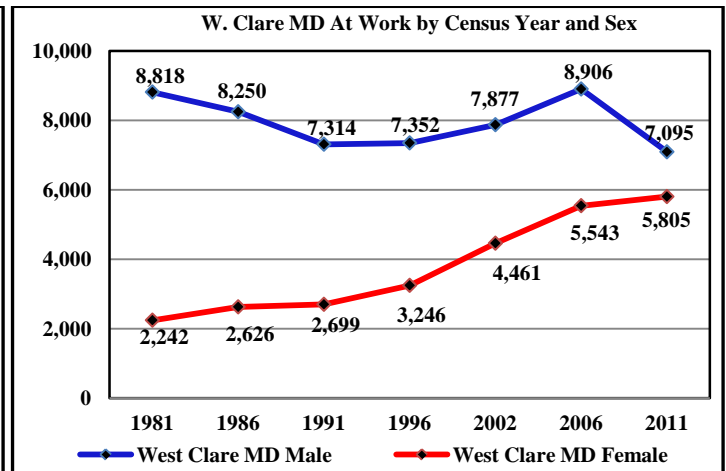
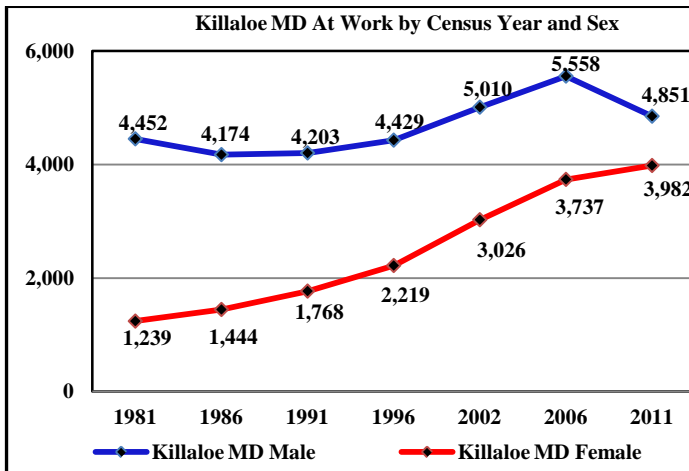
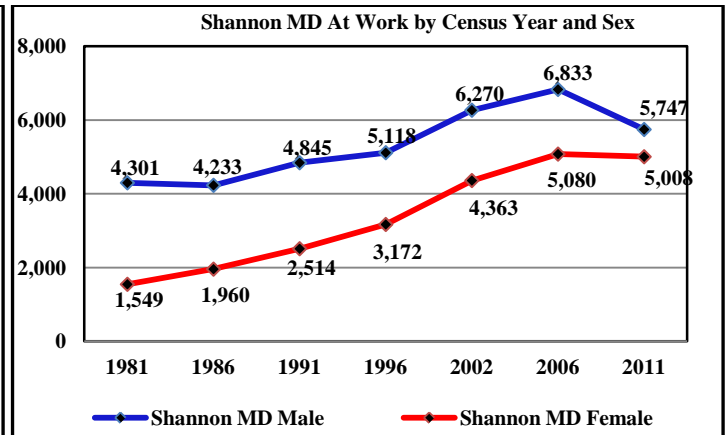
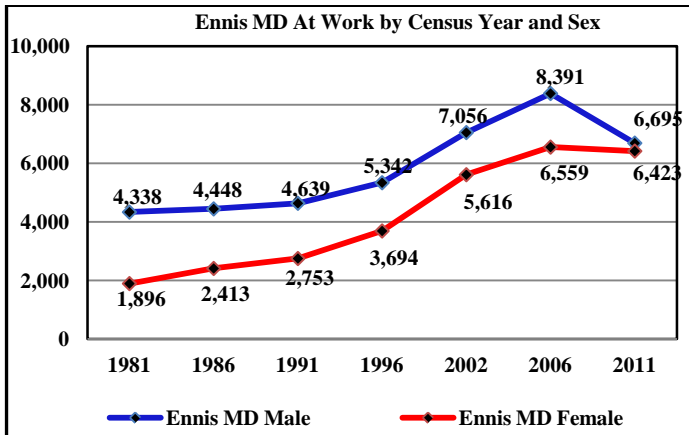

Diagram 3.3.1. Clare Employment Rates 2011 by Sex (Census Population)

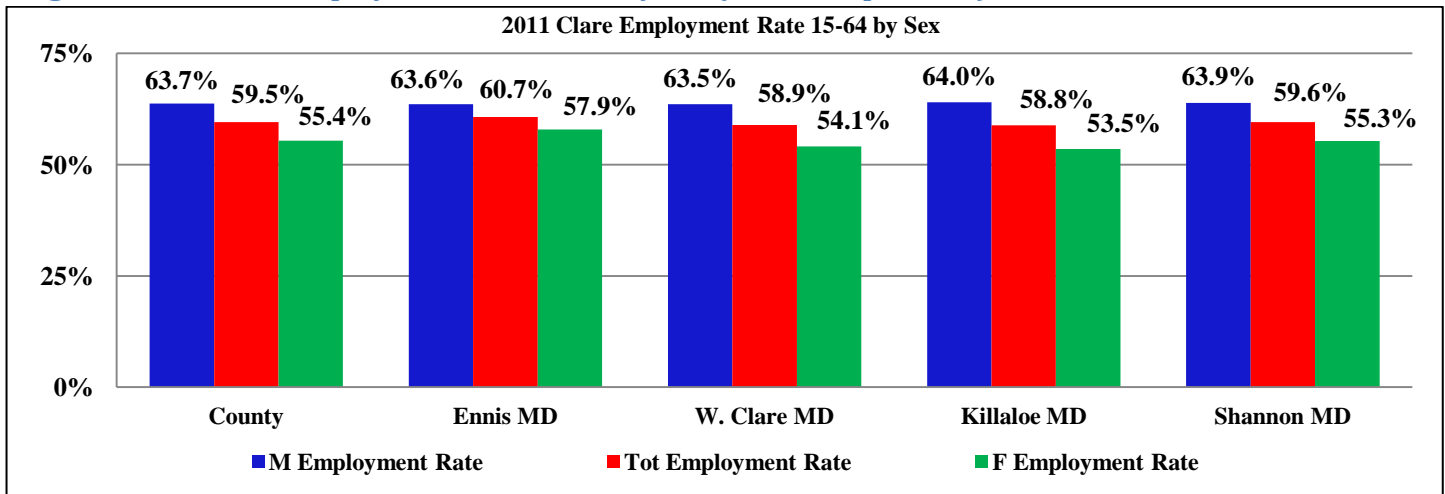


Diagram 3.3.2. National Employment Rates 1998 - 2014 by Sex (QNHS)

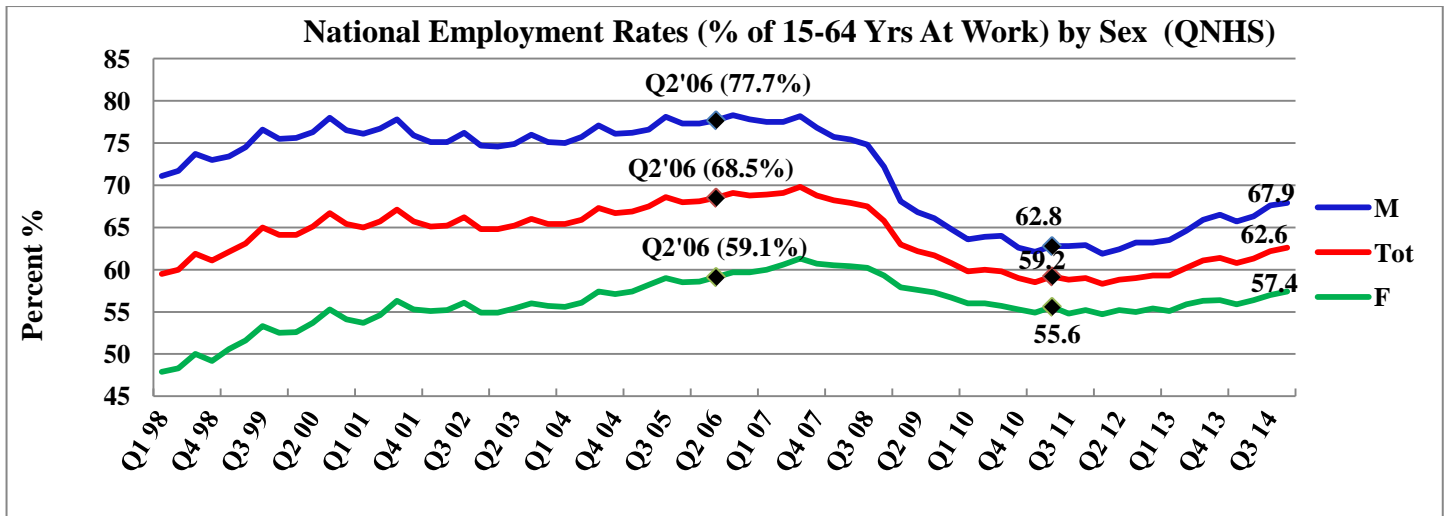
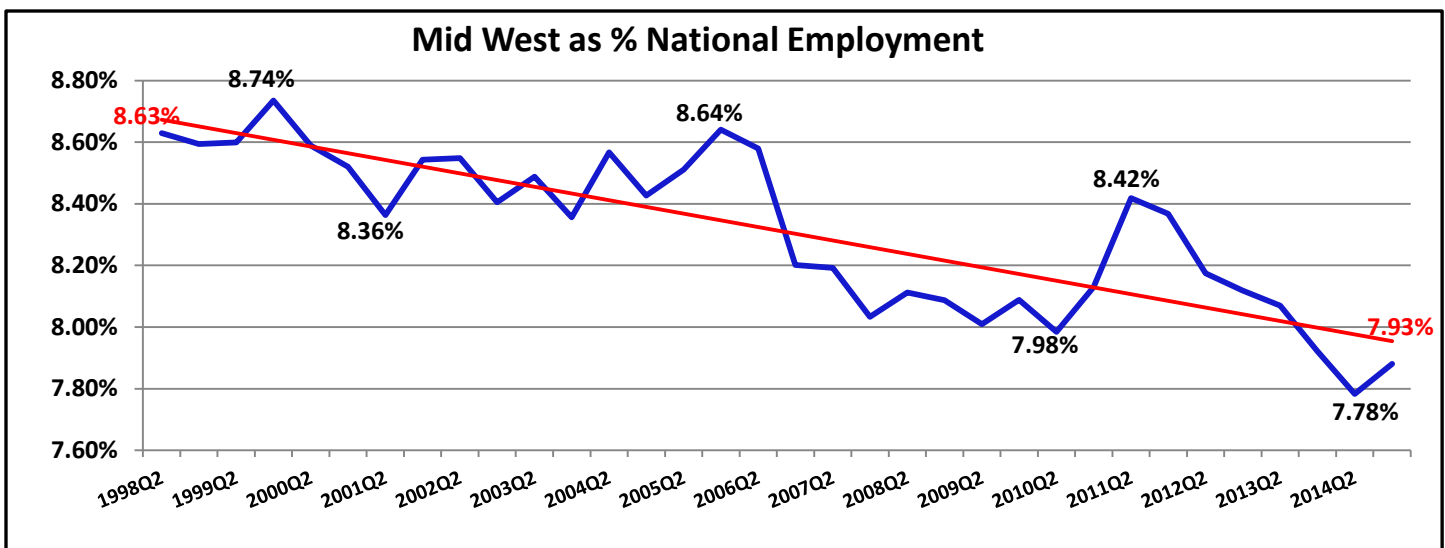


Diagram 3.3.3. Mid West Employment as % National Employment (1998 - 2014) (QNHS)

Diagram 3.4.1. Clare Workforce by Age and Sex as % Total Workforce - 1981

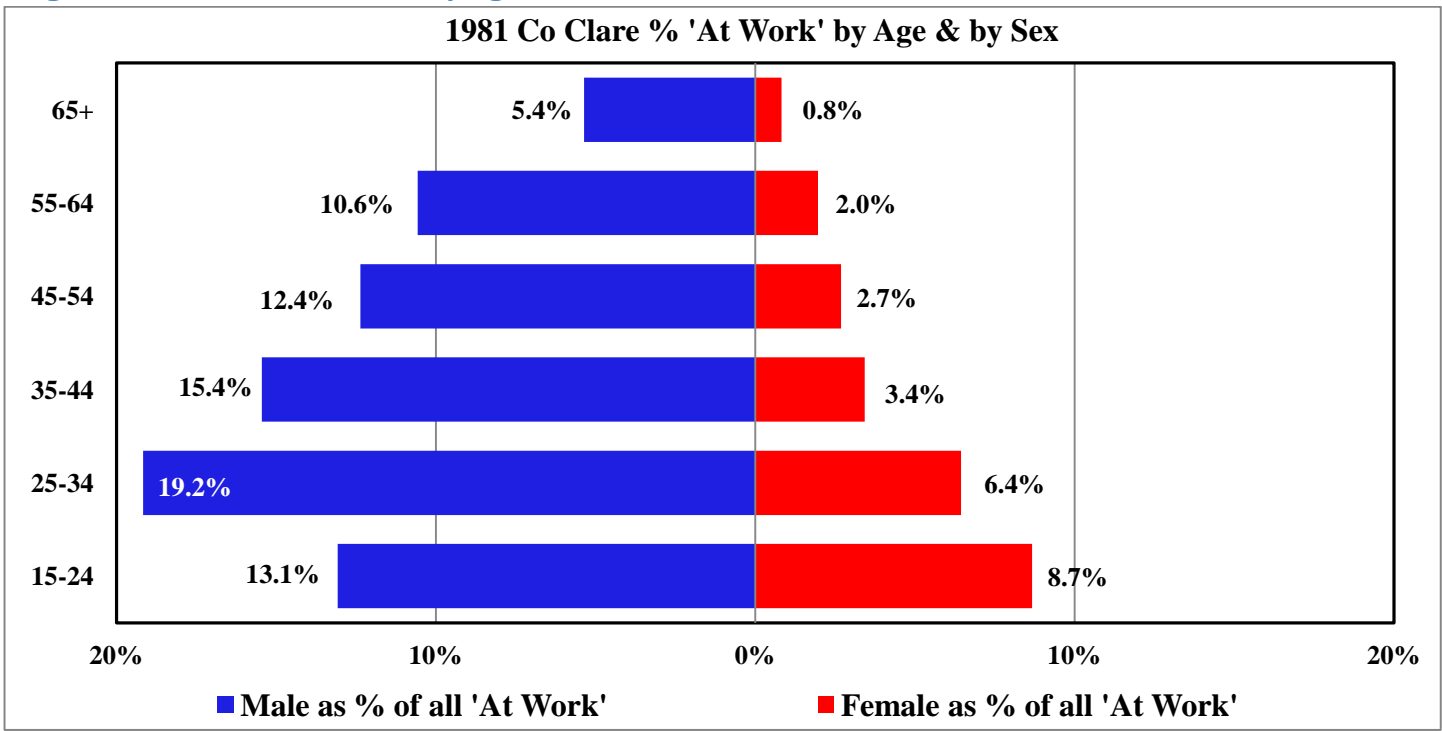


Diagram 3.4.2. Clare Workforce by Age and Sex as % Total Workforce - 2011

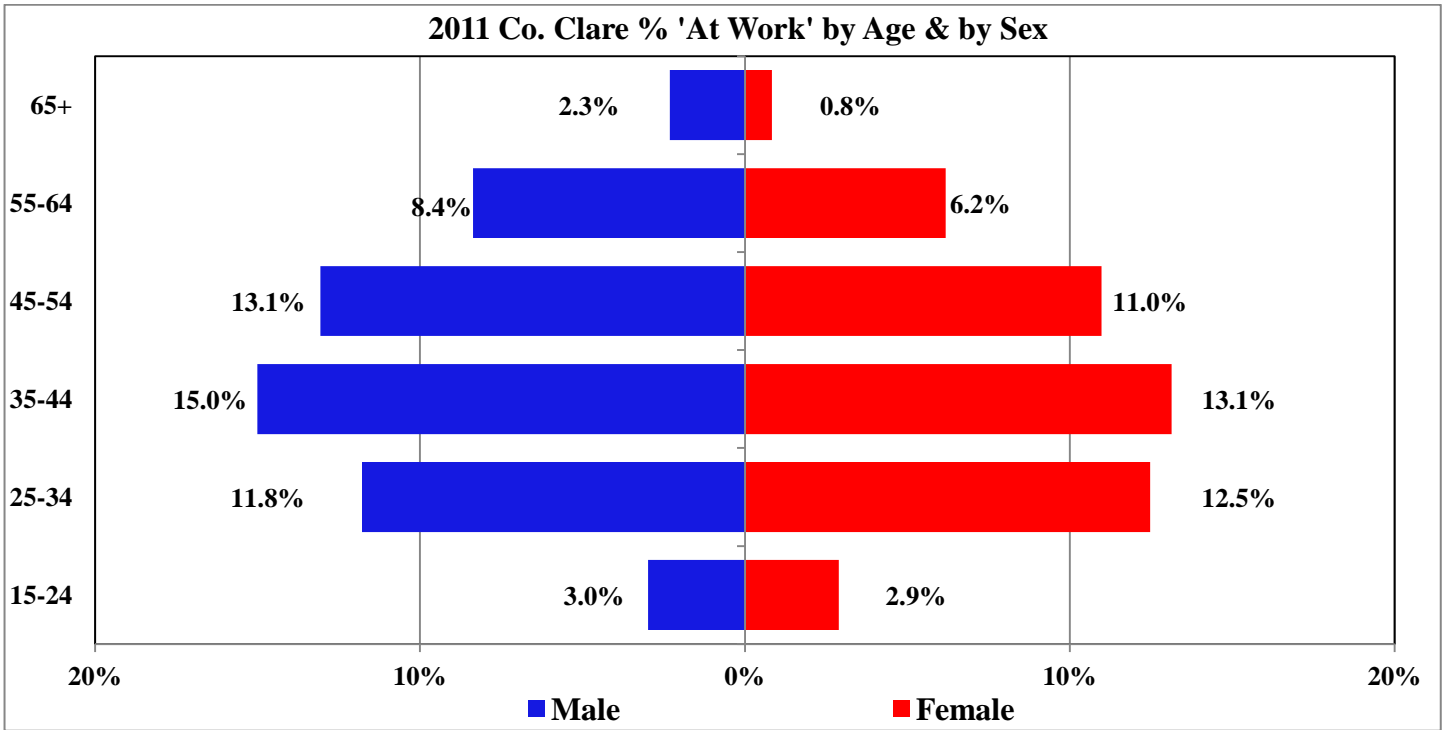
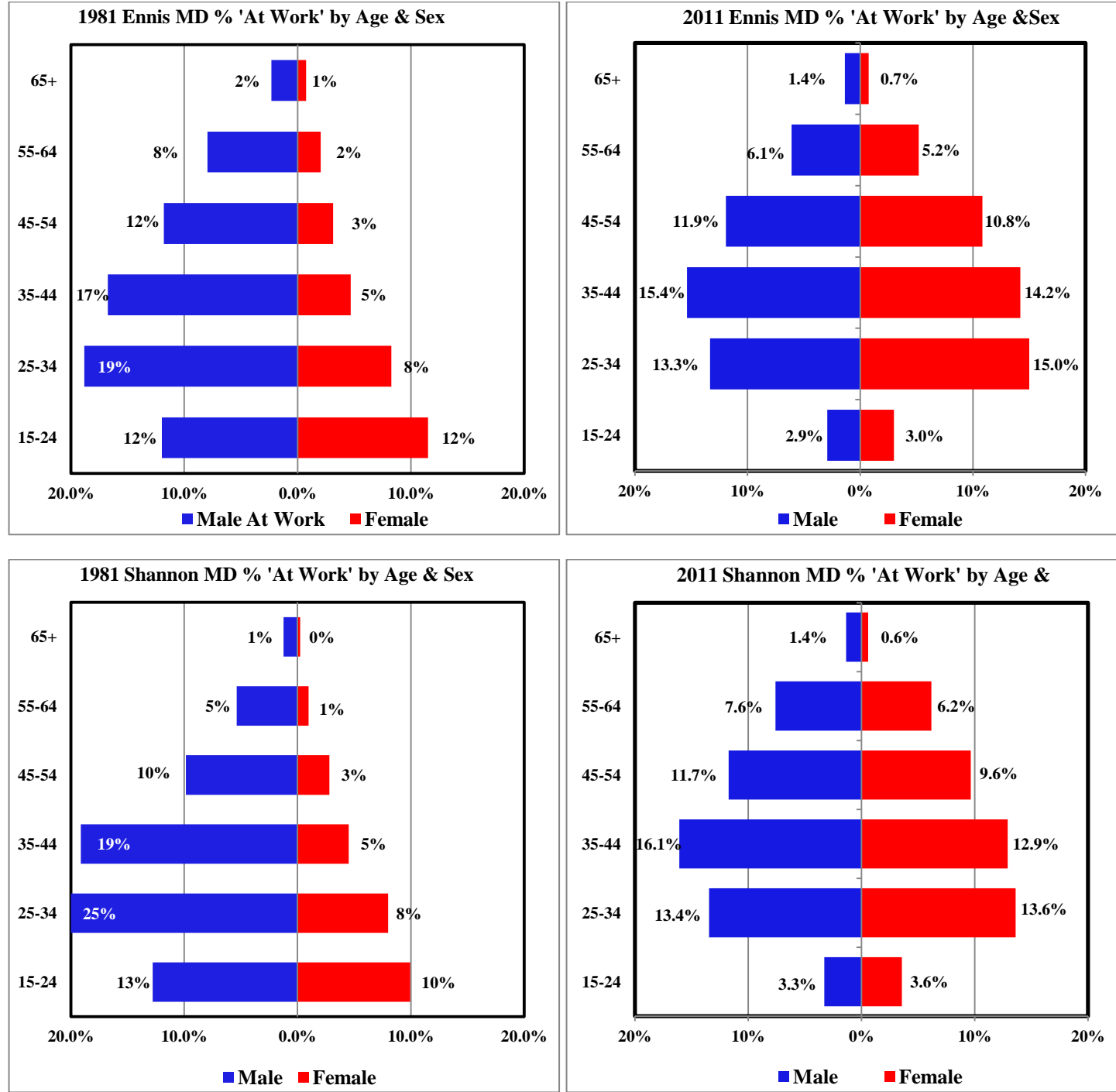


Diagram 3.4.3. Ennis, Shannon MD's Workforce by Age and Sex as % Total Workforce 1981, 2011



**Diagram 3.4.4. Killaloe, W. Clare MD's Workforce by Age and Sex as % Total Workforce 1981, 2002**

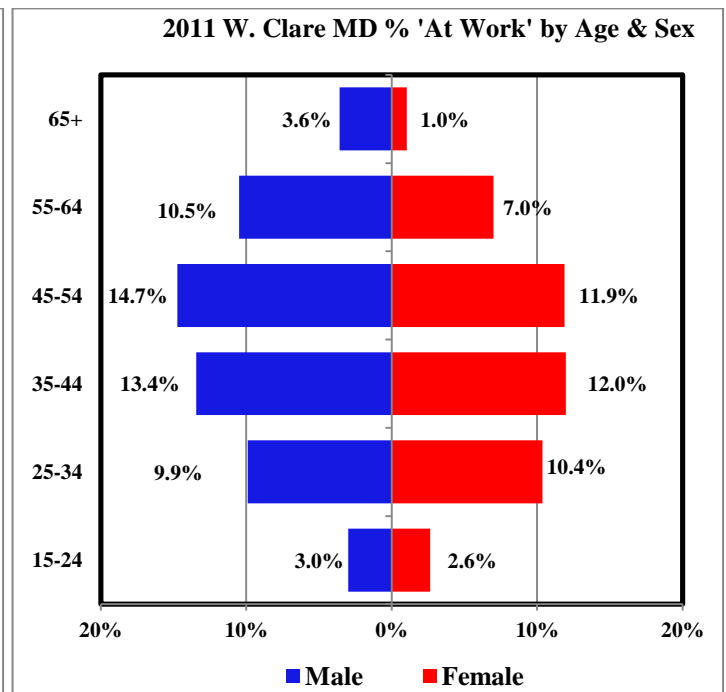
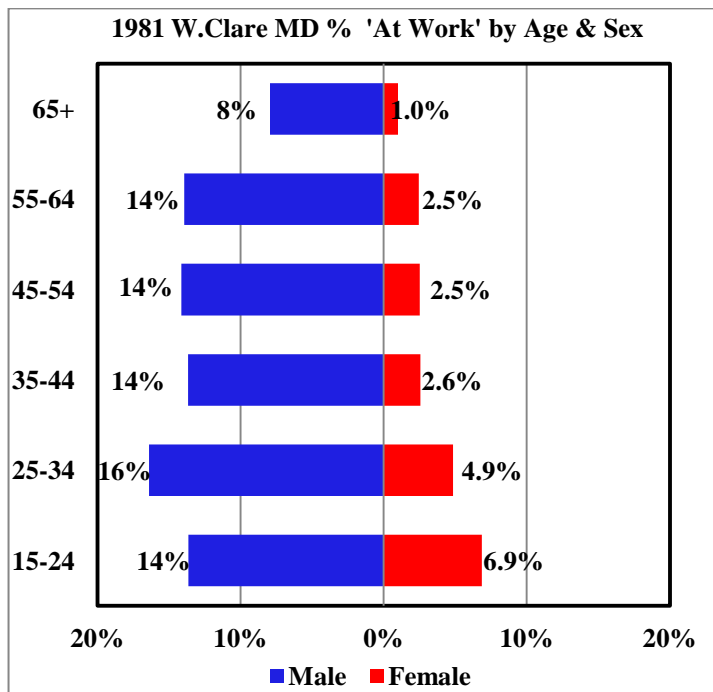
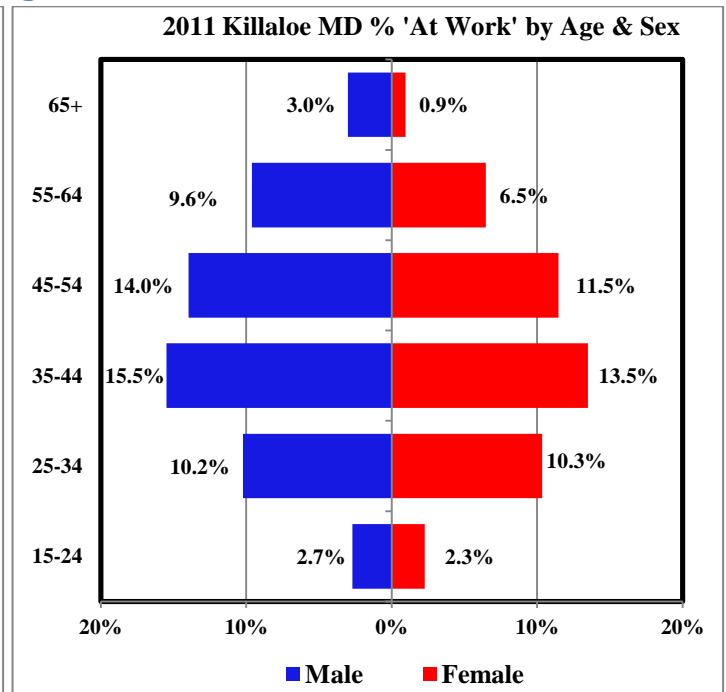
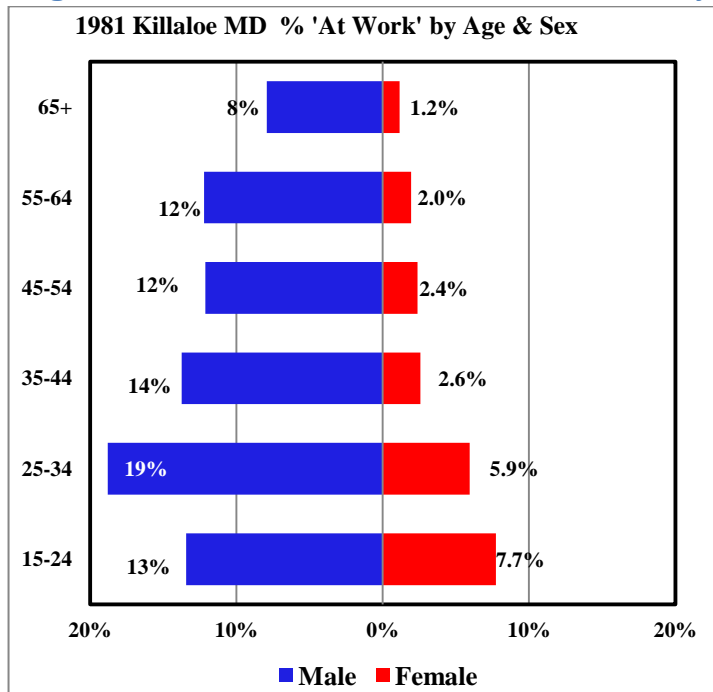


Diagram 3.4.5. Clare Workforce by Sector and Sex as % Total Workforce - 1981

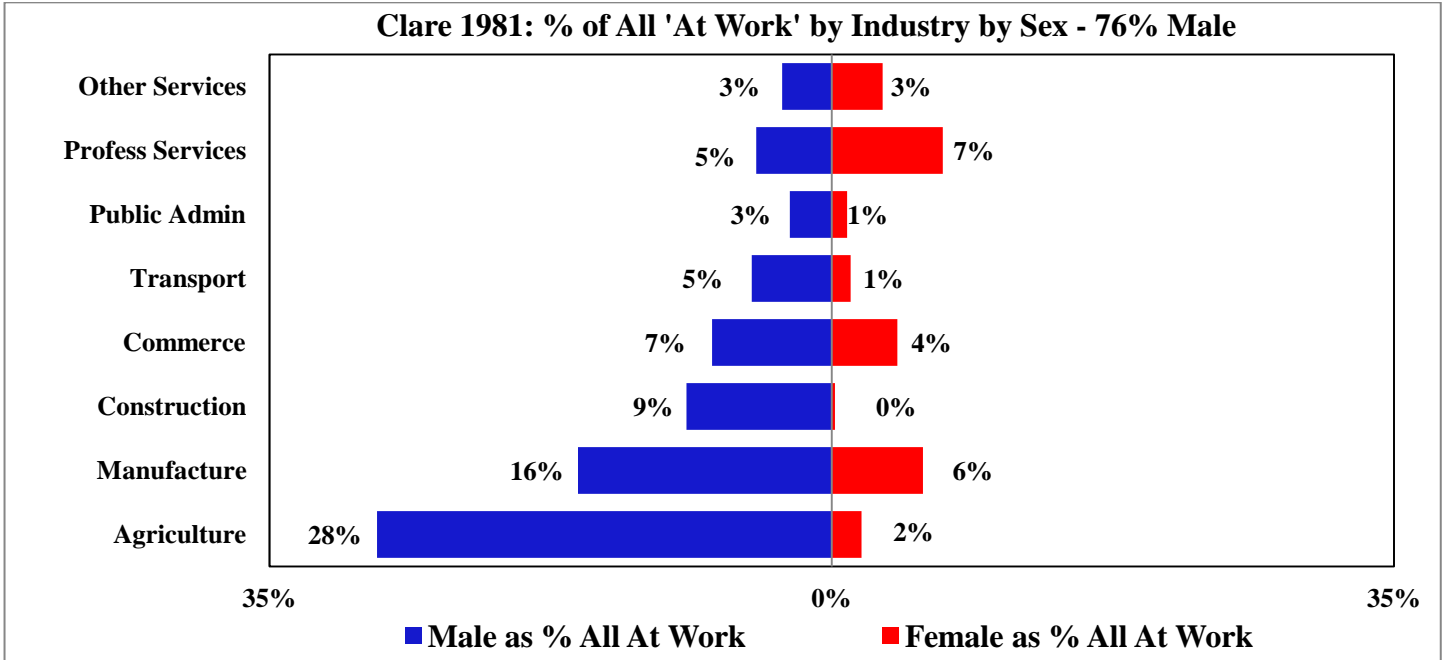
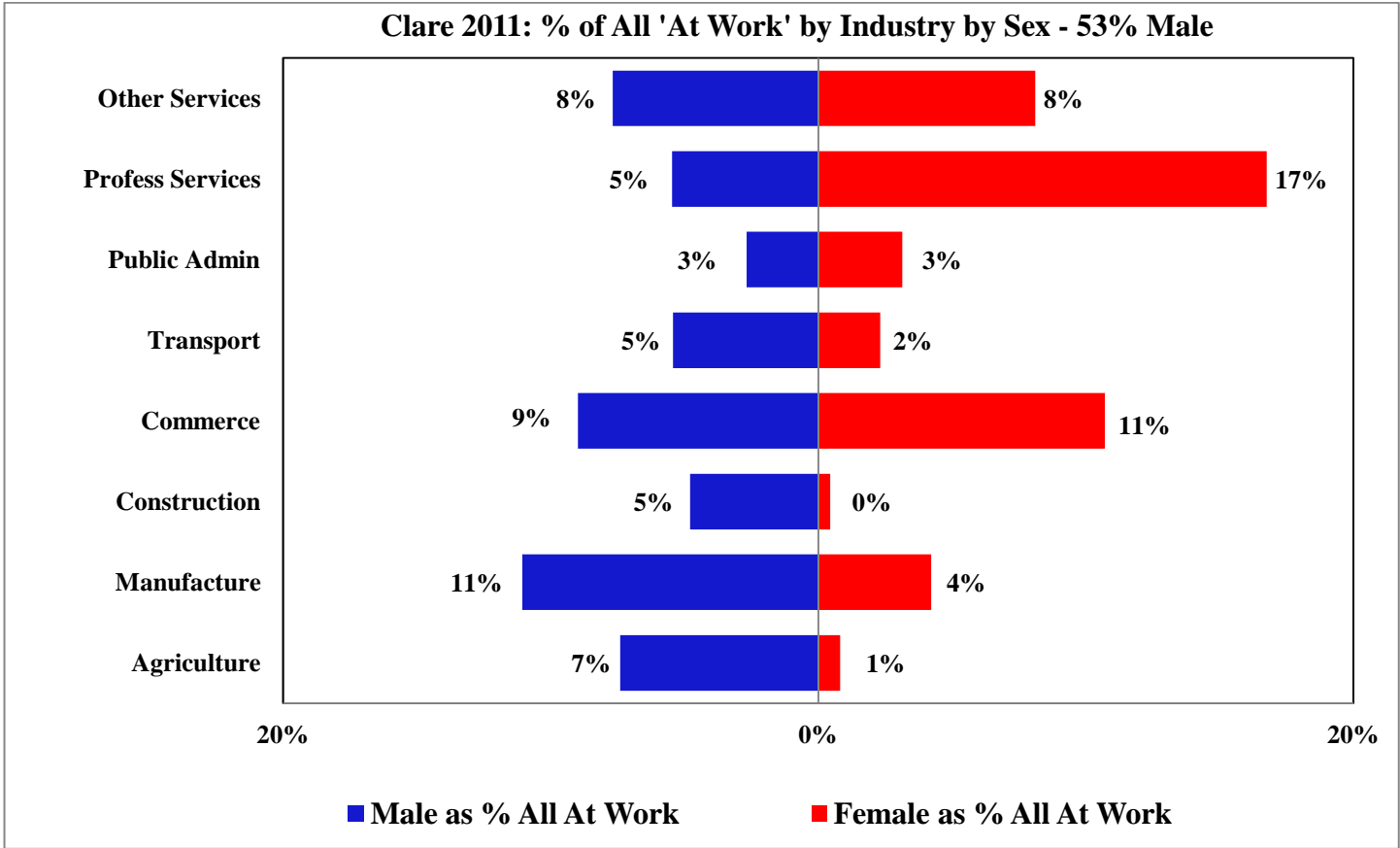
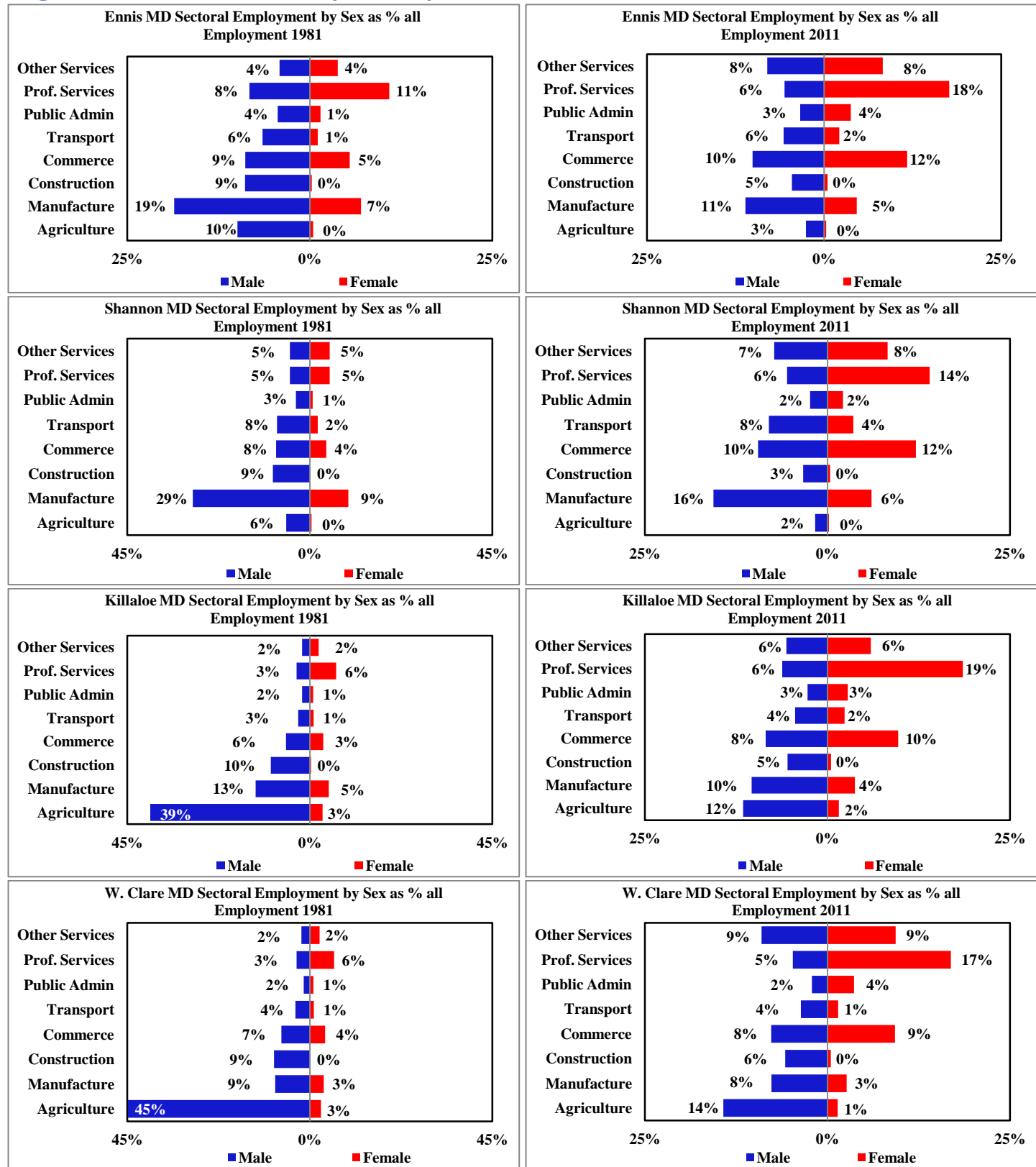


Diagram 3.4.6 Clare Workforce by Industry and Sex as % Total Workforce - 2011

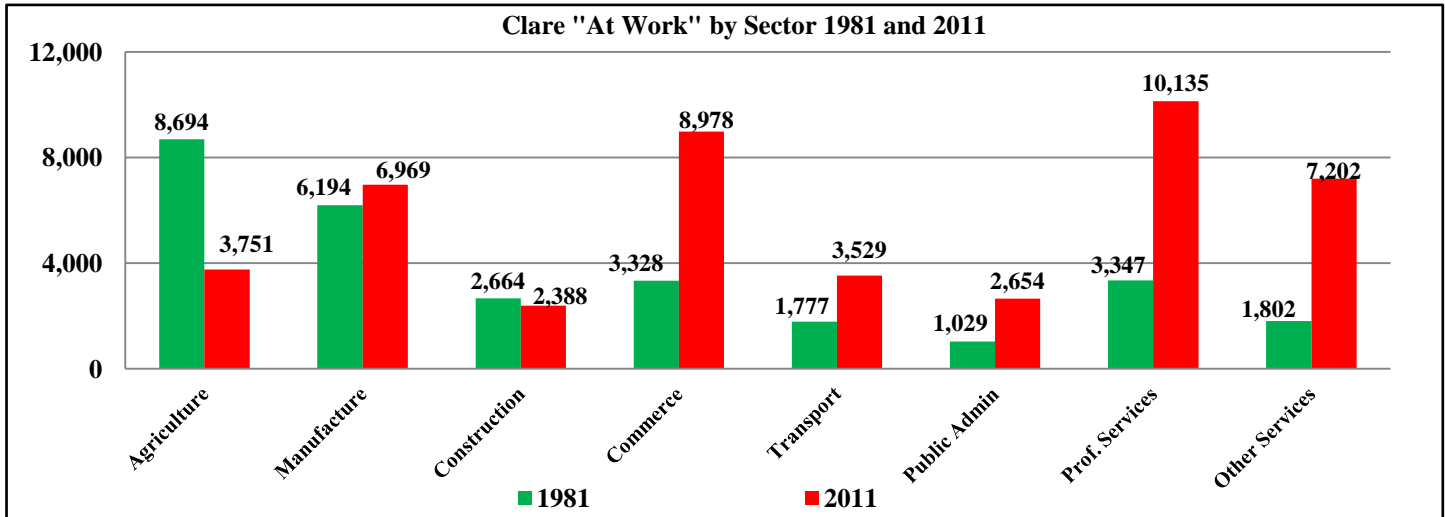
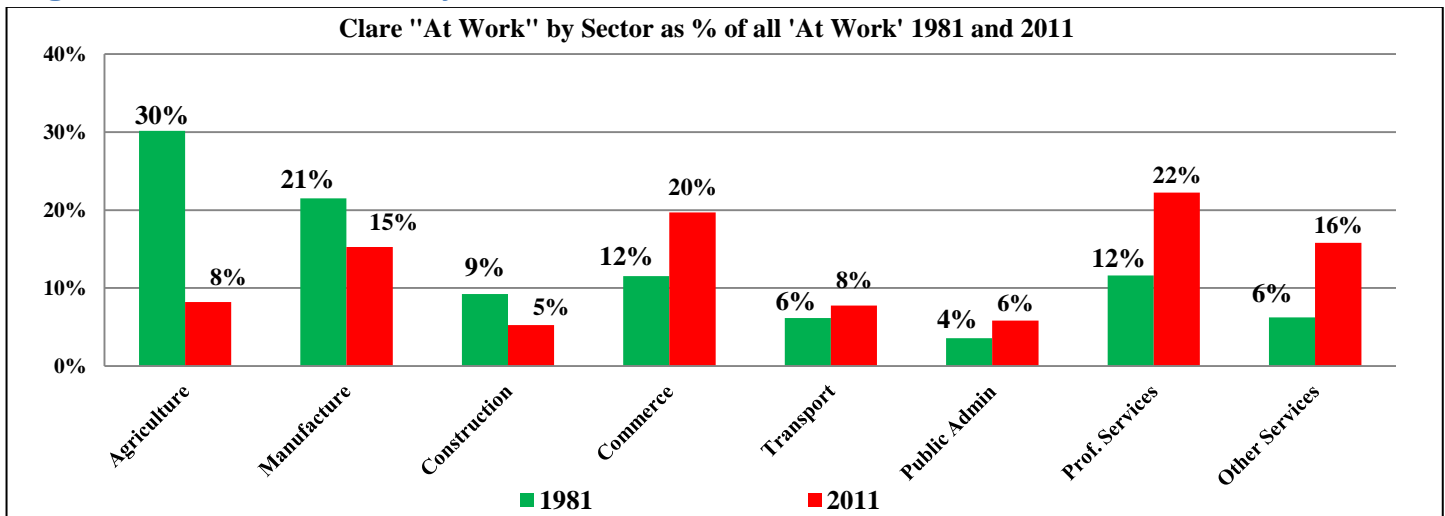
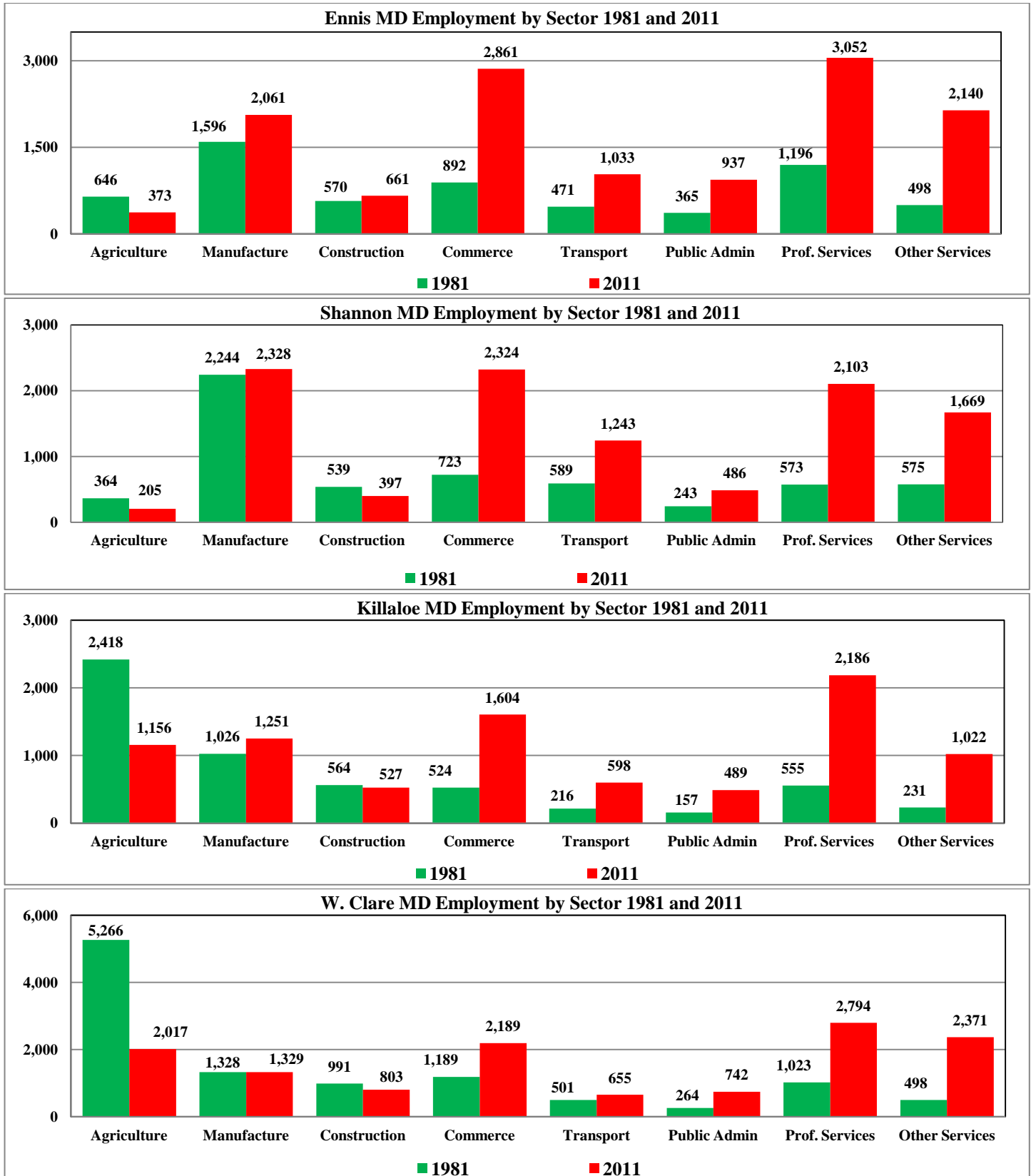


Diagram 3.5.2 Clare Workforce by Sector as % Total Workforce - 1981 and 2011

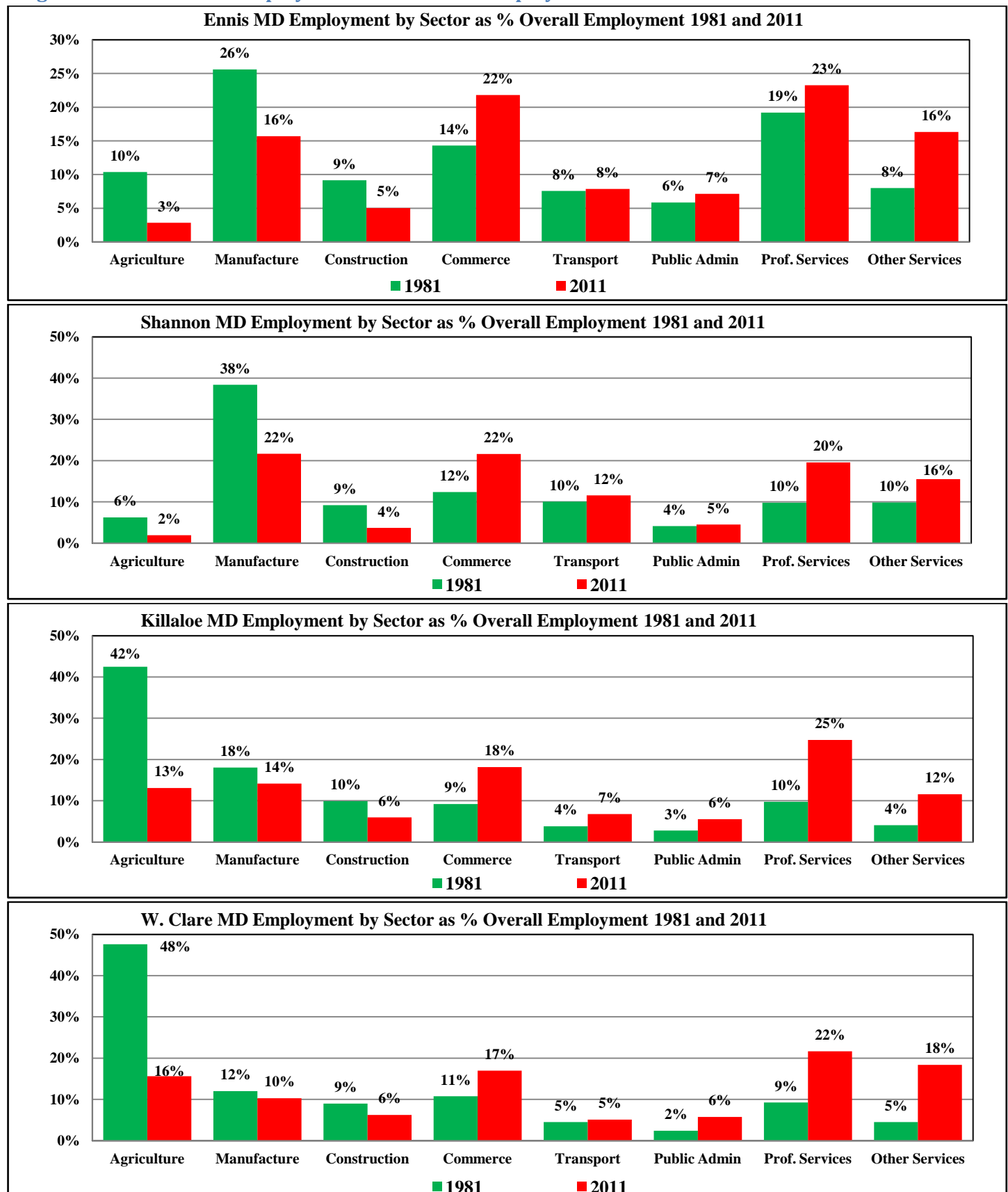




### Diagrams 3.5.3. Employment in MDs in 1981 and 2011 by Sector

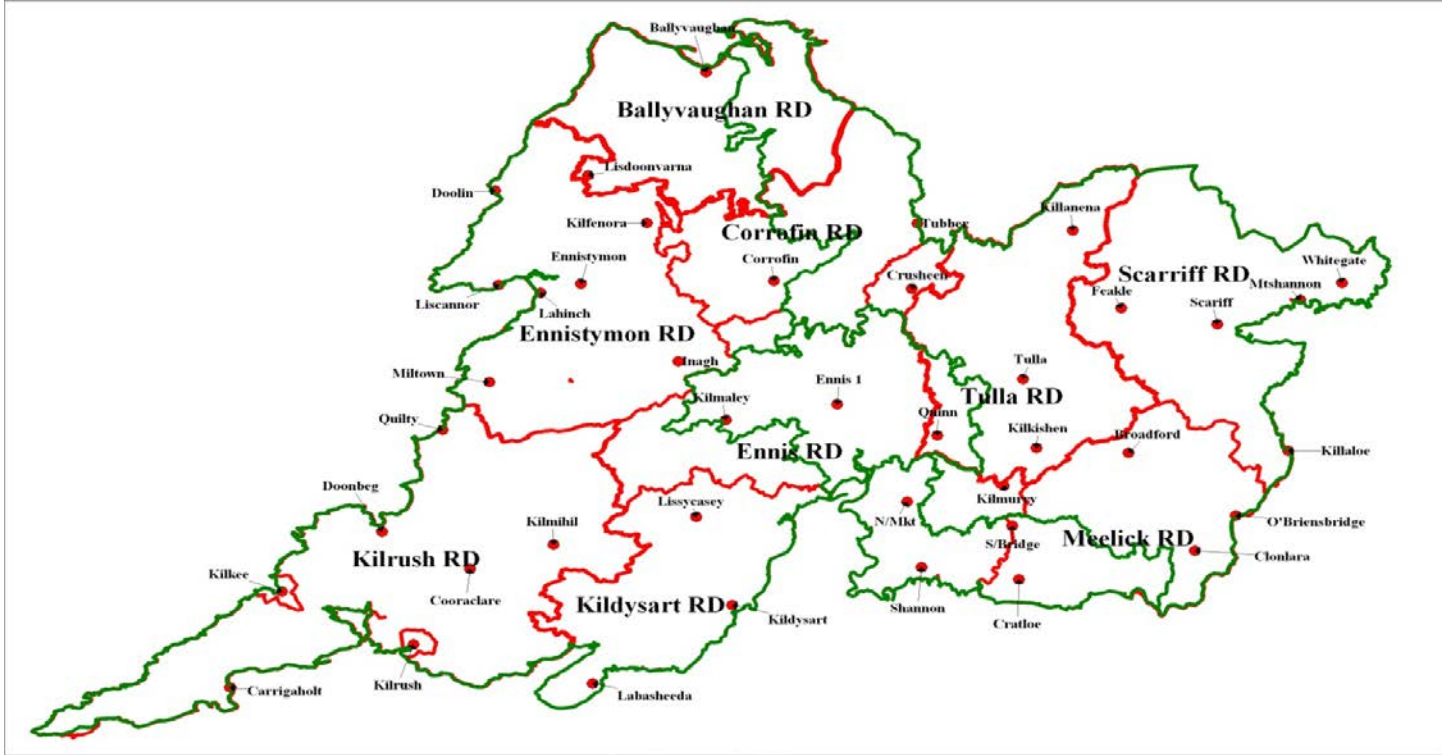
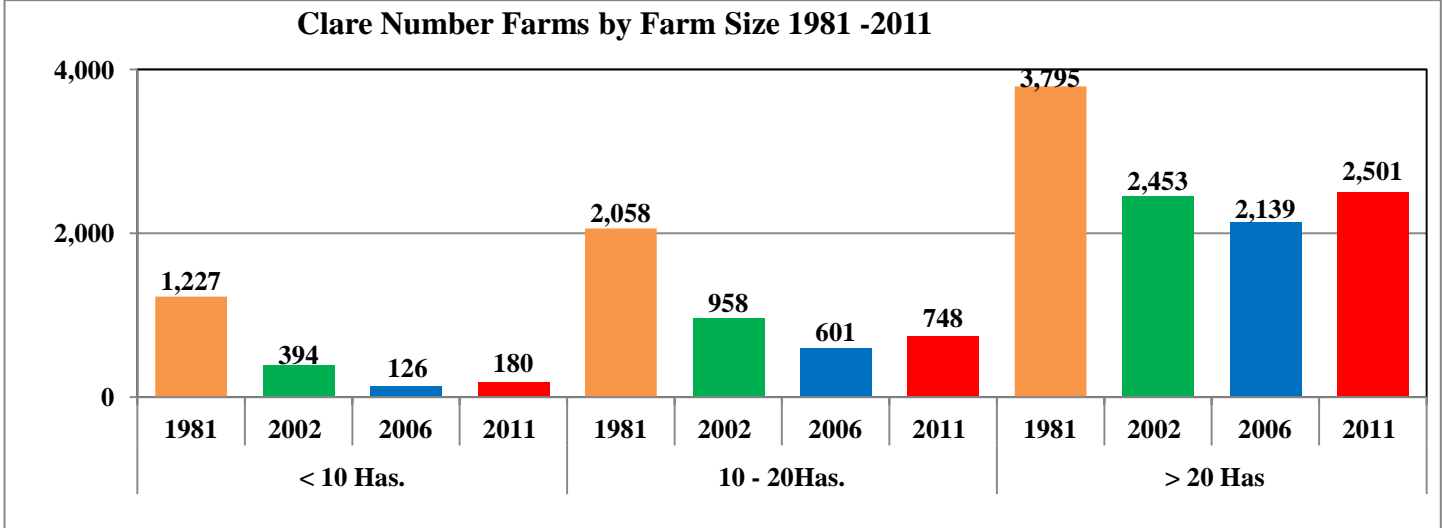
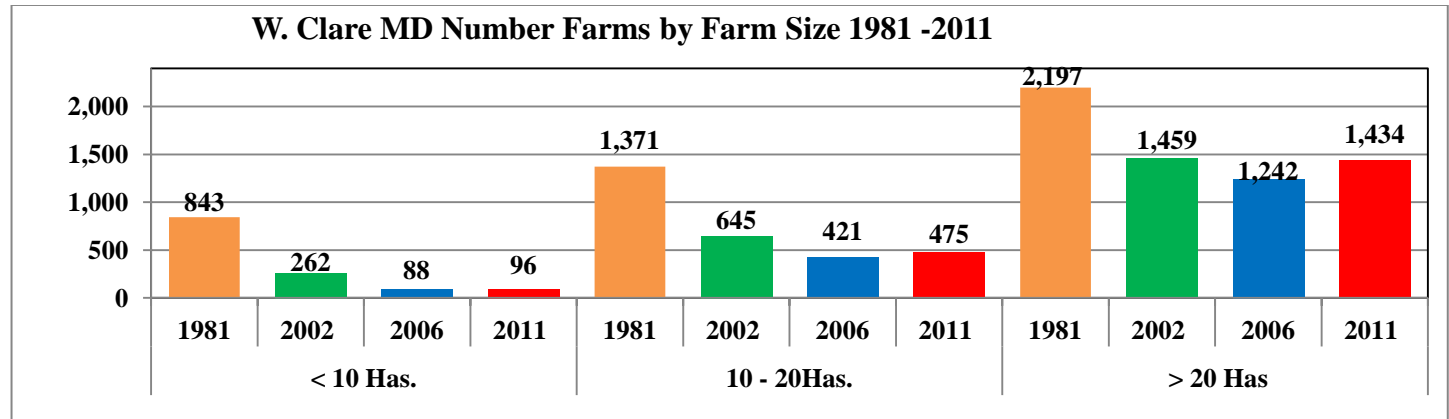
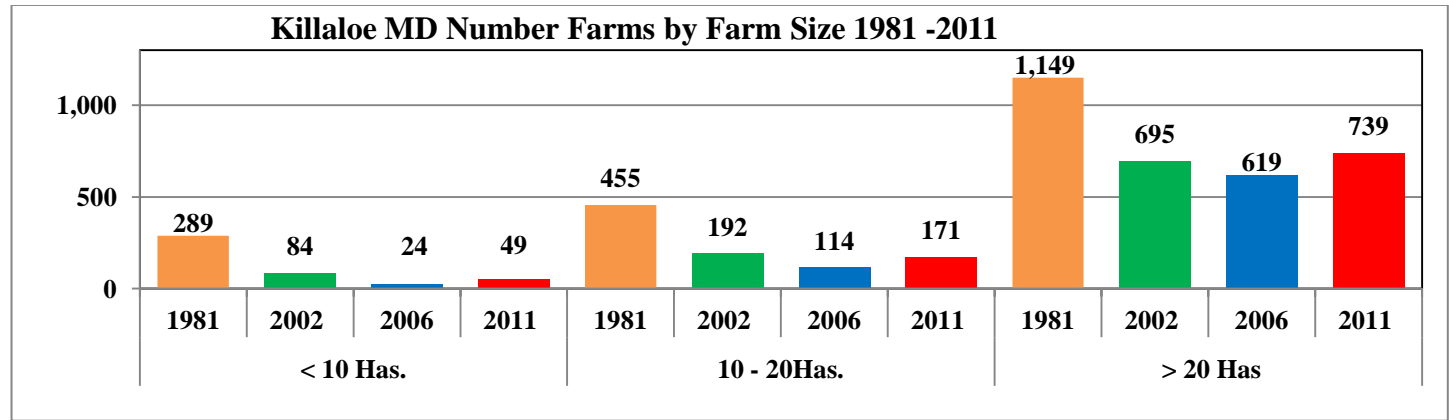
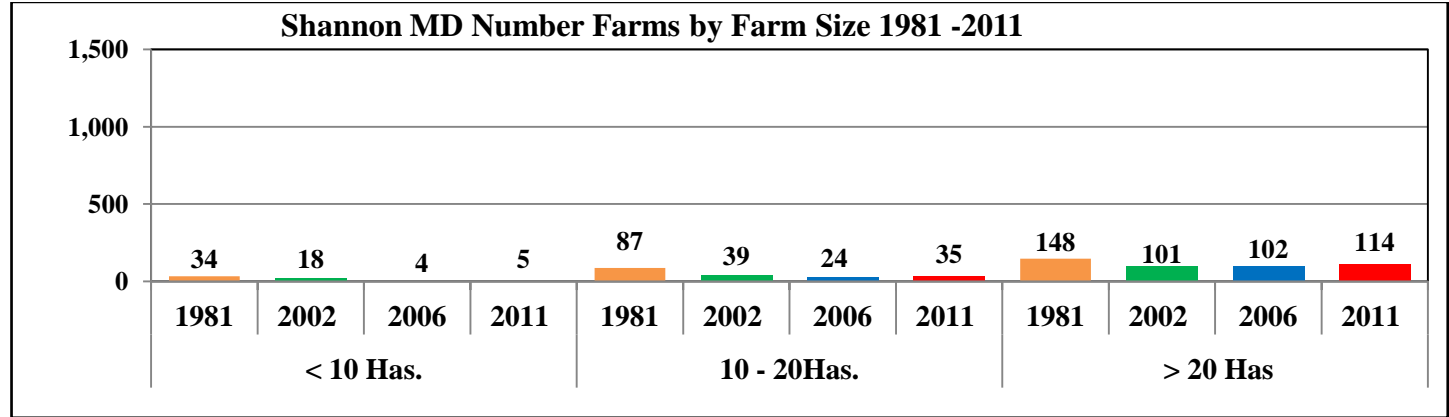
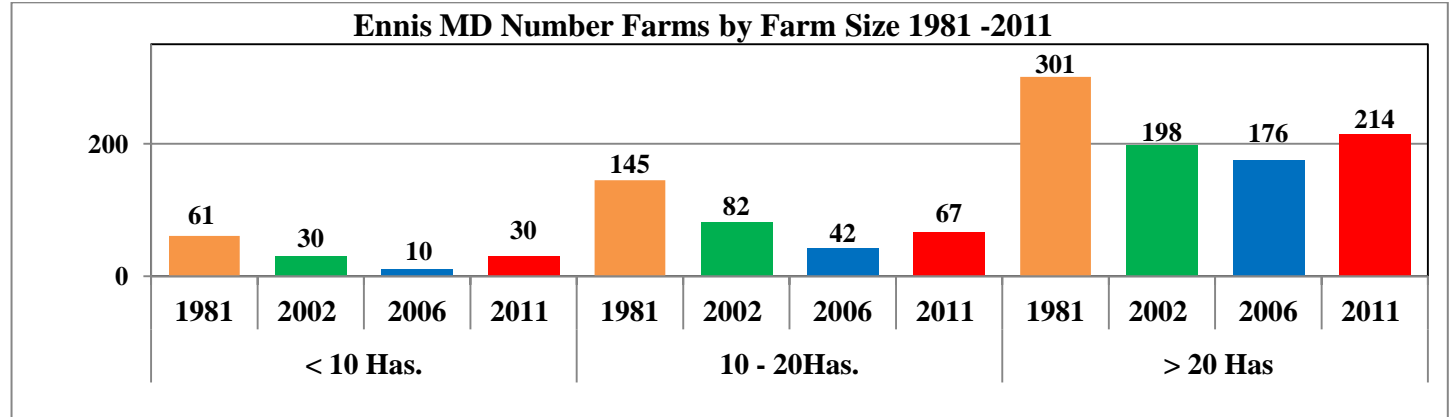


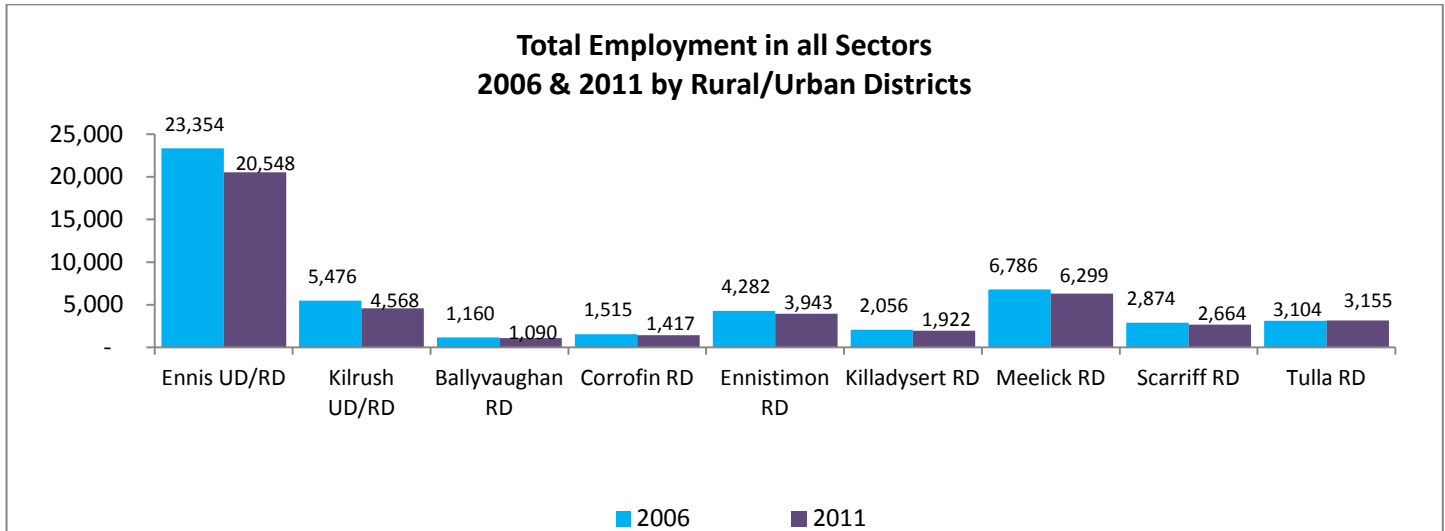
Diagram 3.5.5. Clare Number of Farms by Farm Size 1981, 2002, 2006, 2011 (Census Population)



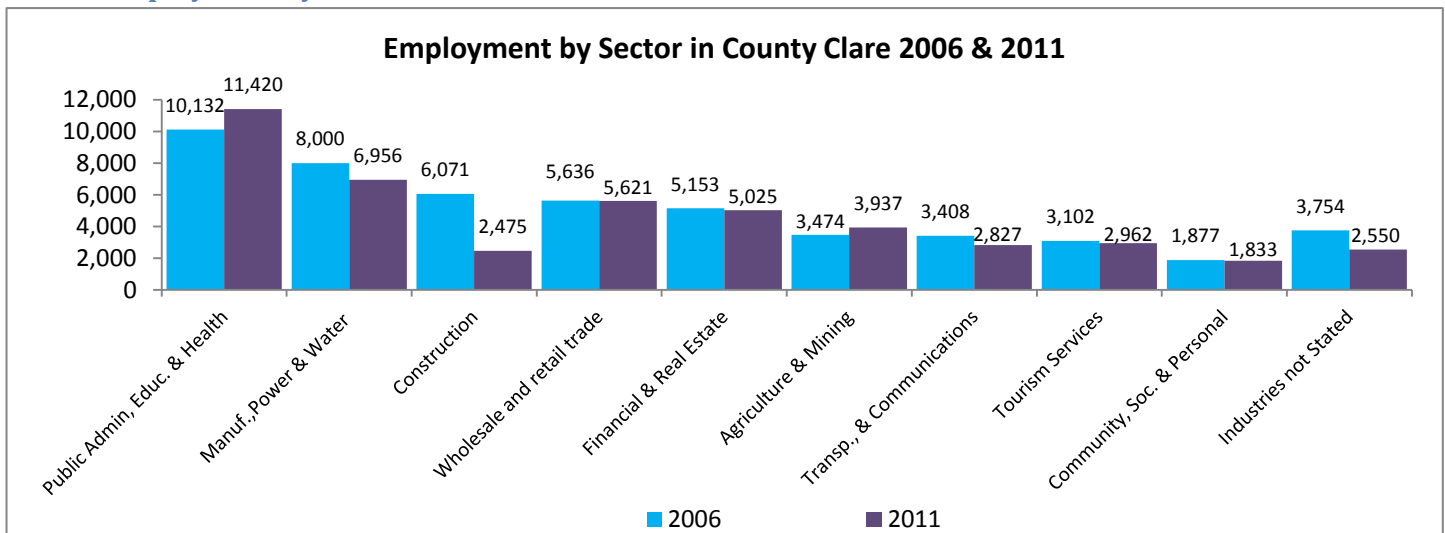

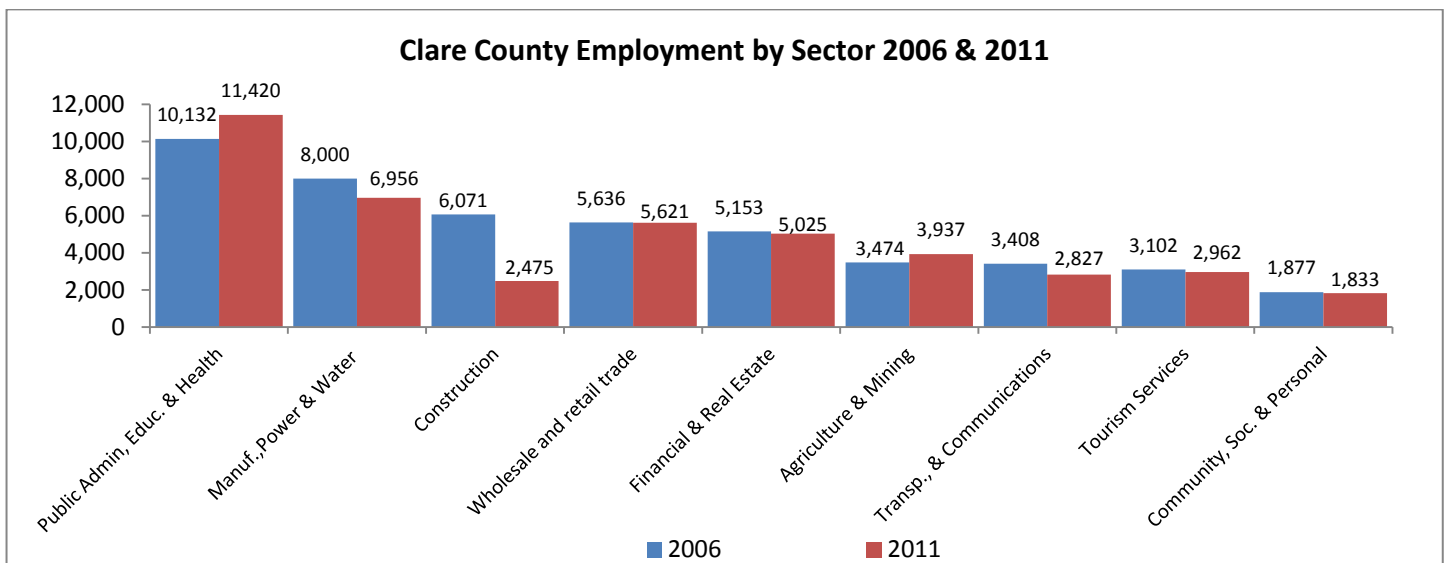
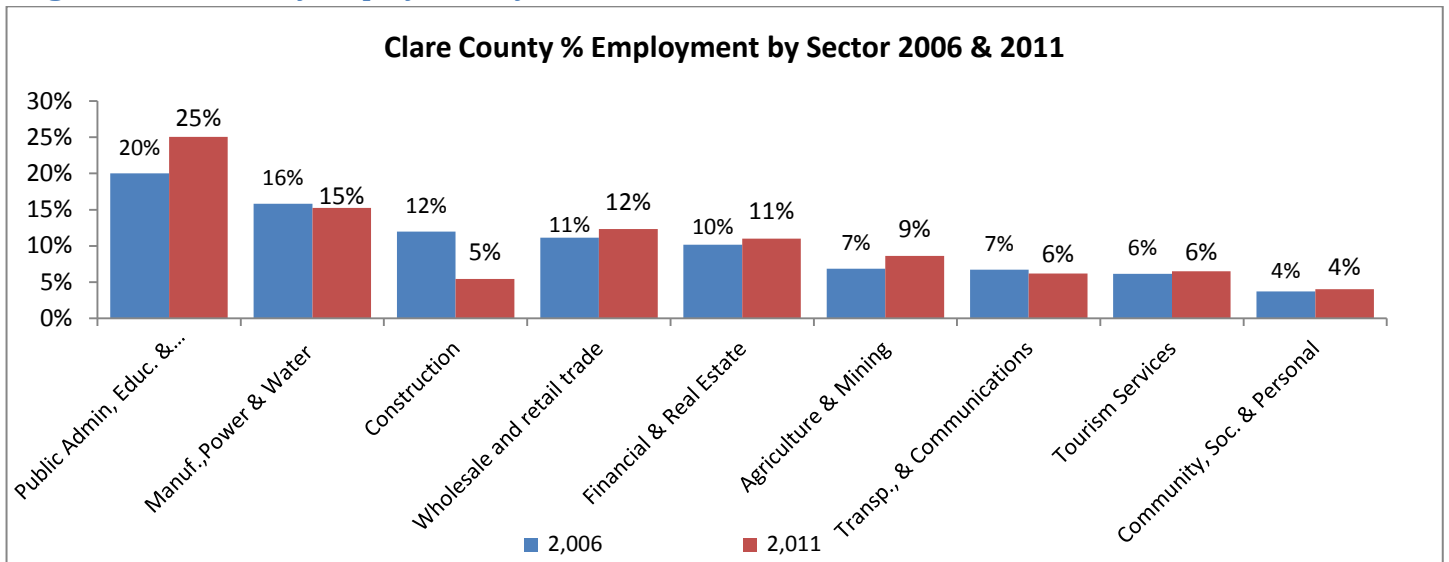

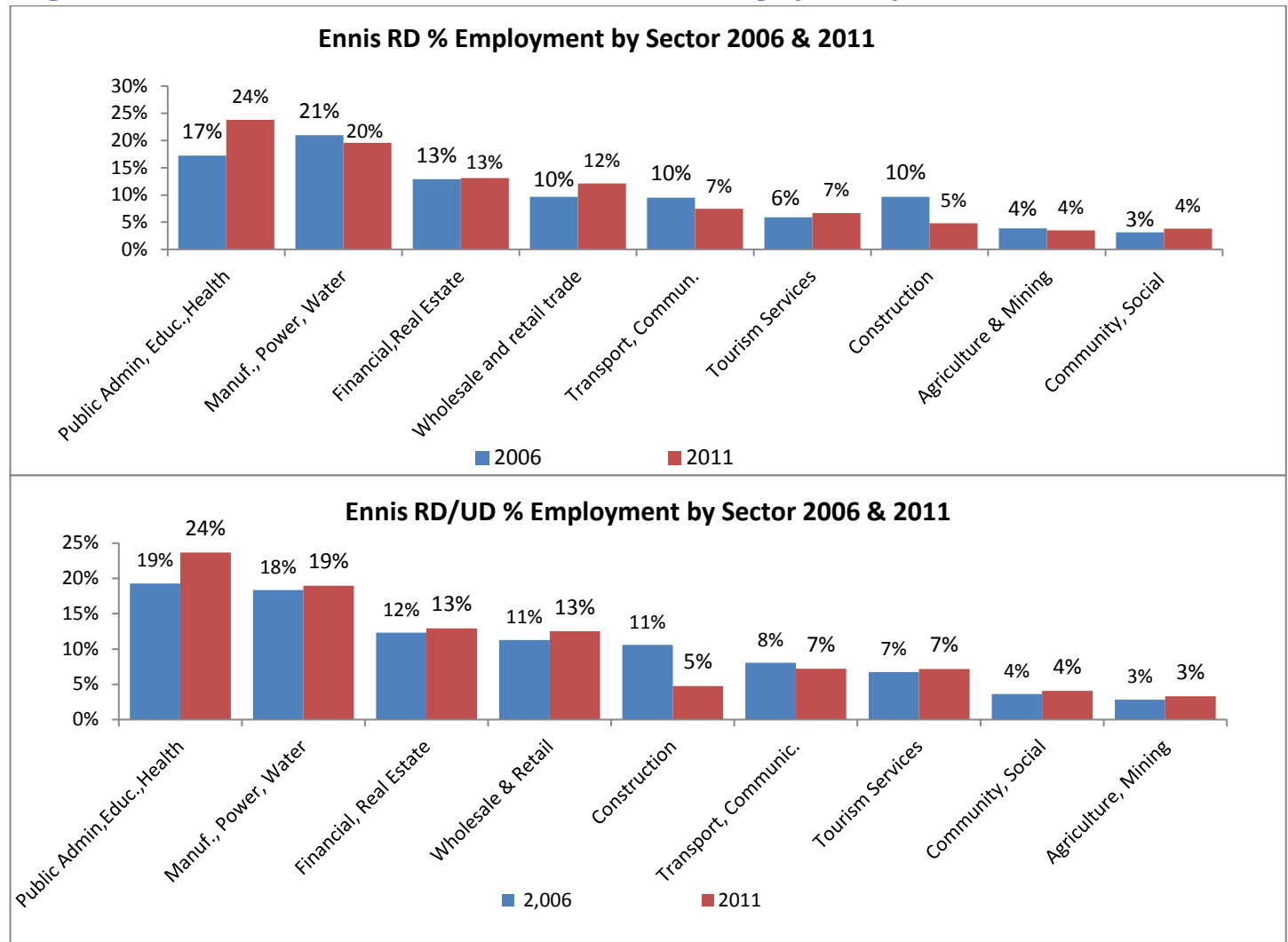




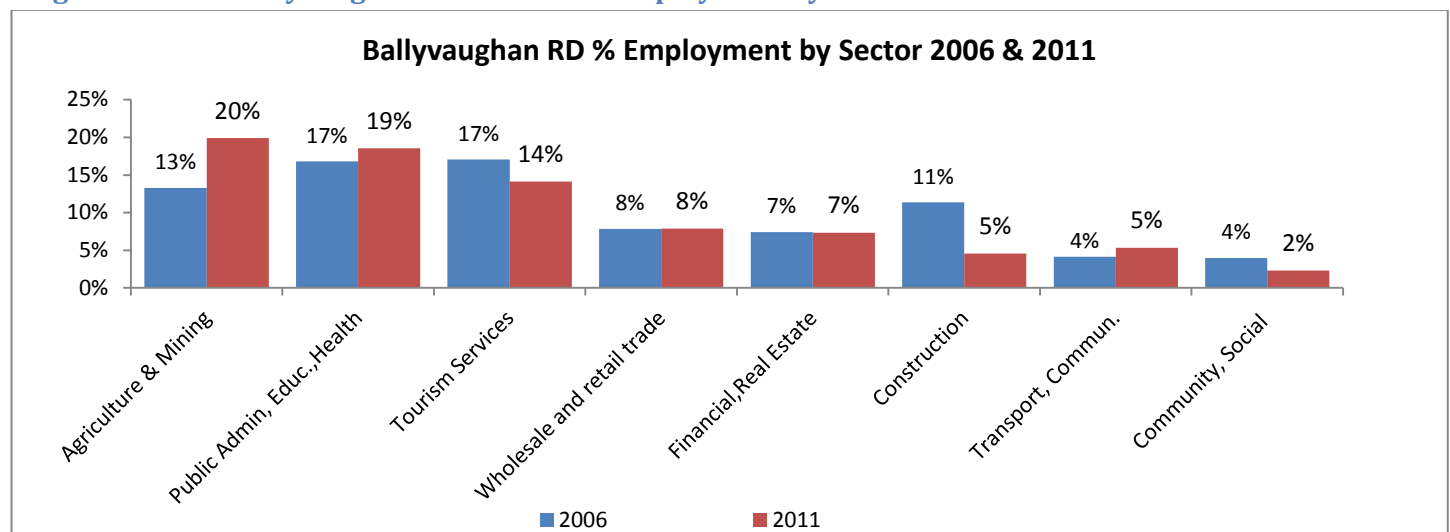

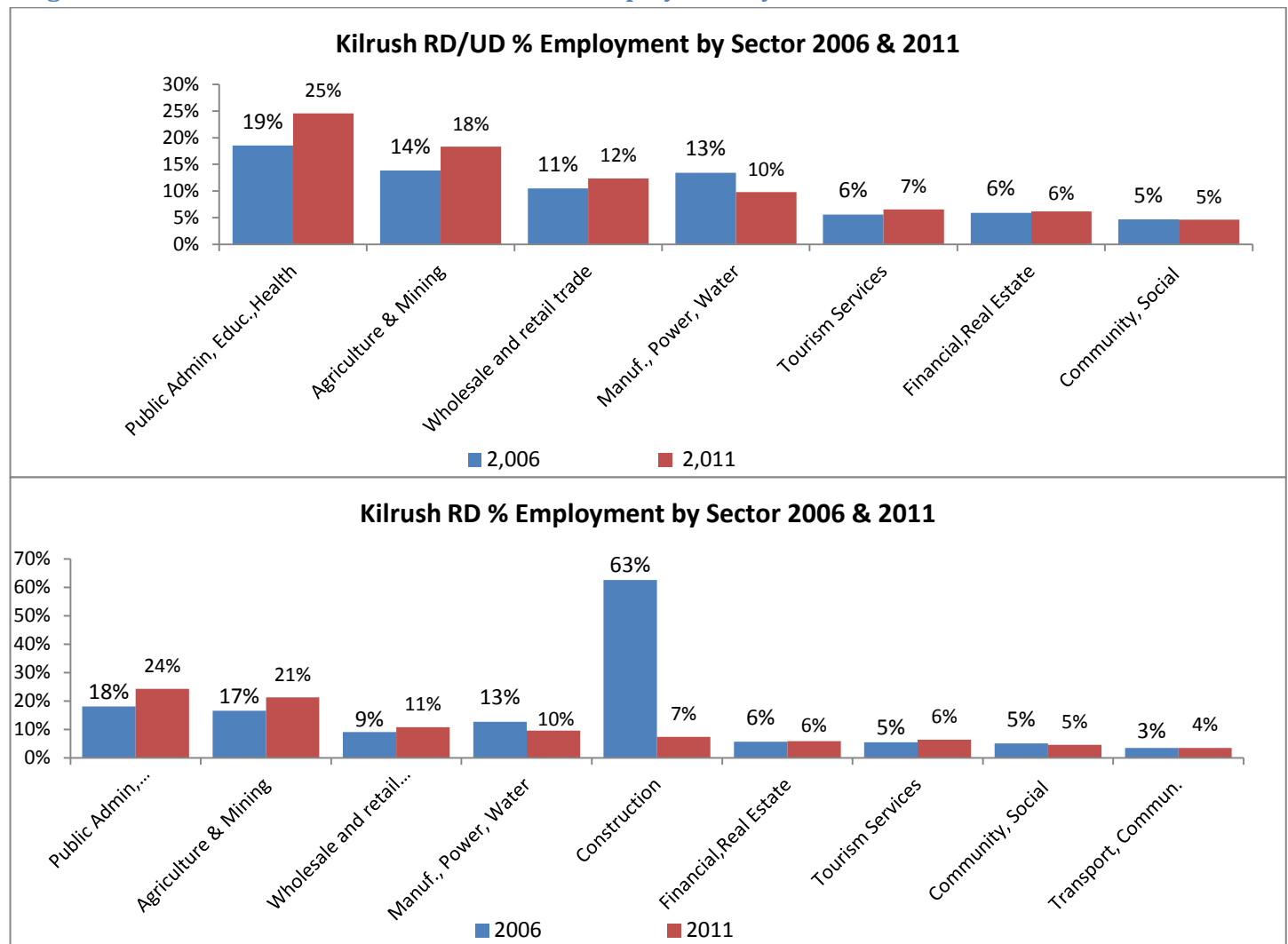
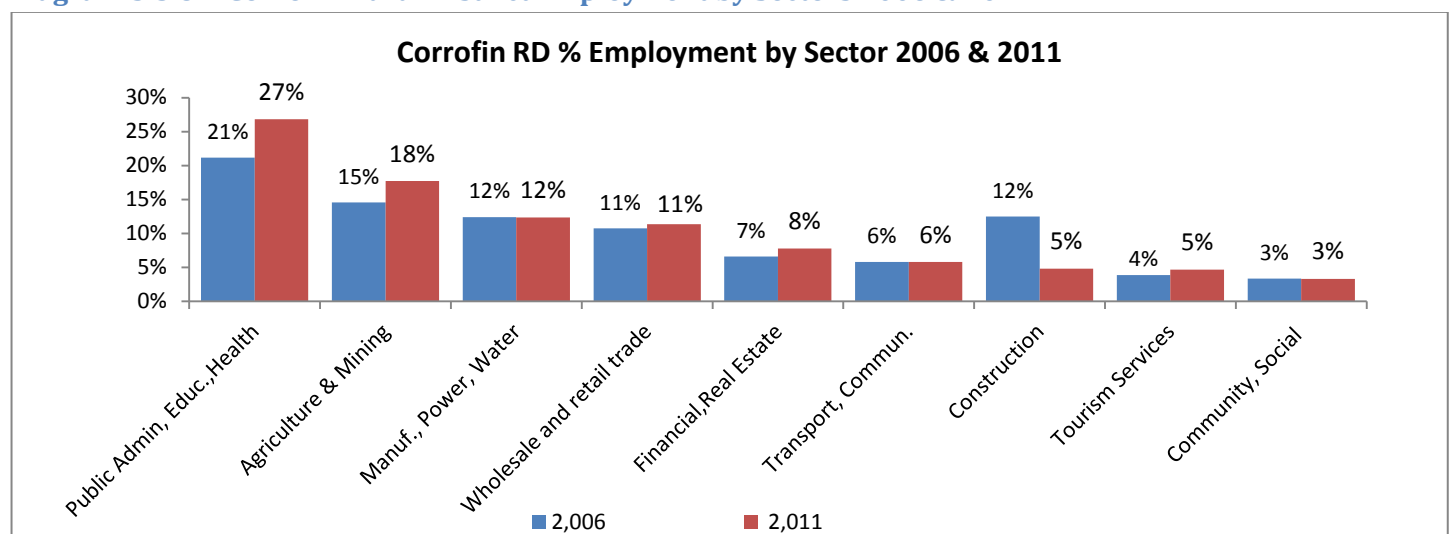
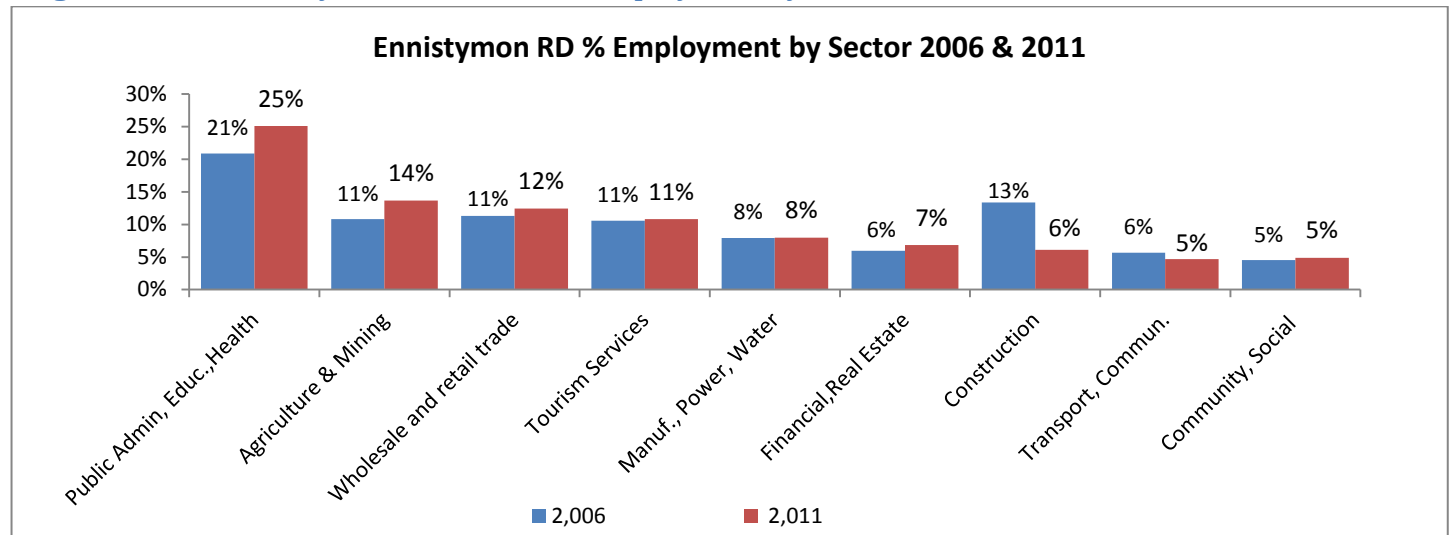


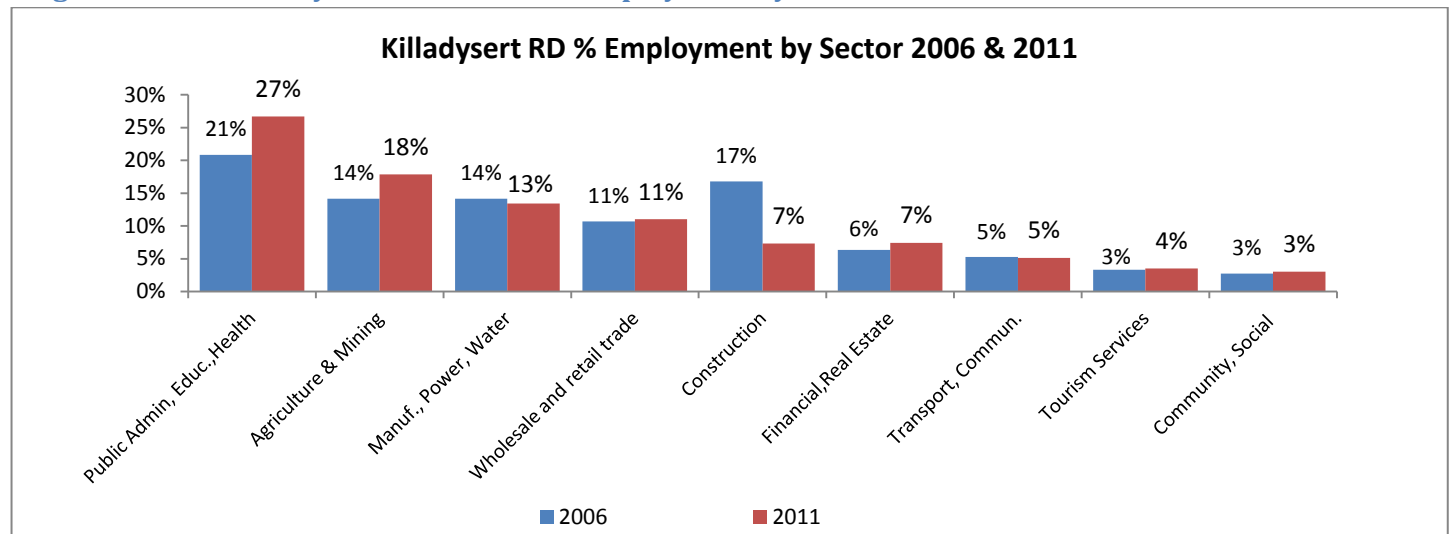
Diagram 3.5.8.4. Corrofin Rural District Employment by Sectors 2006 & 2011

**Diagram 3.5.8.7. Meelick Rural District Employment by Sectors 2006 & 2011**

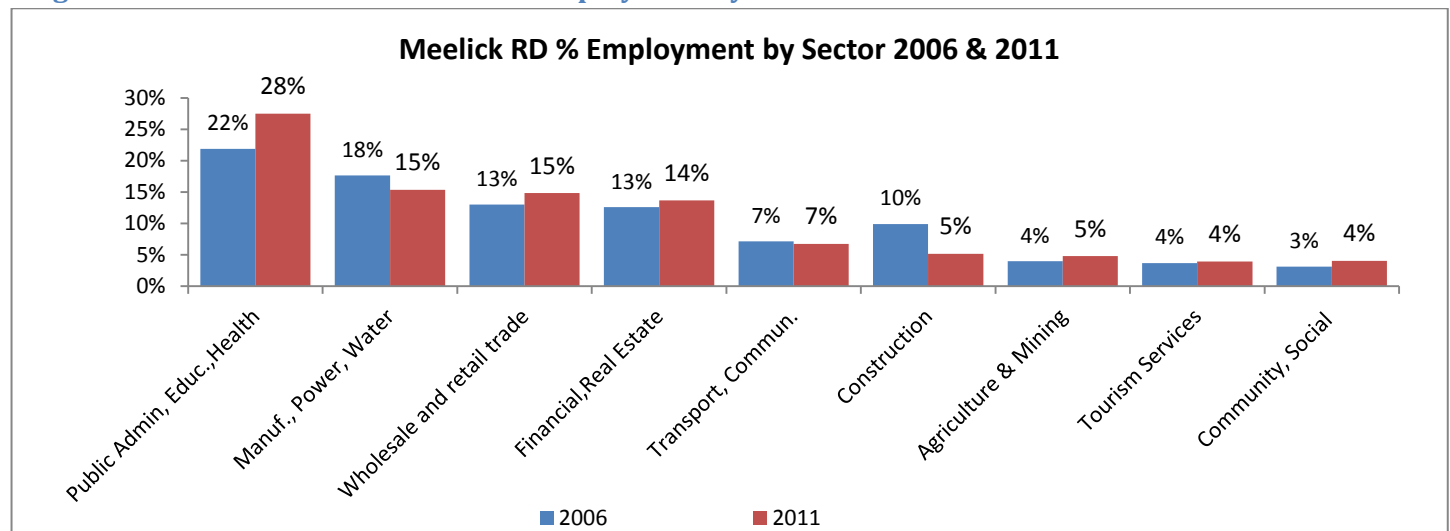


Diagram 3.5.8.8. Scarriff Rural District Employment by Sectors 2006 & 2011

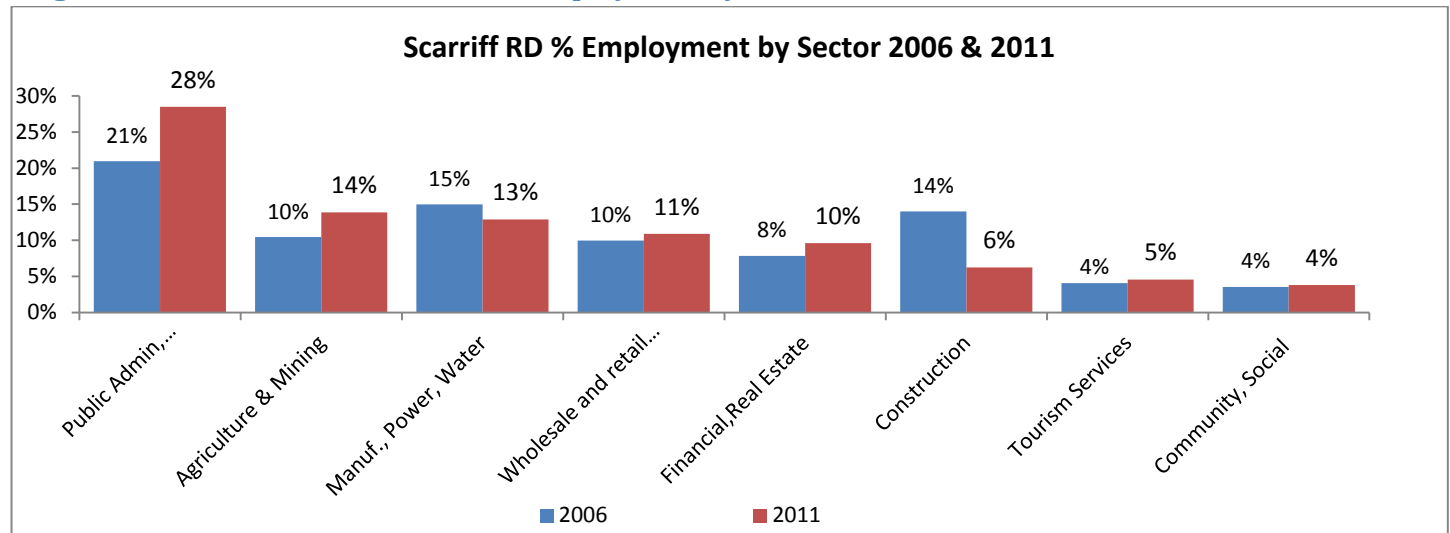
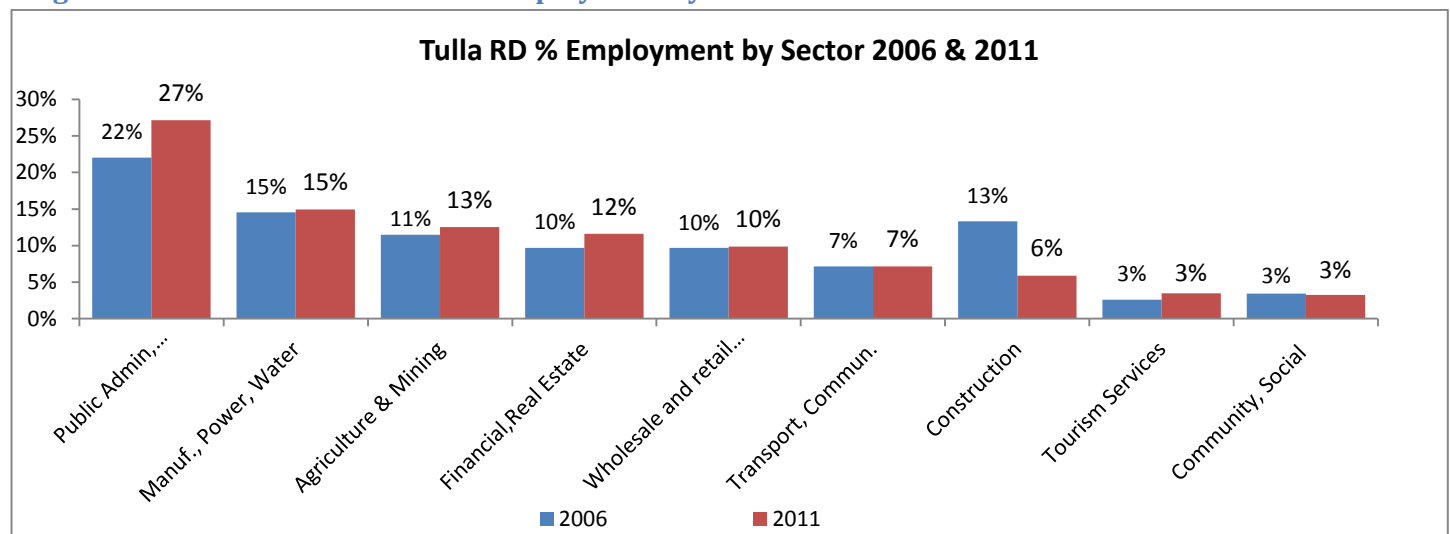
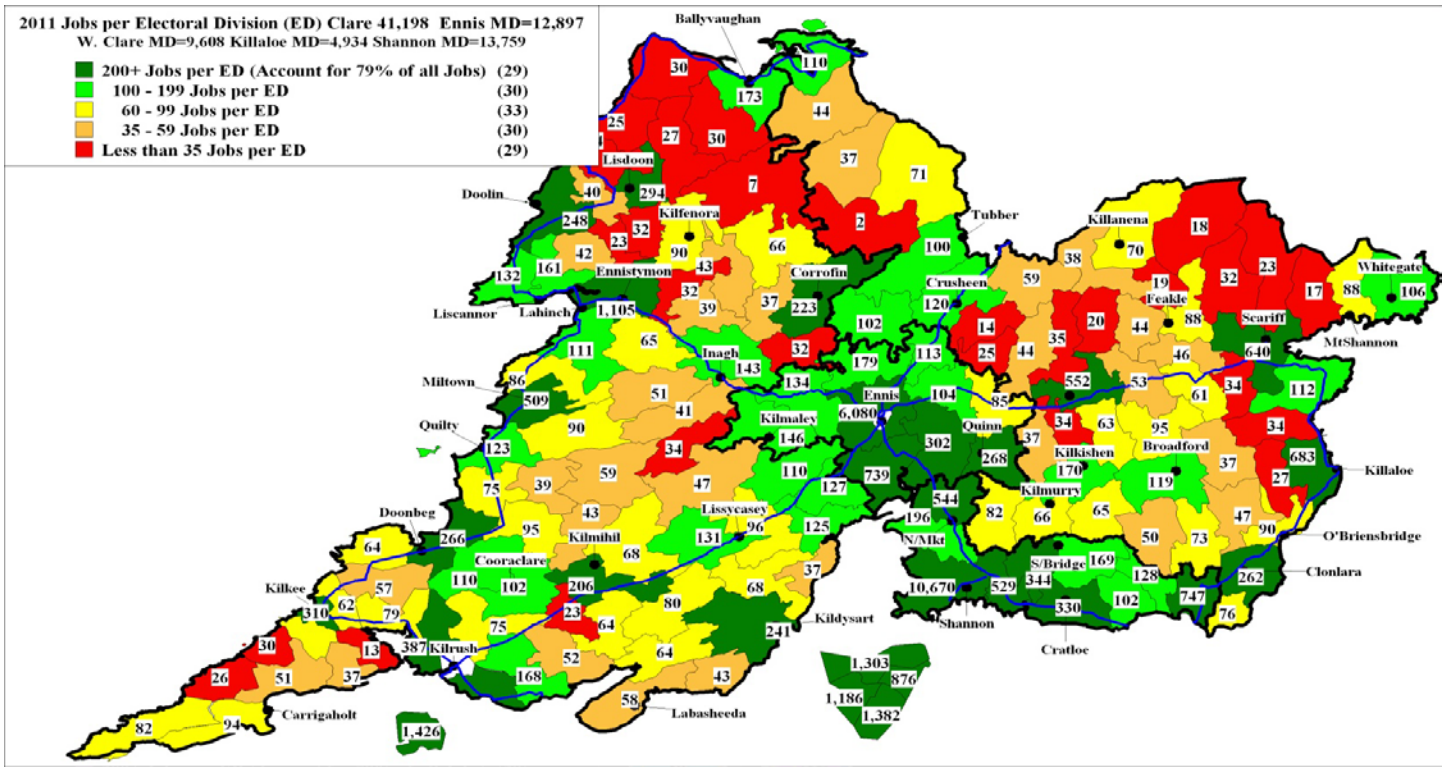


Diagram 3.5.8.9 Tulla Rural District Employment by Sectors 2006 & 2011

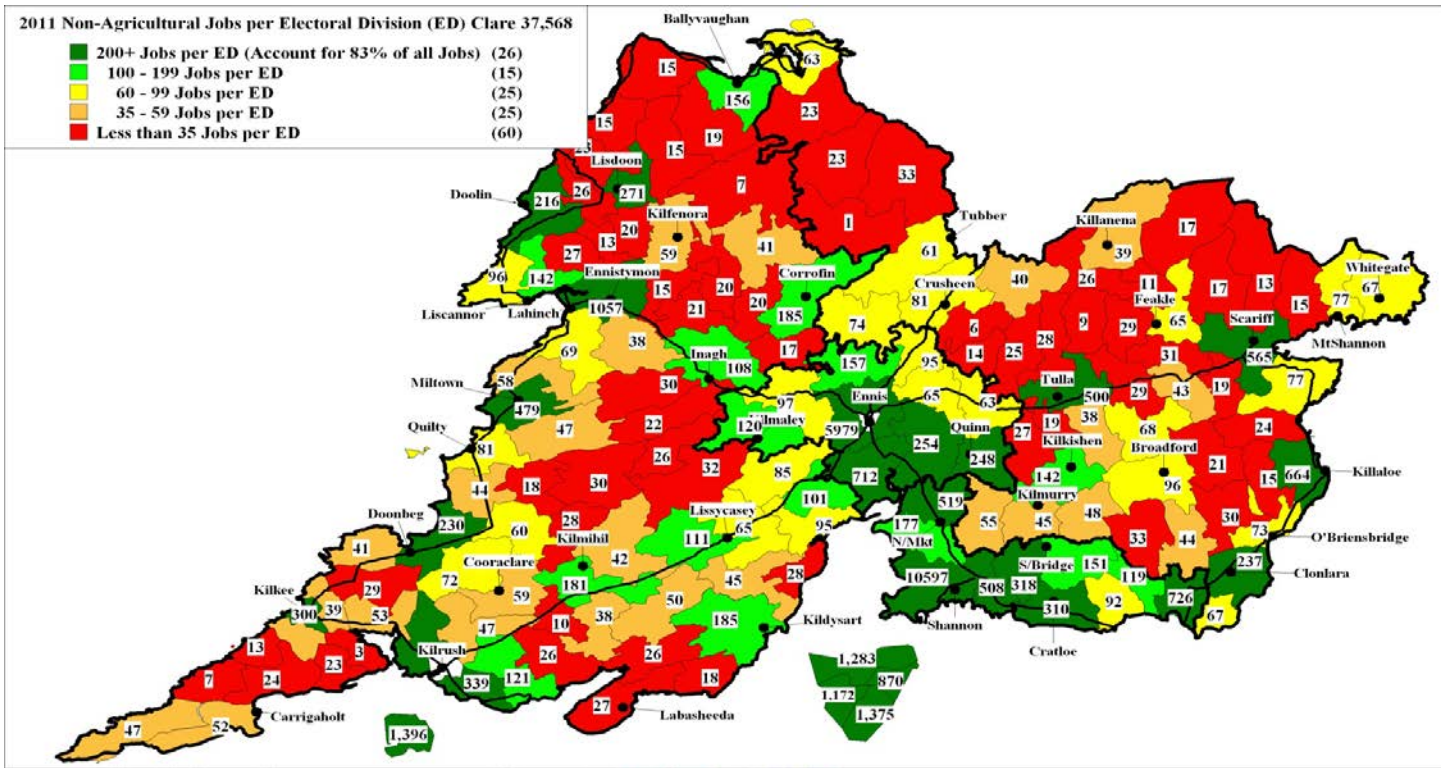

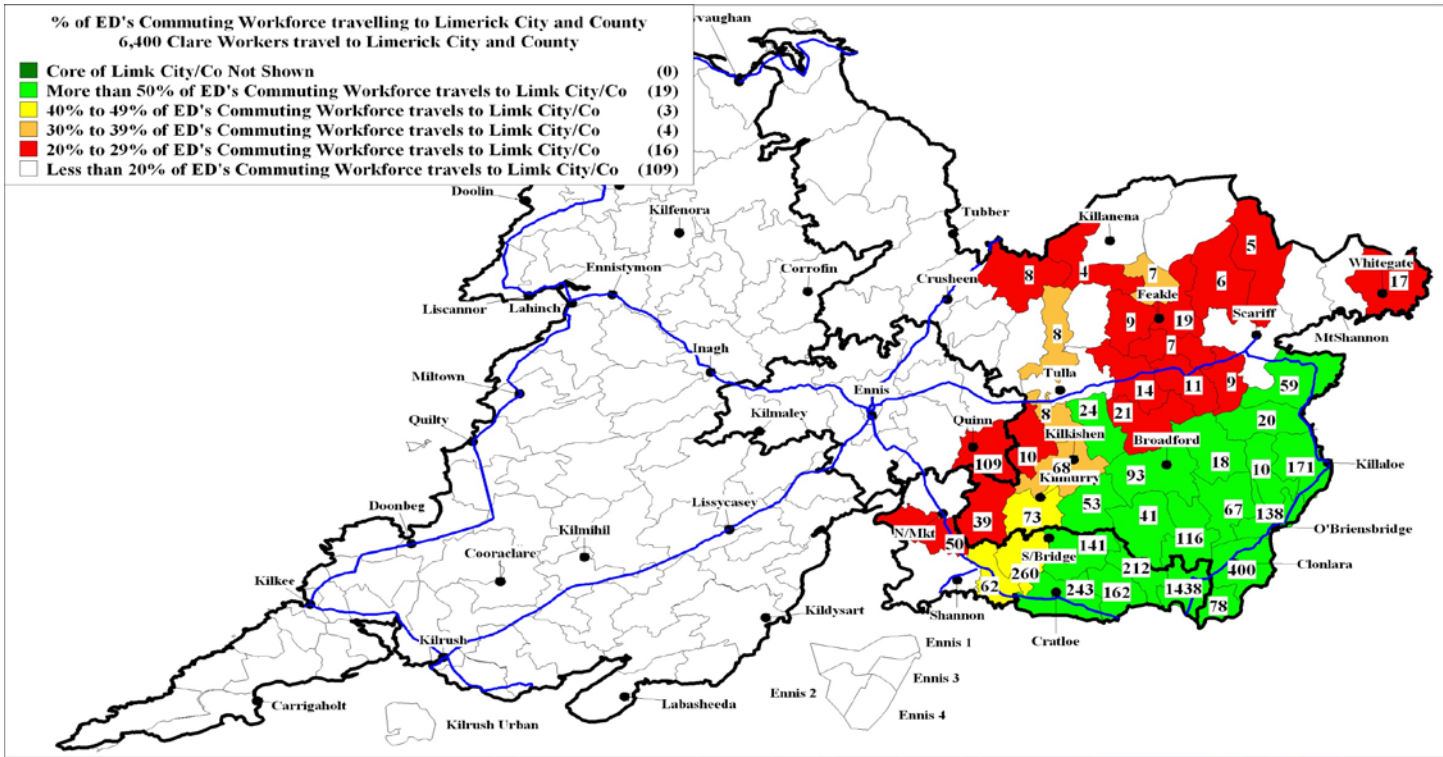

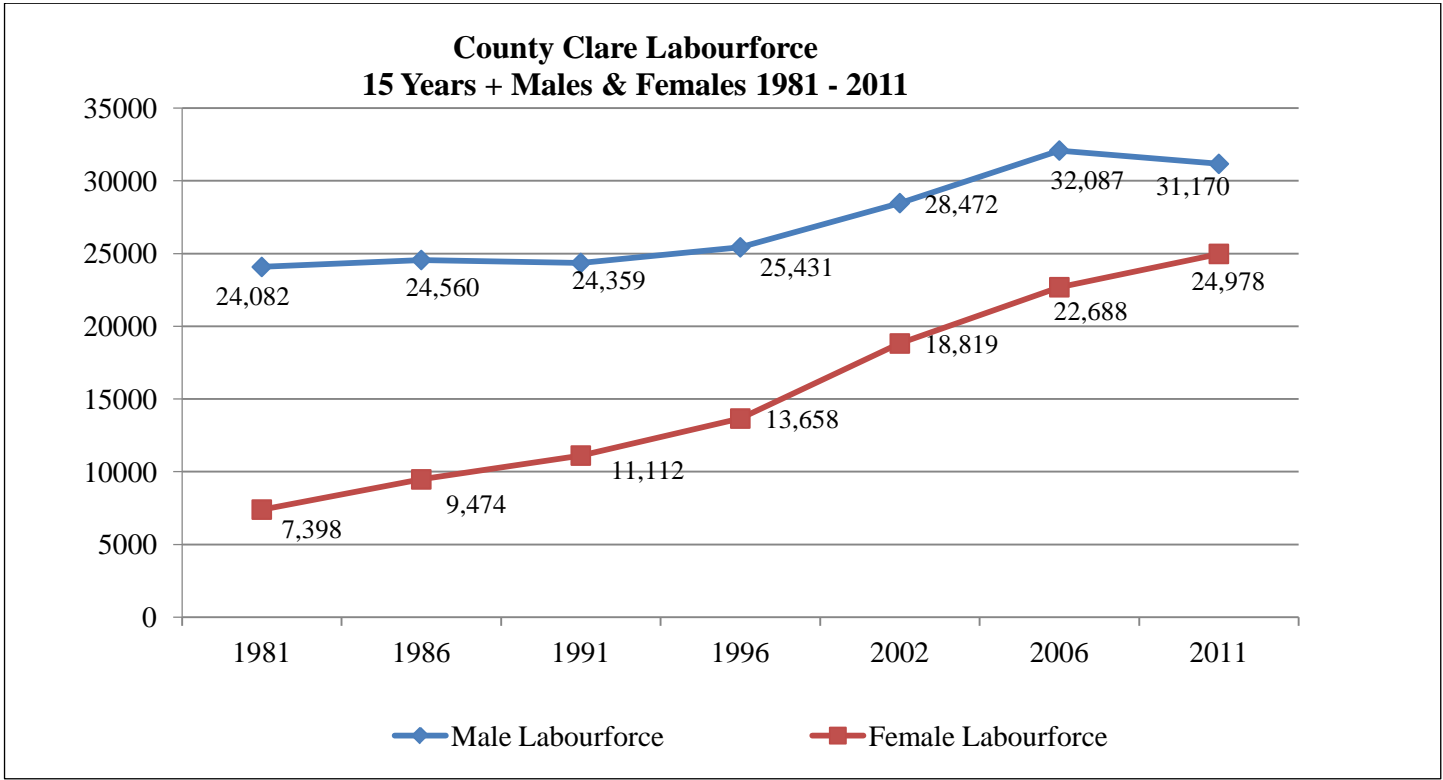

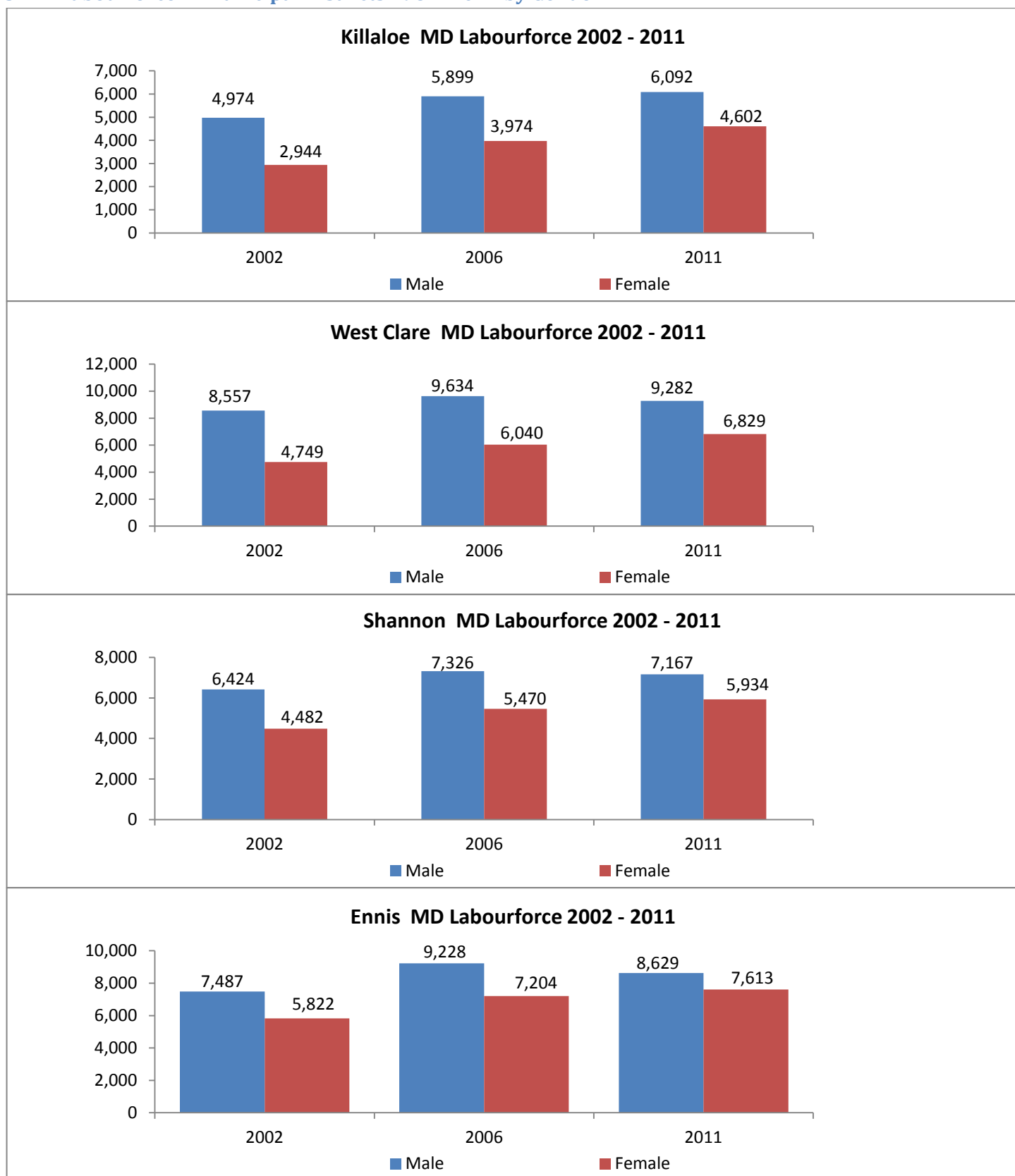
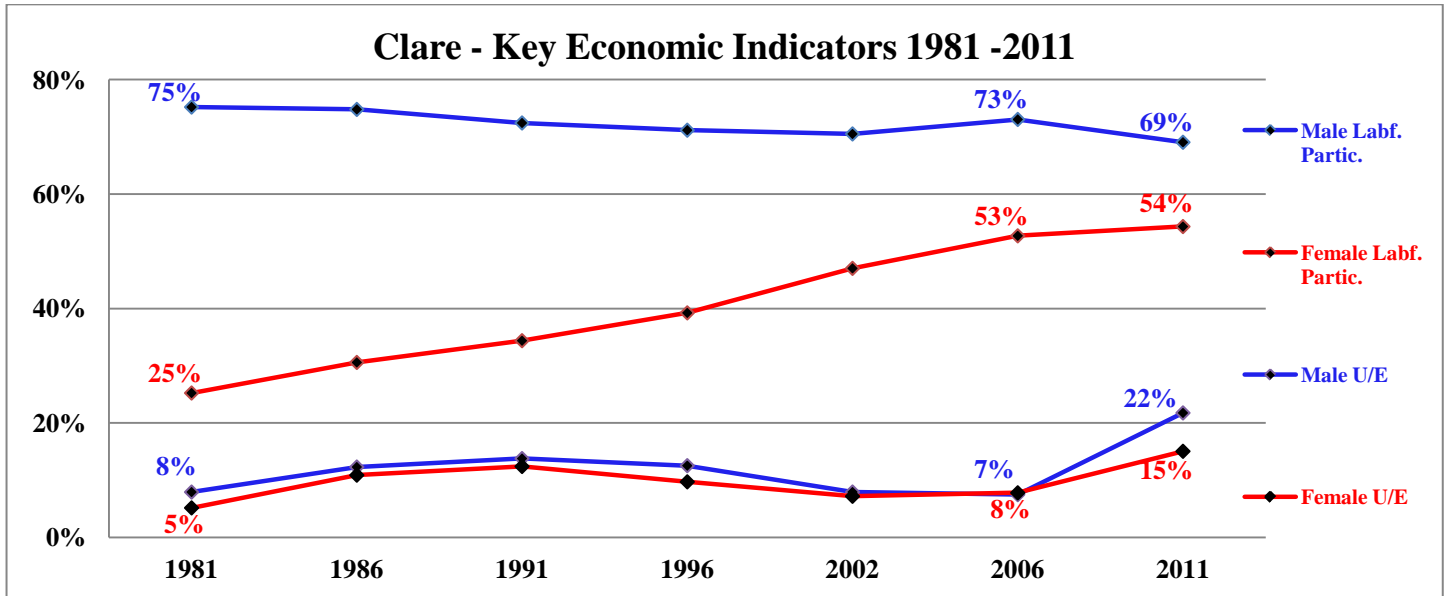
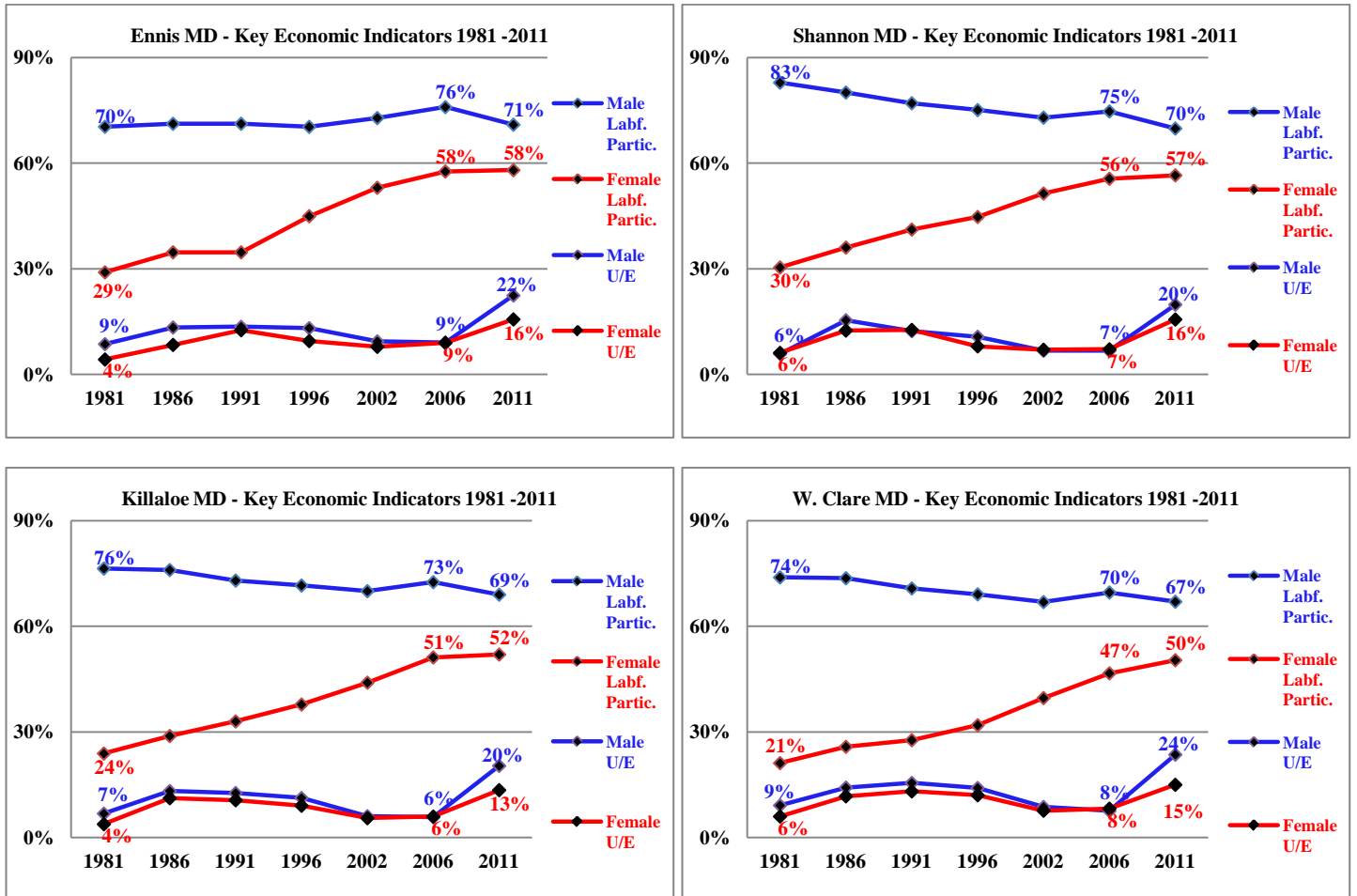


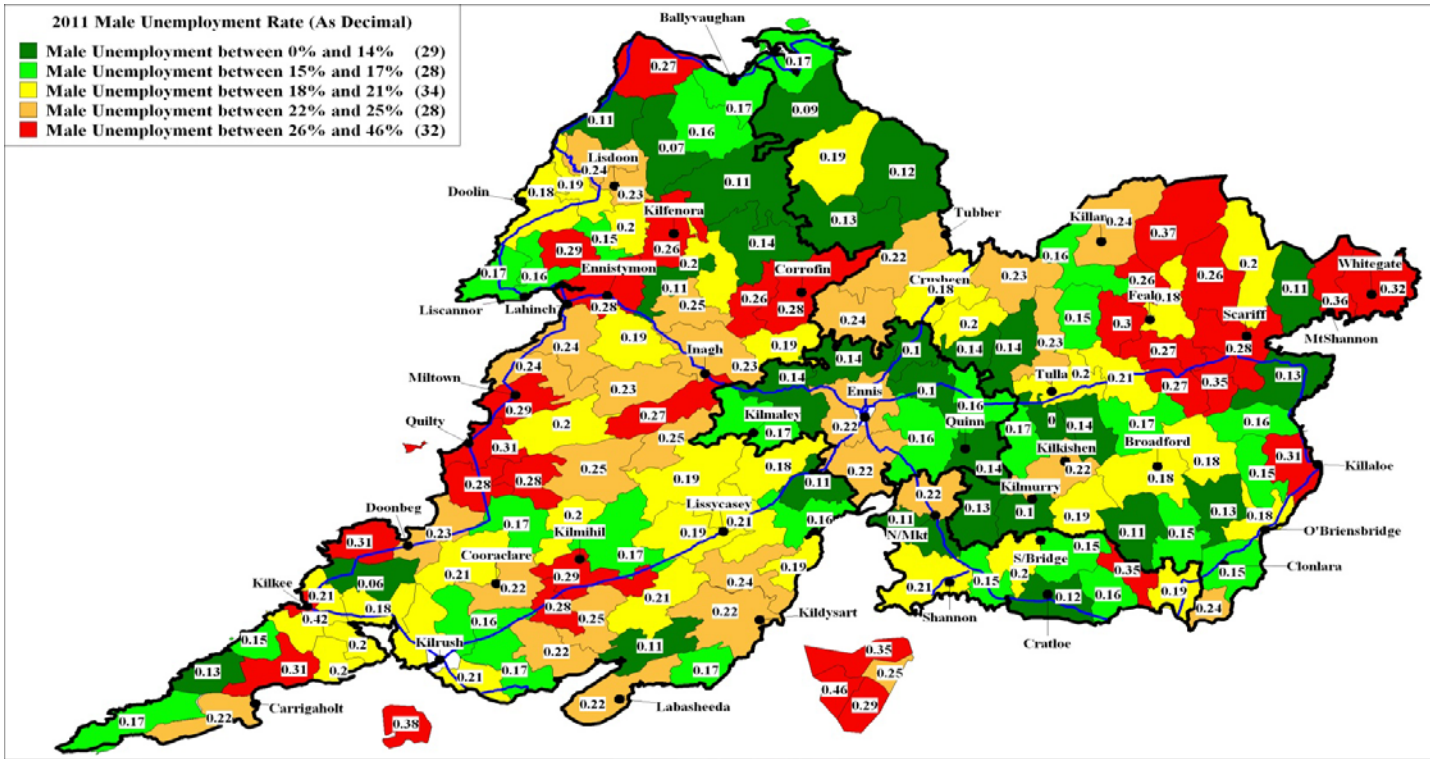
Diagram 3.7.2. Clare Rates of Labourforce Participation and Unemployment 1981 - 2011

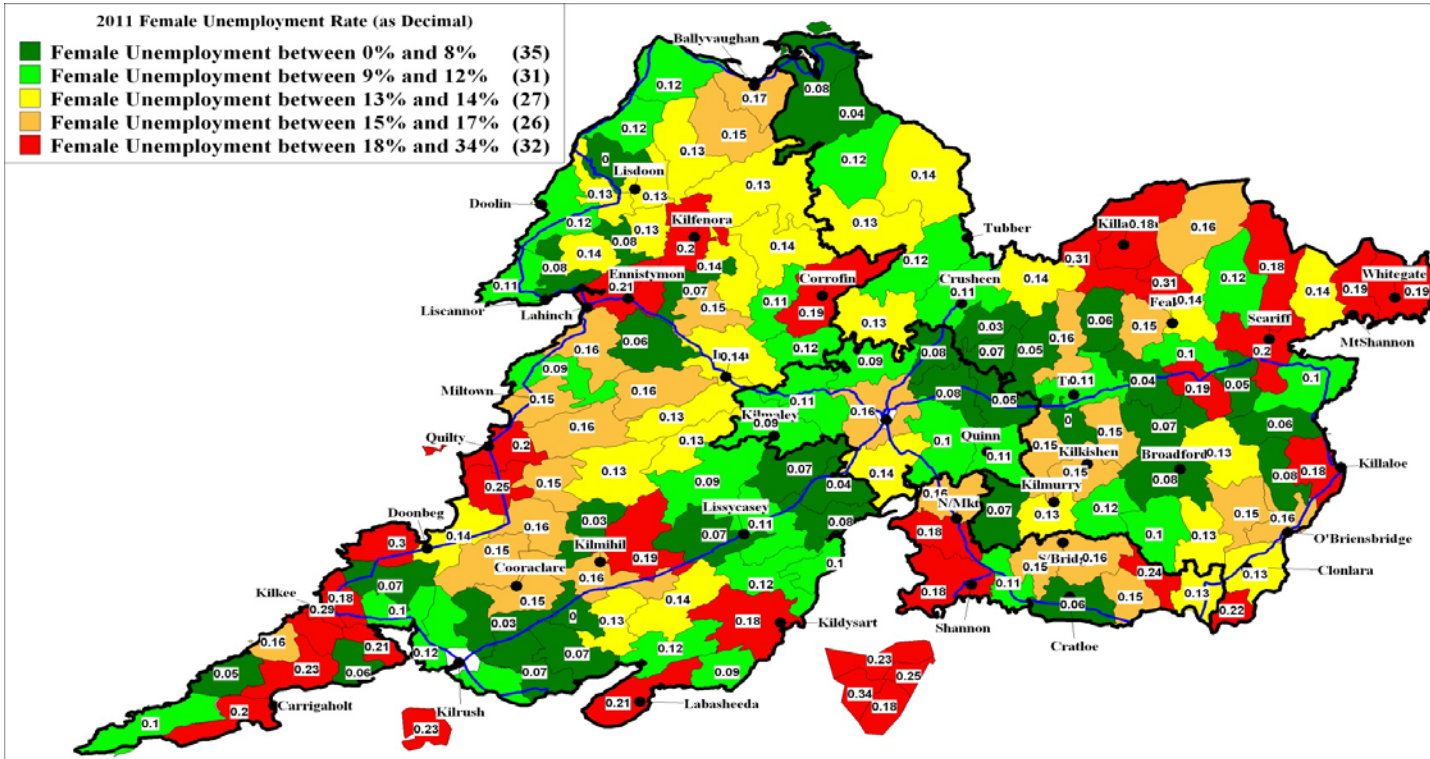


Diagram 3.7.4. Clare Live Register Feb 2006 – Feb 2015

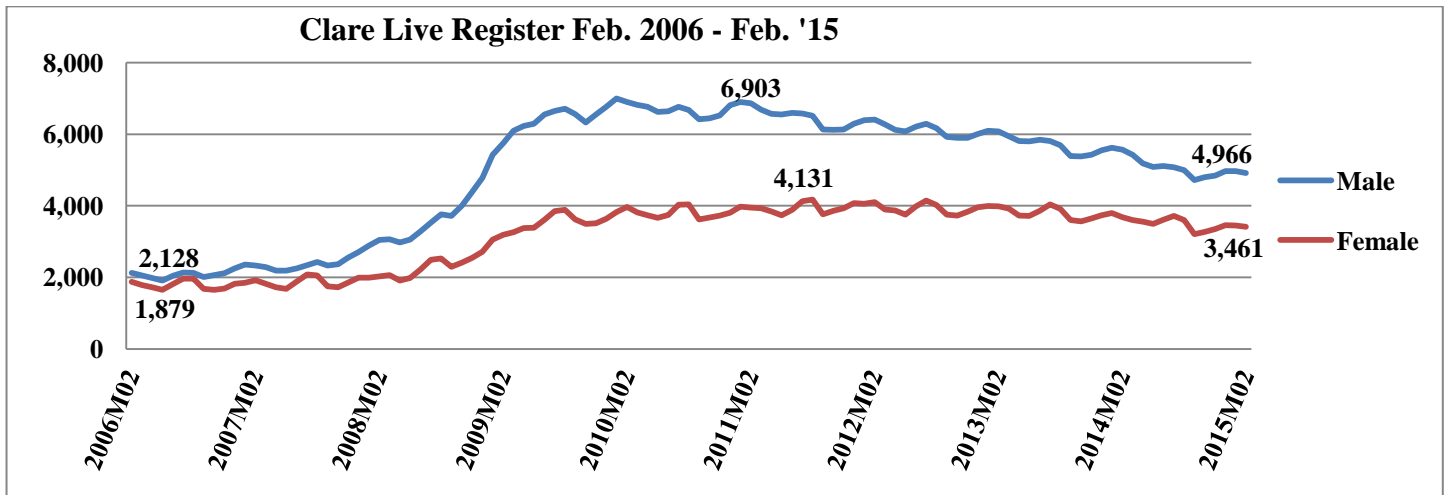


Diagram 3.7.5. Ennis DSP Office Live Register Feb 2006 – Feb 2015

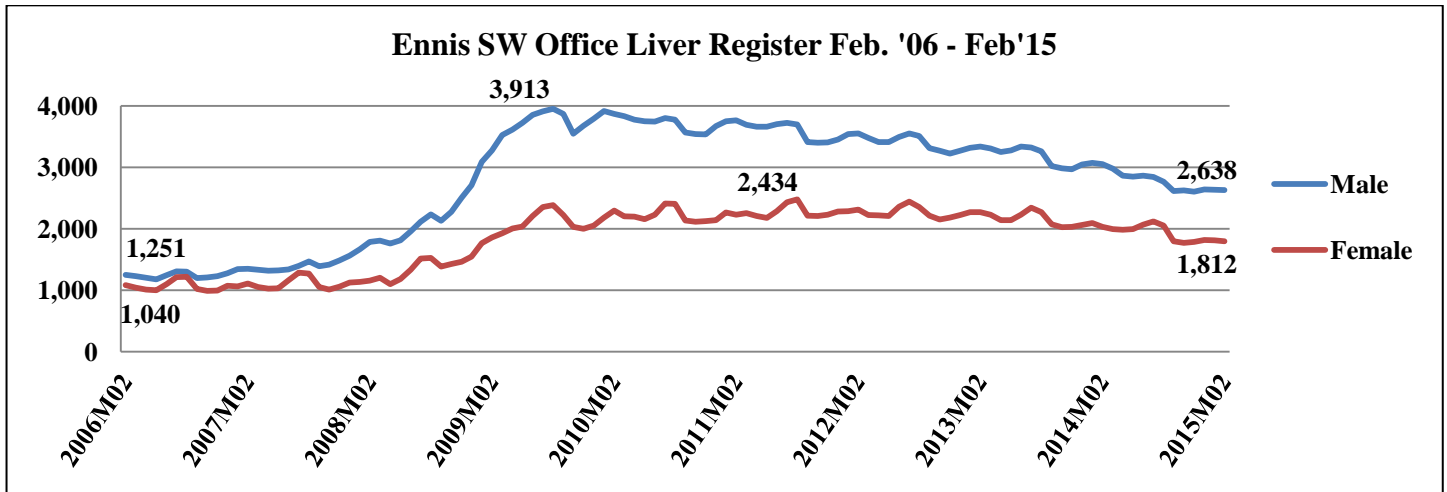


Diagram 3.7.6. Ennistymon DSP Office Live Register Feb 2006 – Feb 2015

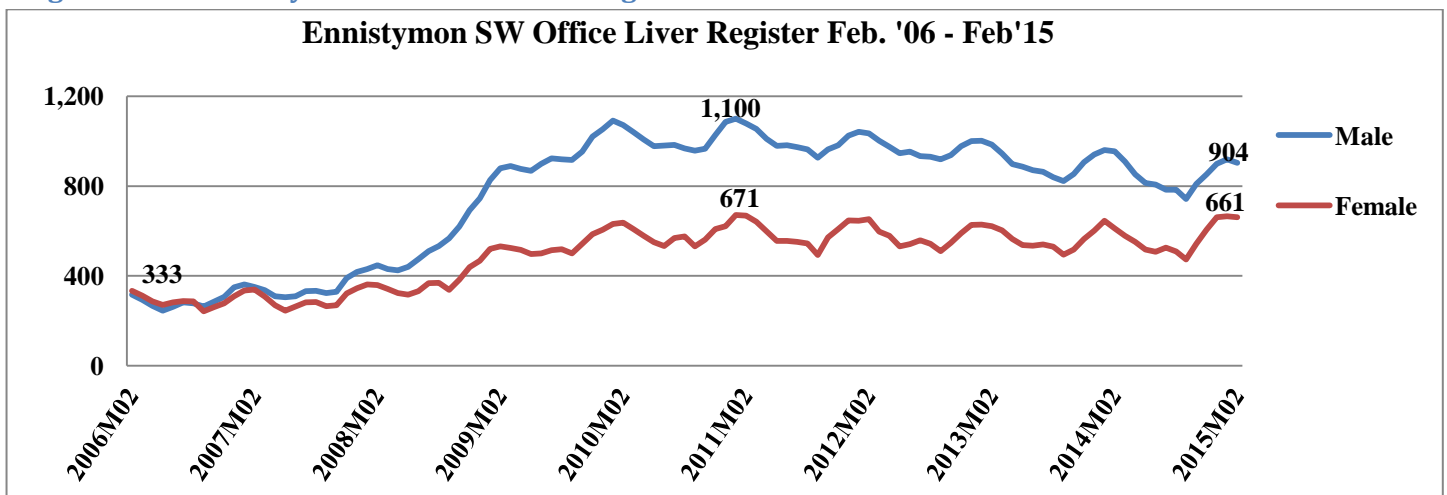


Diagram 3.7.7. Kilrush DSP Office Live Register Feb 2006 – Feb 2015

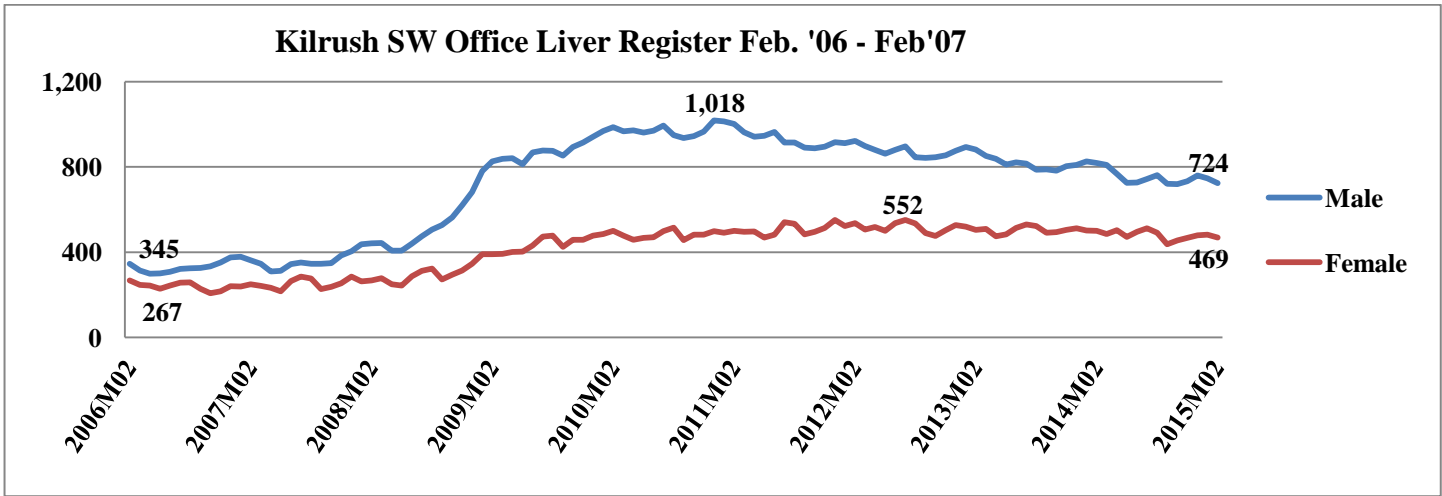
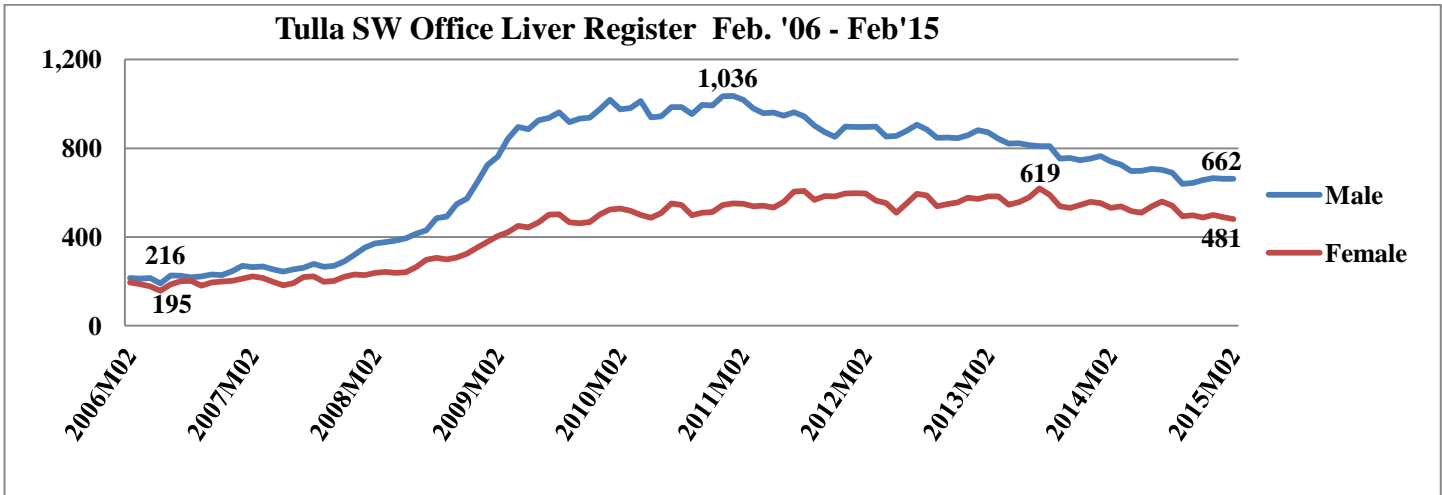


Diagram 3.7.8. Tulla DSP Office Live Register Feb 2006 – Feb 2015

Diagram 4.2.1. 1996 Unemployment Rates by Level Education by County and MD

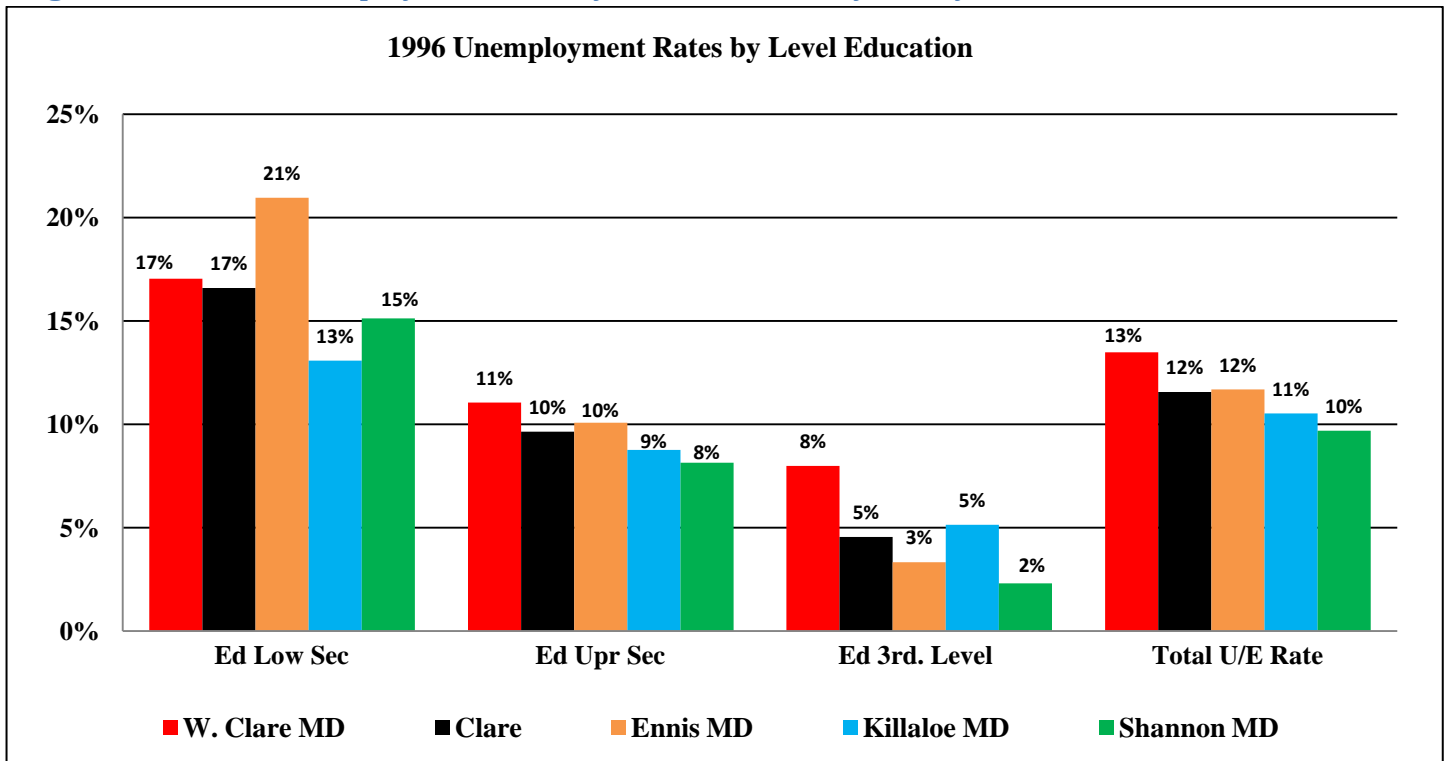
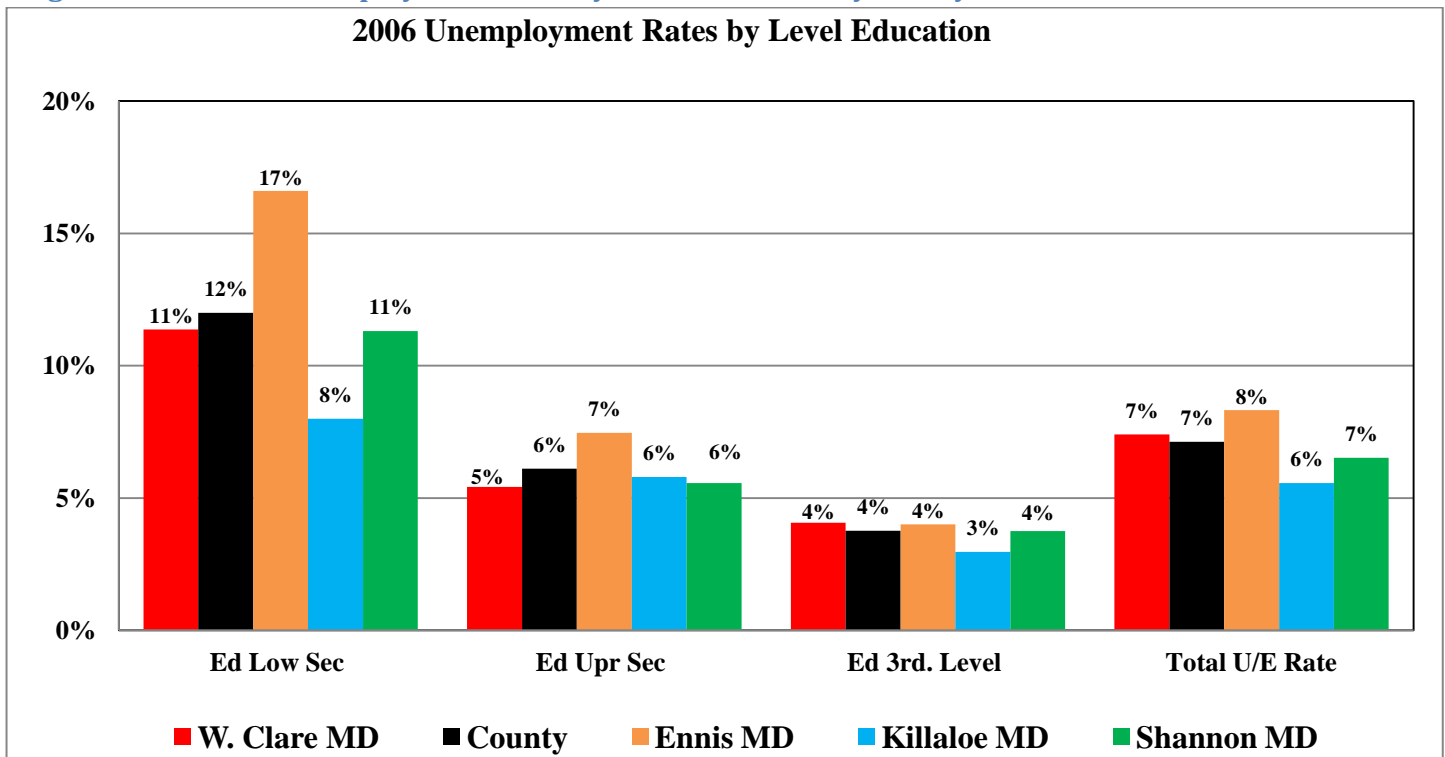


Diagram 4.2.2. 2006 Unemployment Rates by Level Education by County and MD

Diagram 4.3.1. 1991 Clare At Work by Education by Sex

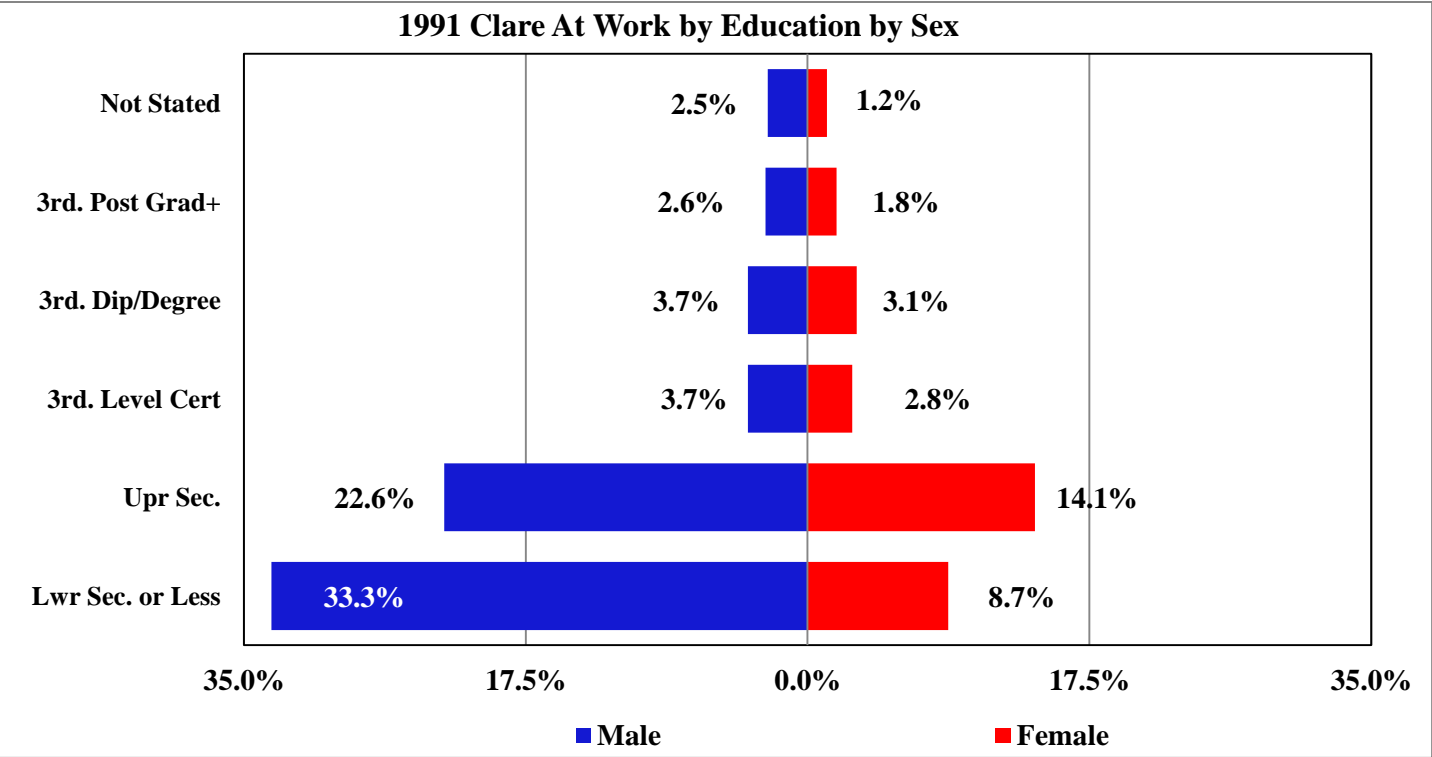
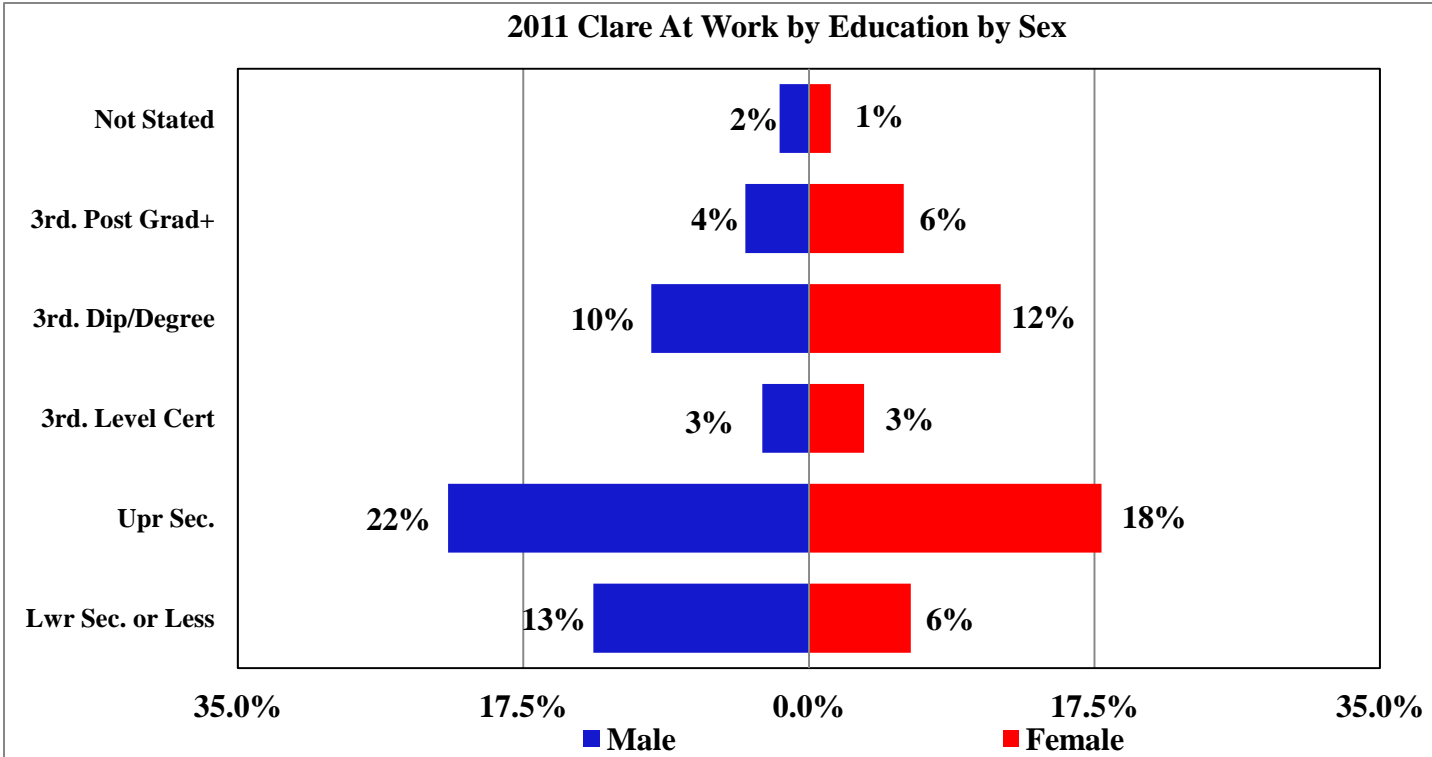
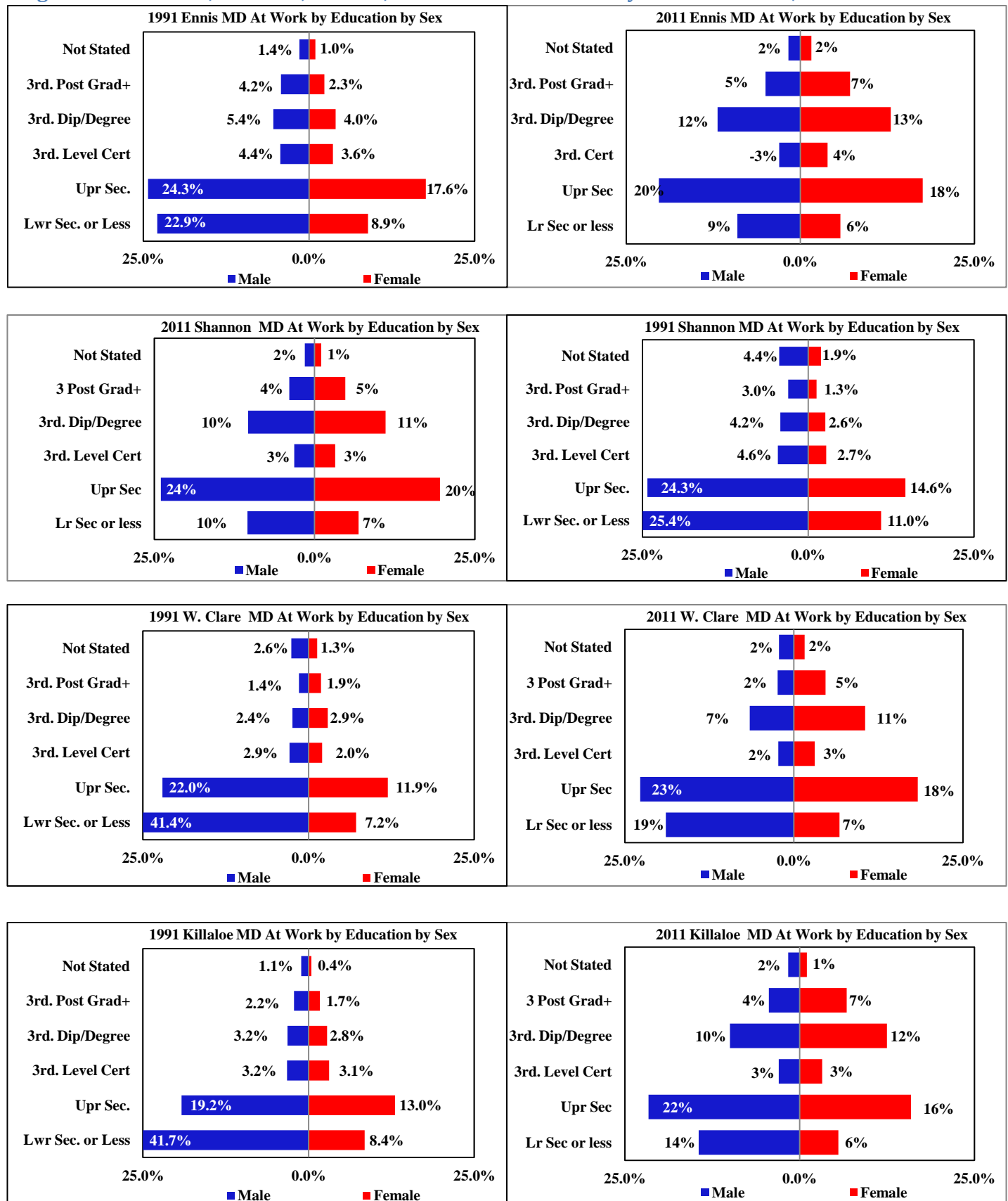


Diagram 4.3.2. 2011 Clare At Work by Education by Sex



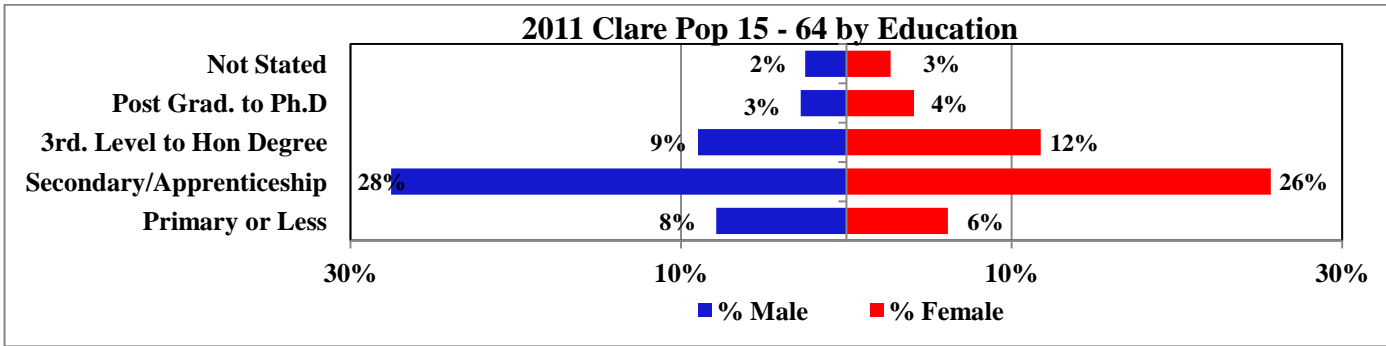

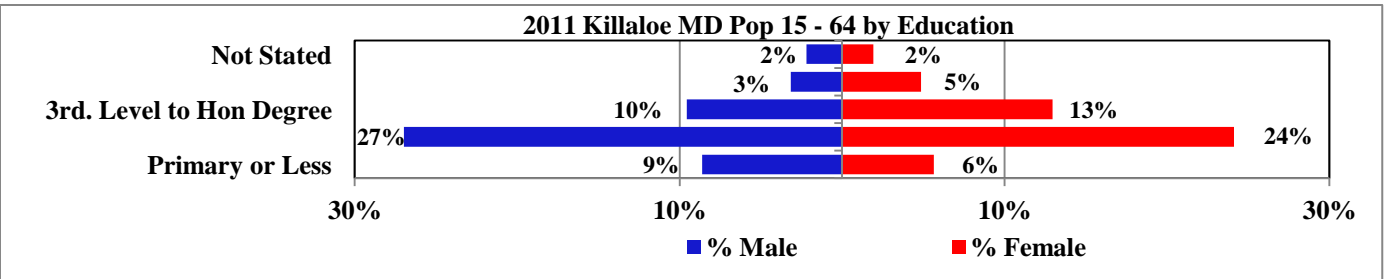
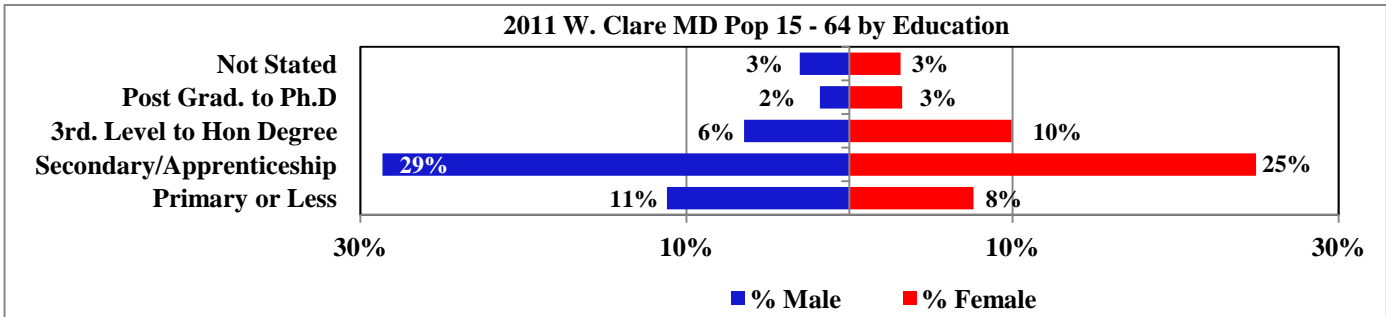
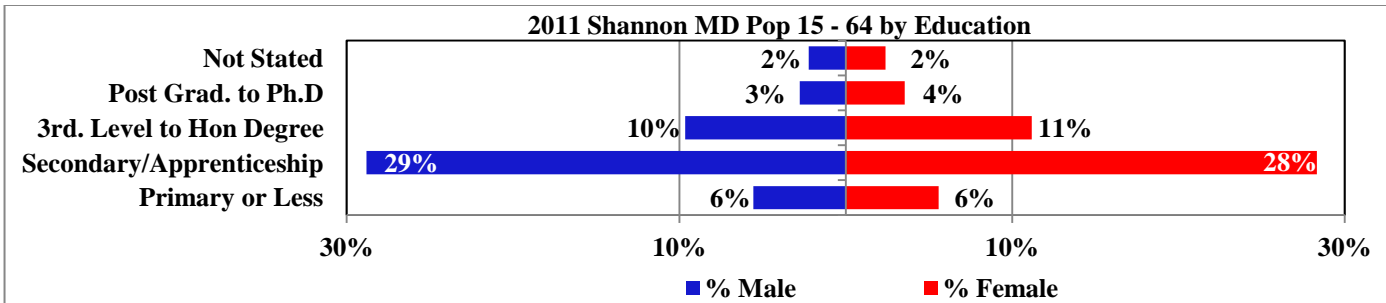
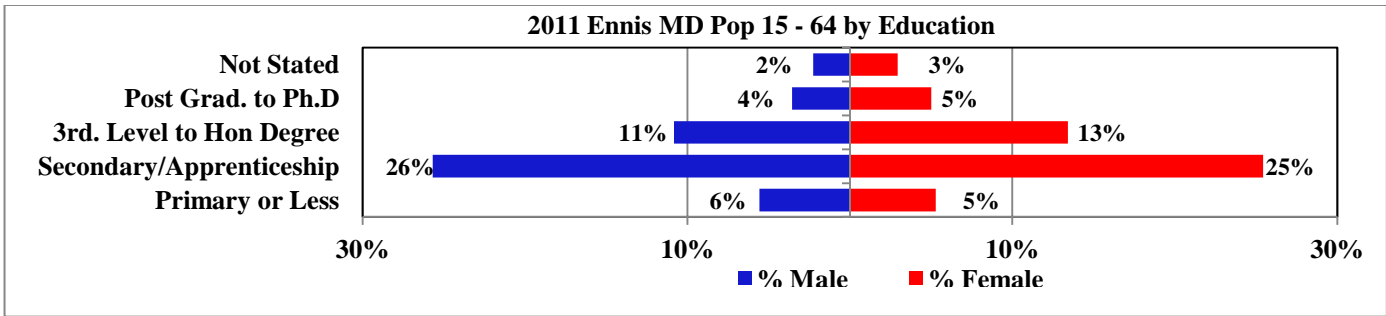


Diagram 4.4.3 Change in % of 15-64 with lower Secondary Education or Less by MD

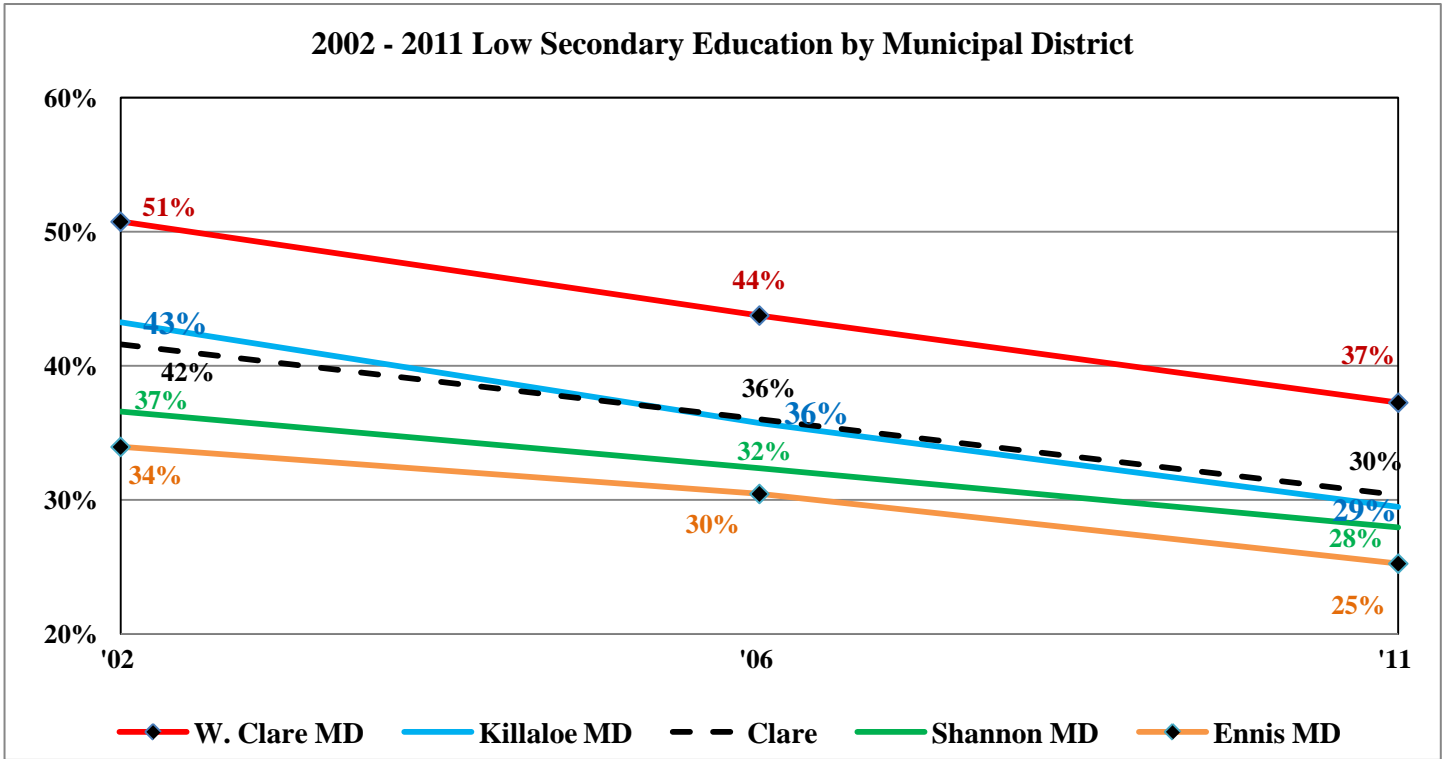
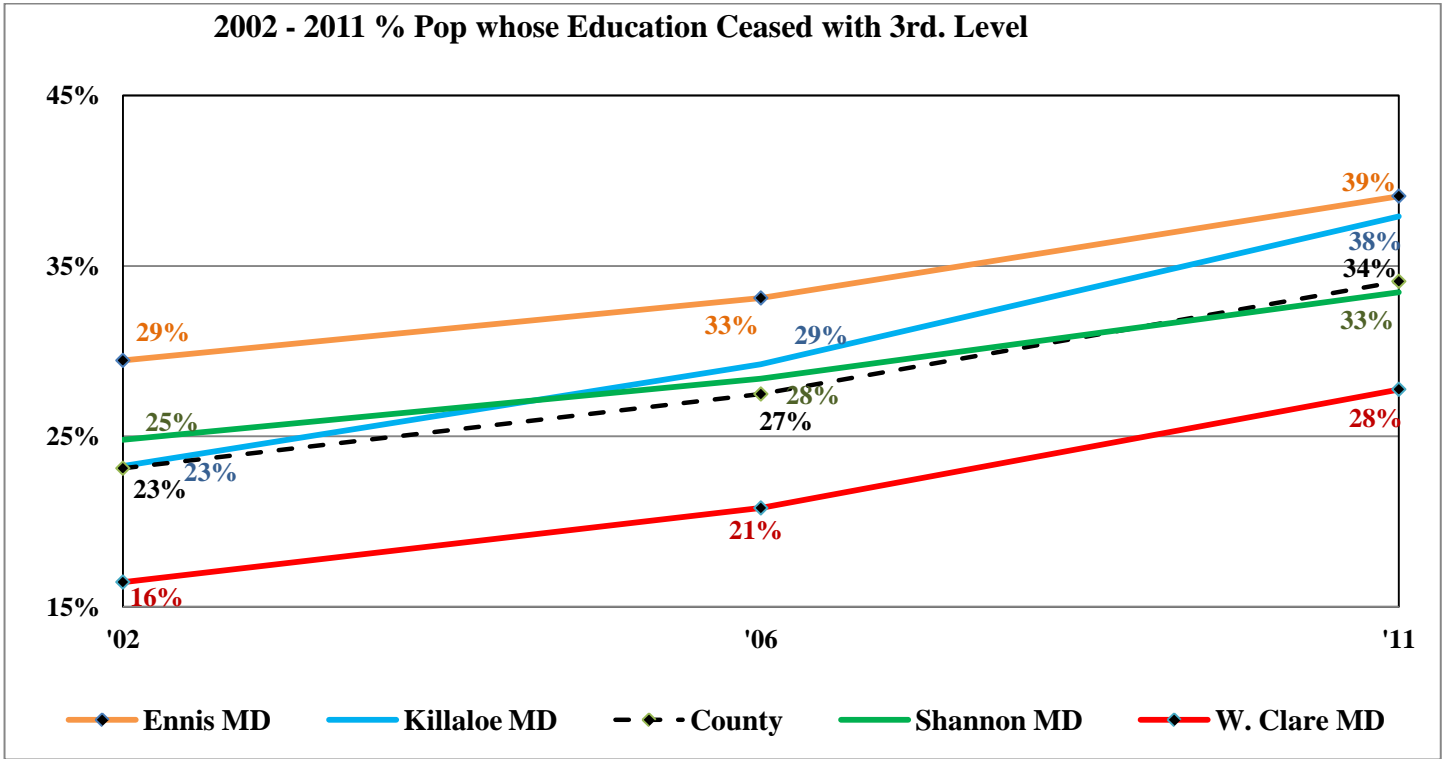


Diagram 4.4.4 Change in % of 15-64 with 3rd. Level Education by County and MD

Diagram 5.2.1. 60% of National Median Equivalised Individual Income 2008 - 2013

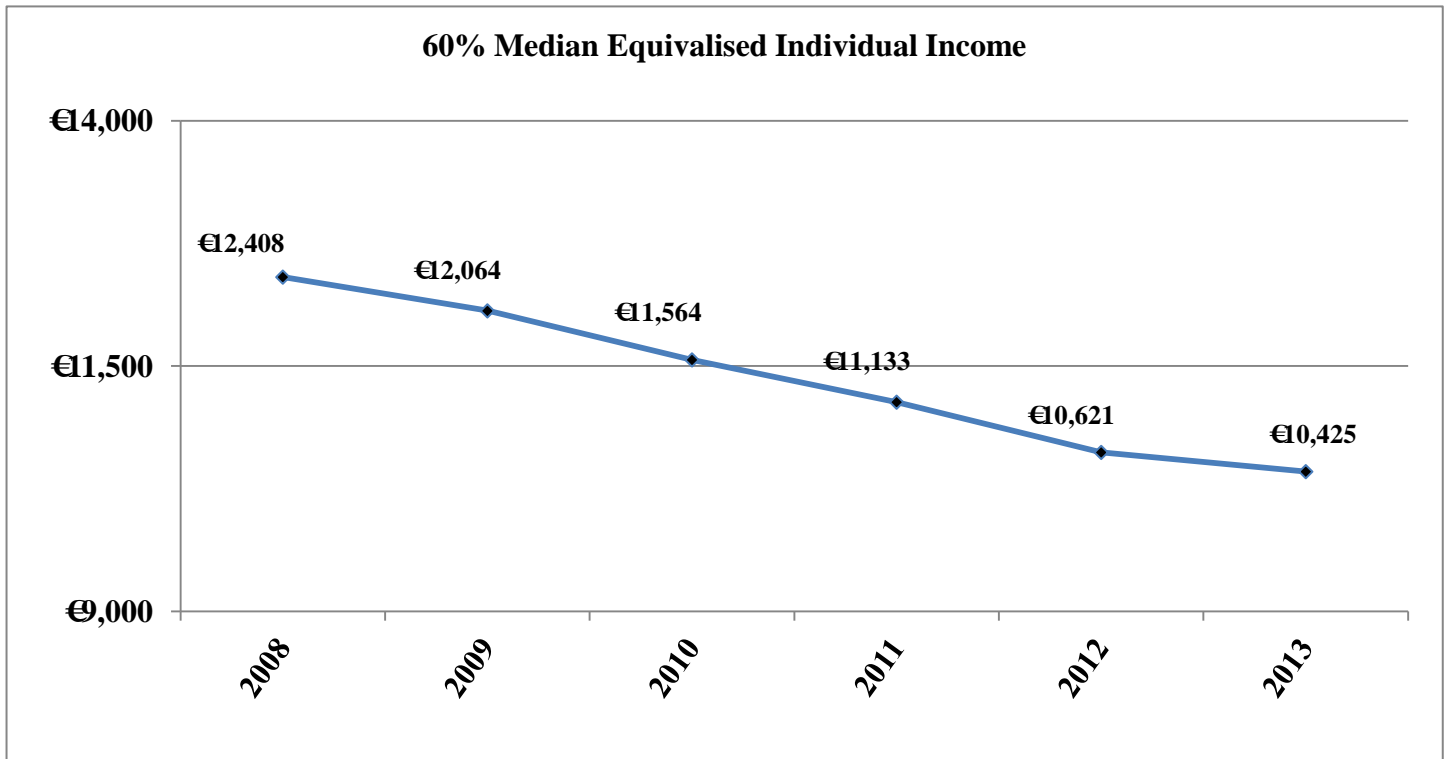


Diagram 5.2.2. National Poverty Rates 2008 - 2013

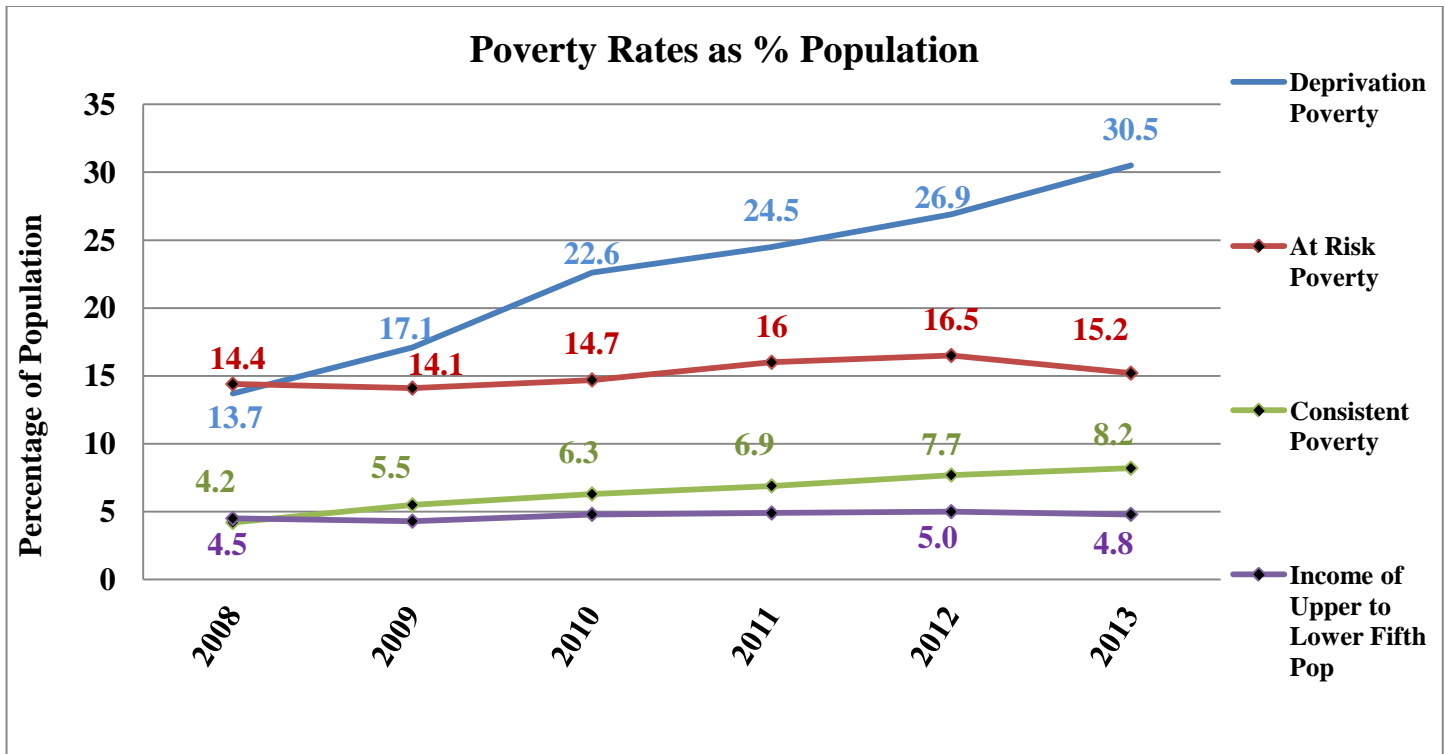


Diagram 5.2.2.1. National Income Poverty Rates by Category 2013

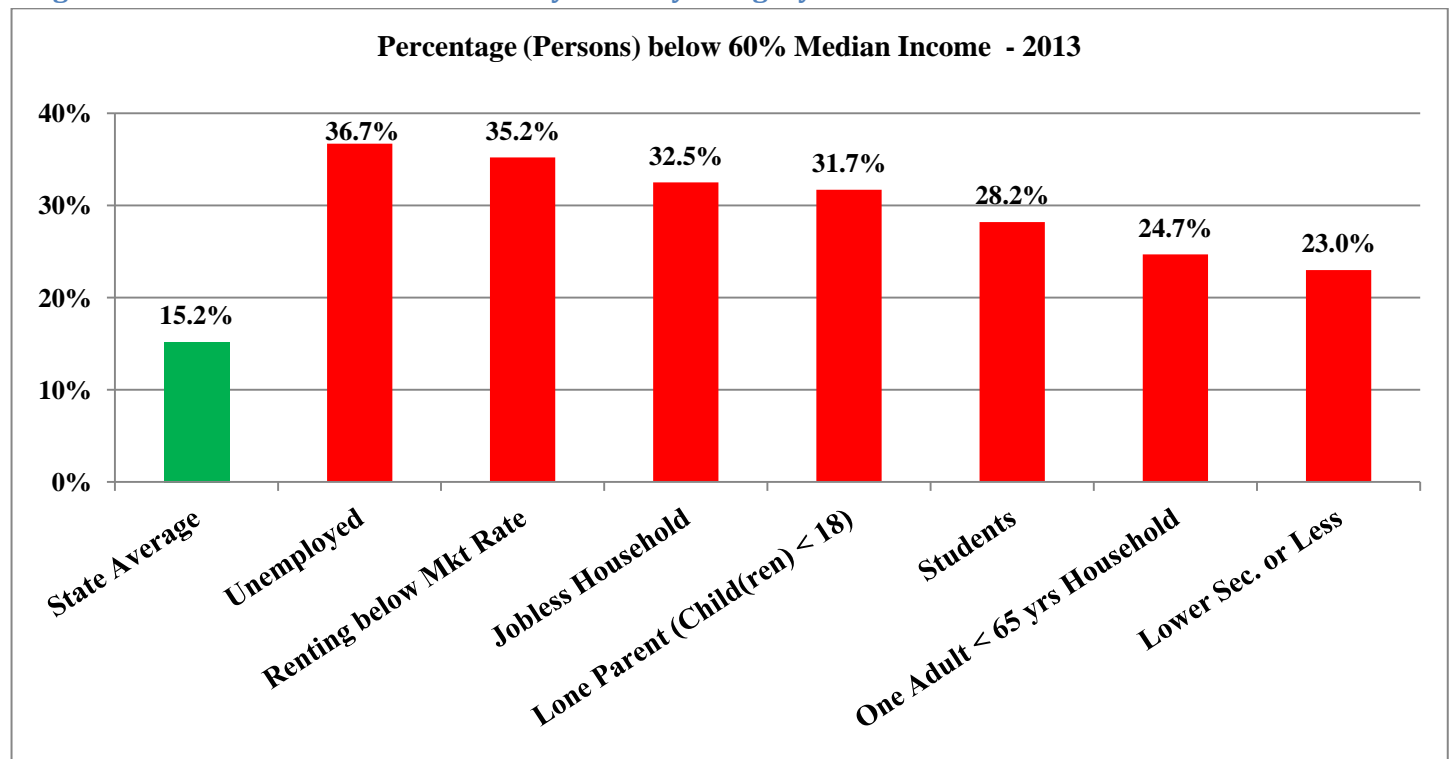


Diagram 5.2.2.2. National Deprivation Rates by Category 2013

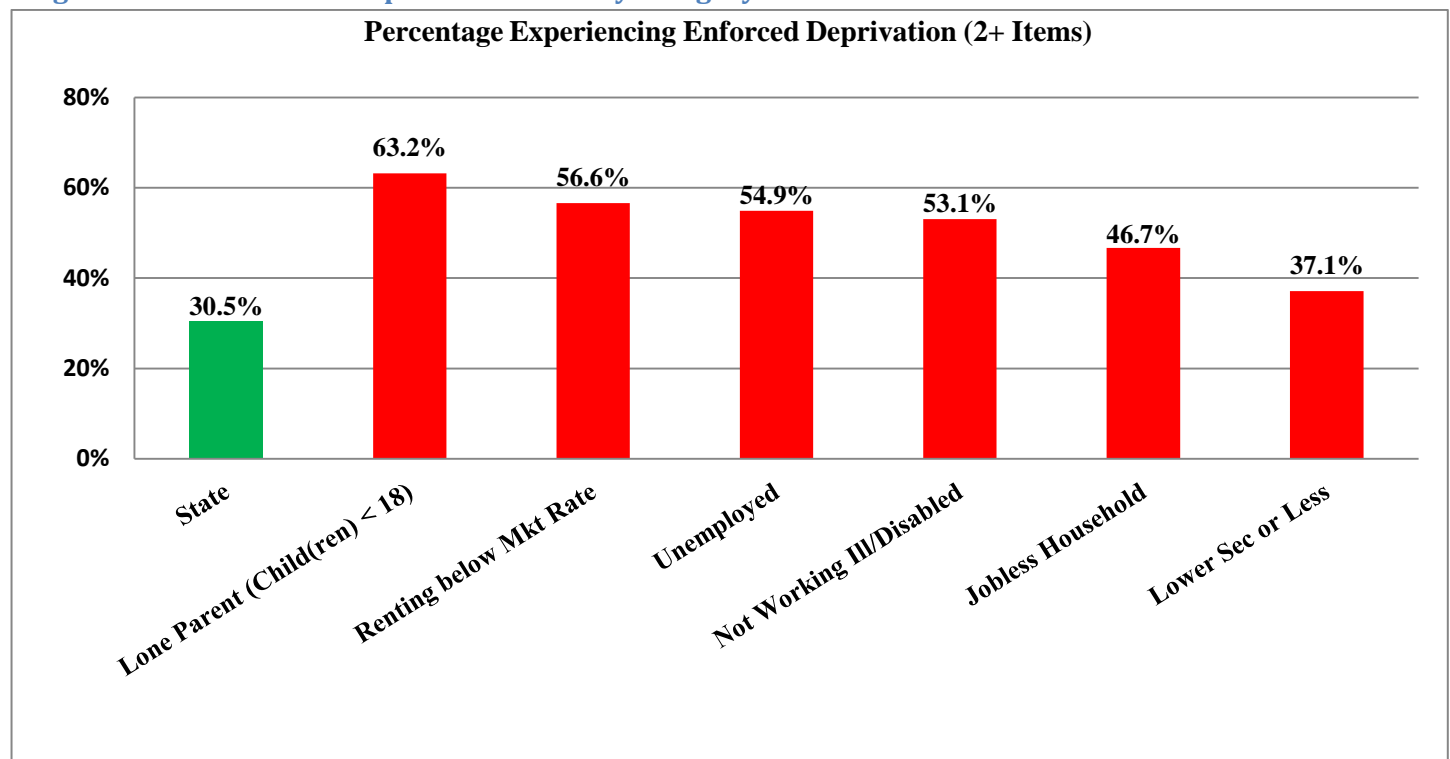
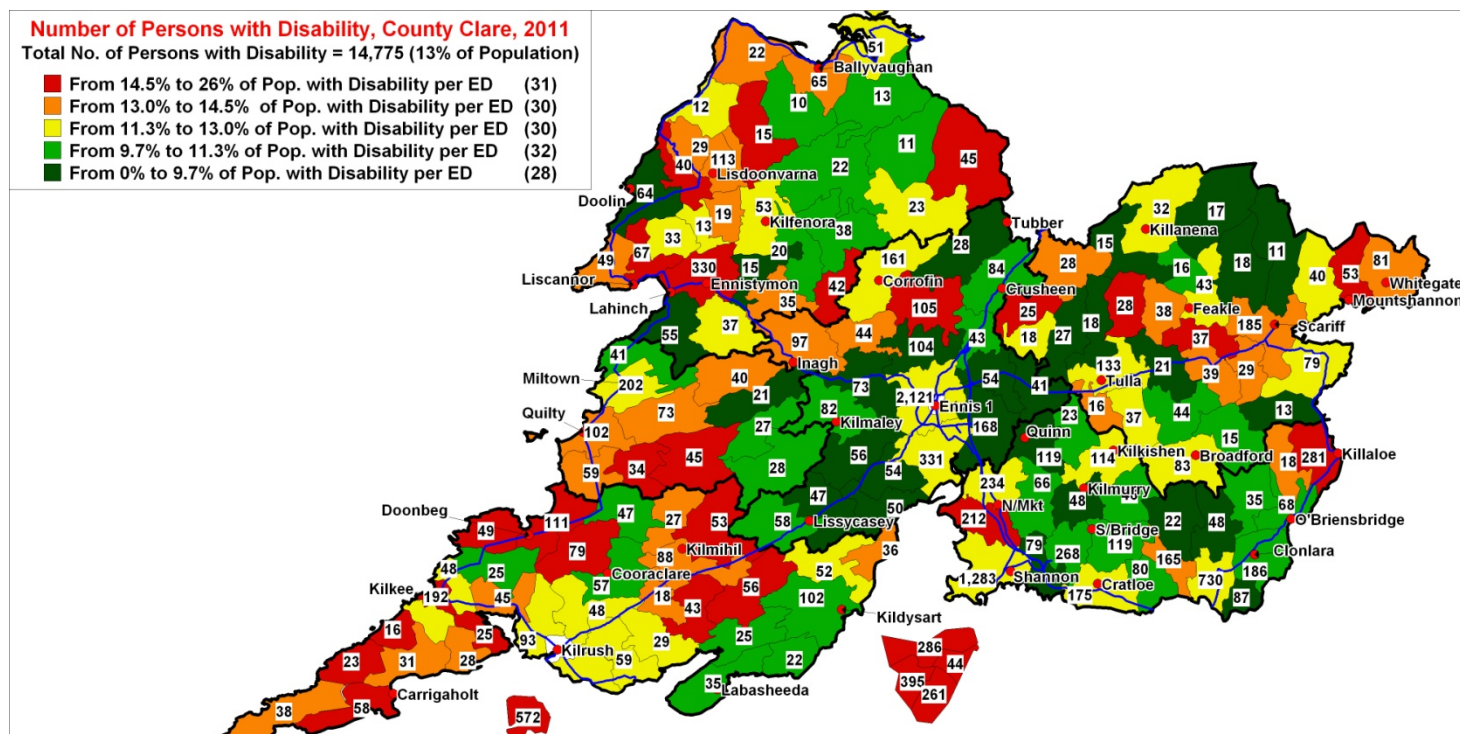


Diagram 5.2.2.3. Consistent Poverty Rates by Category 2013



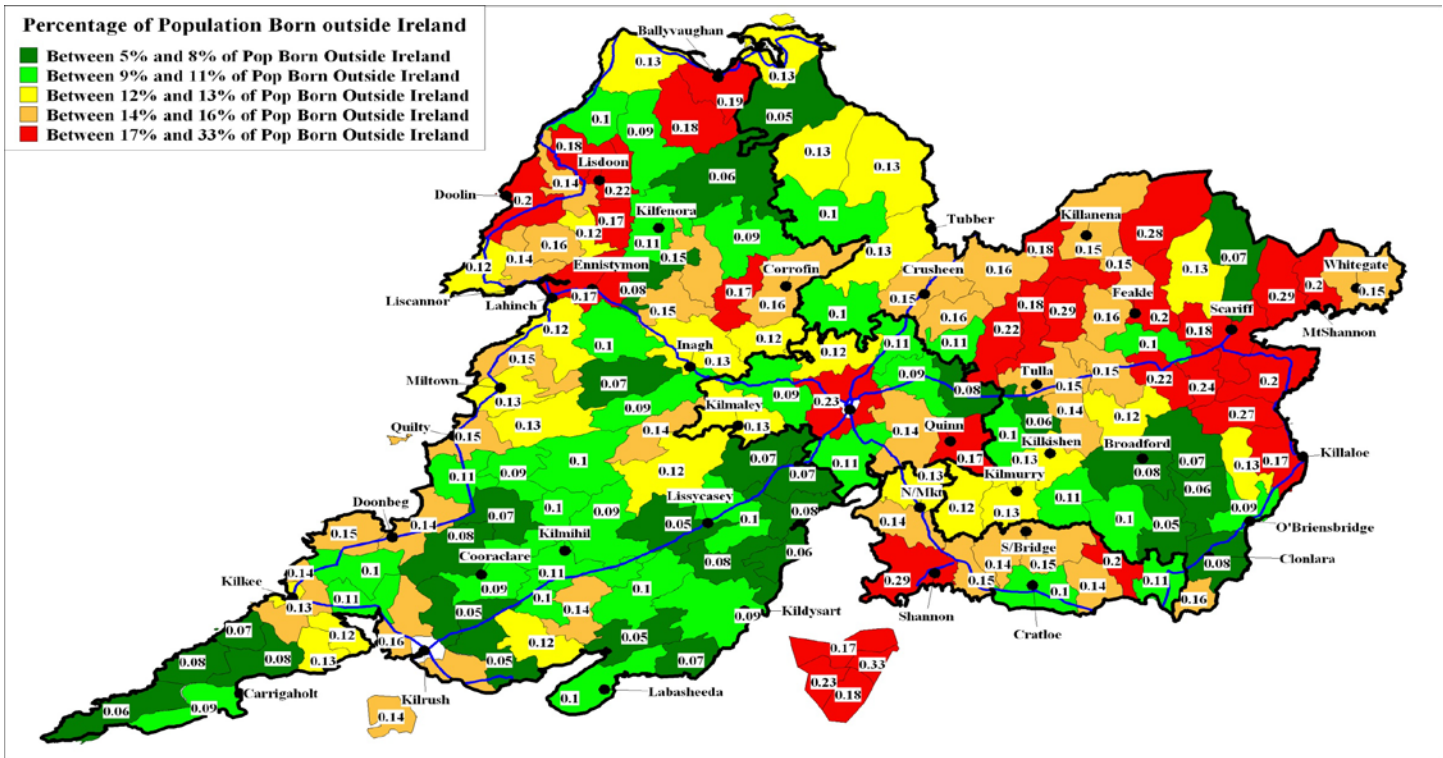


Map 5.2.2.2. Number of Persons with Disability in County Clare, 2011

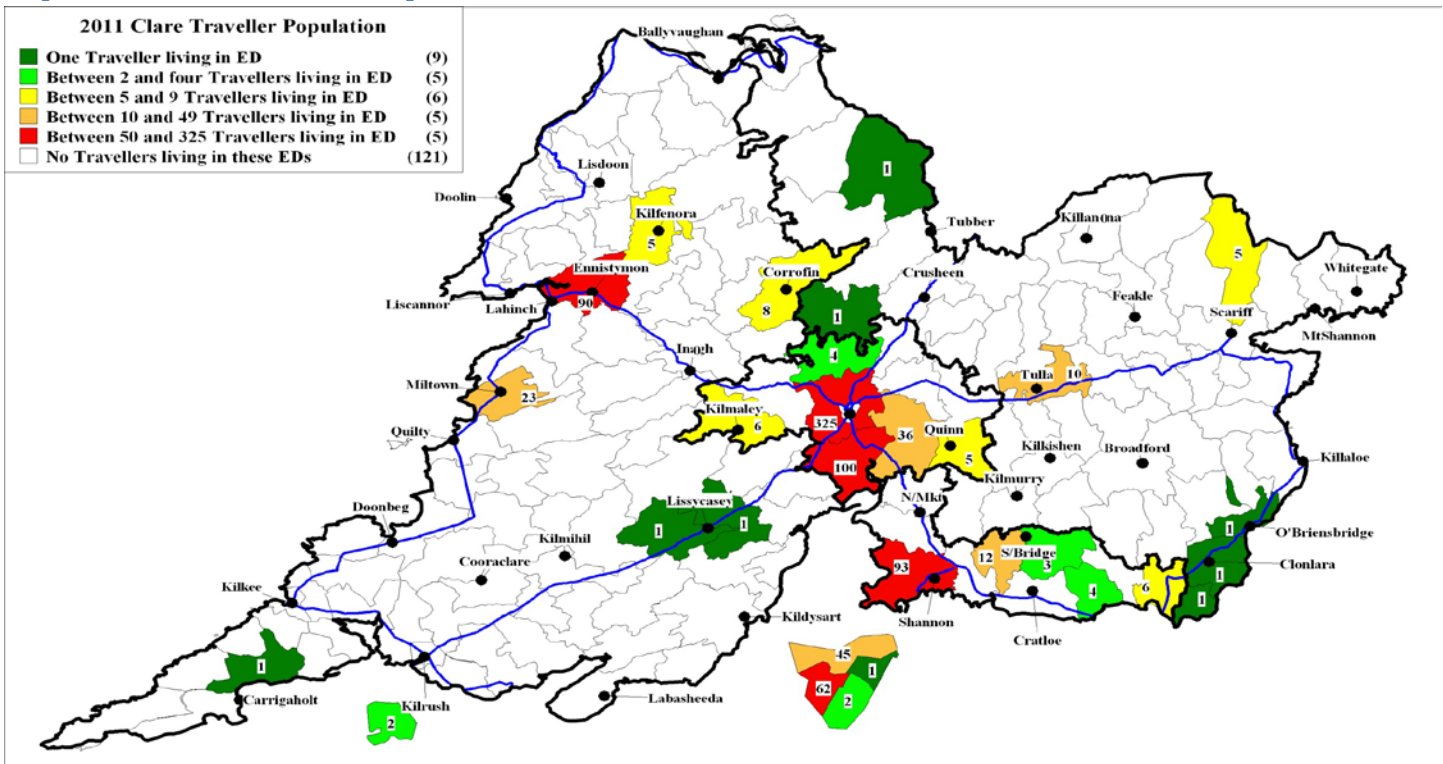

Map 5.3.1.1 % of Population Born Outside Ireland 2011

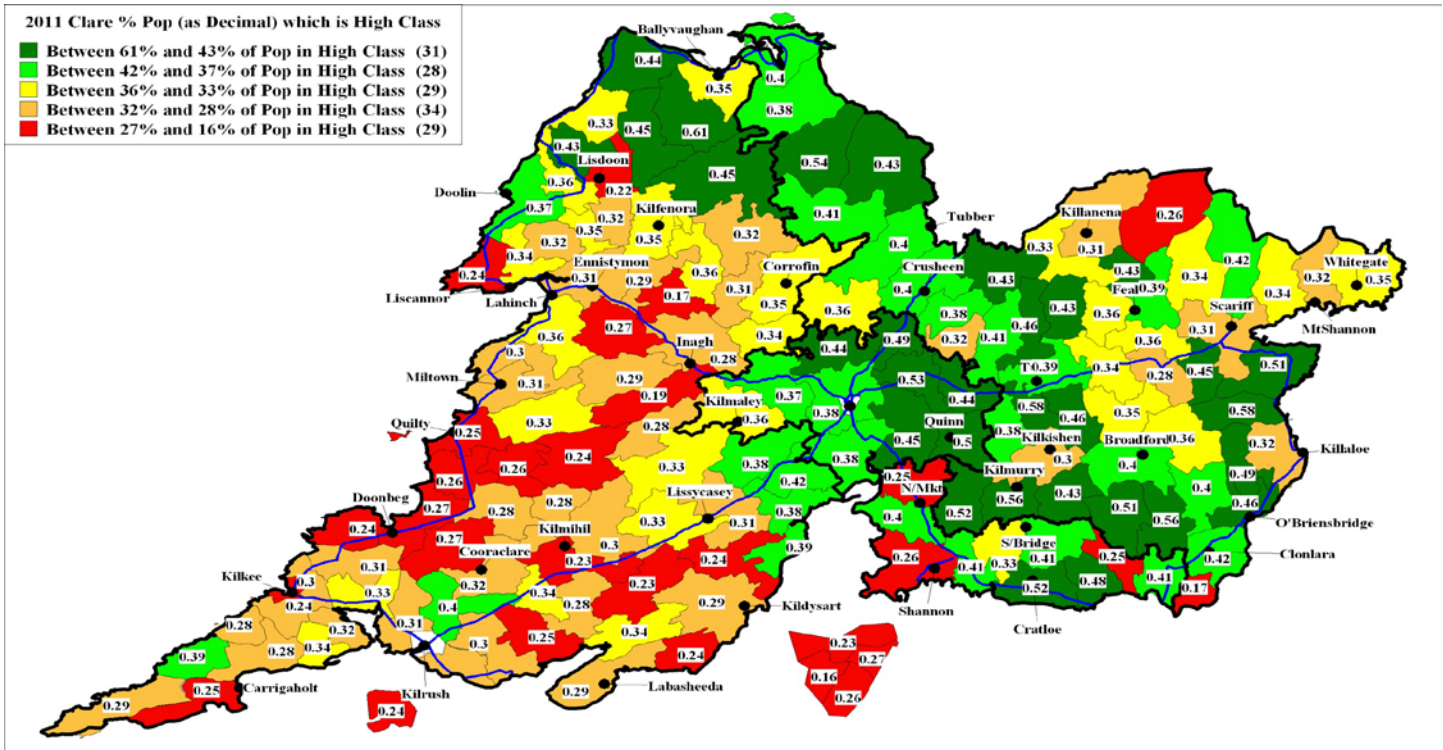


Map 5.3.1.2 Clare Traveller Population 2011

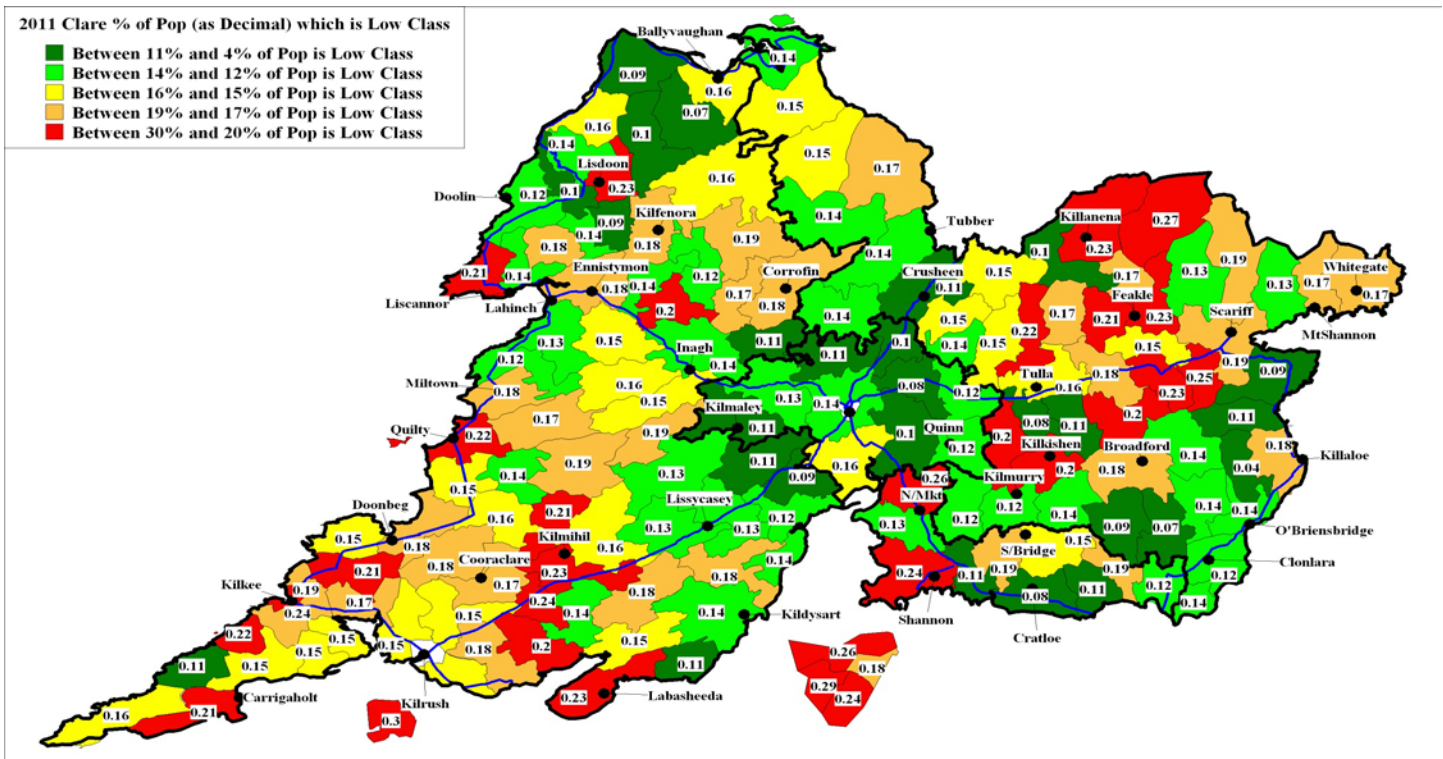




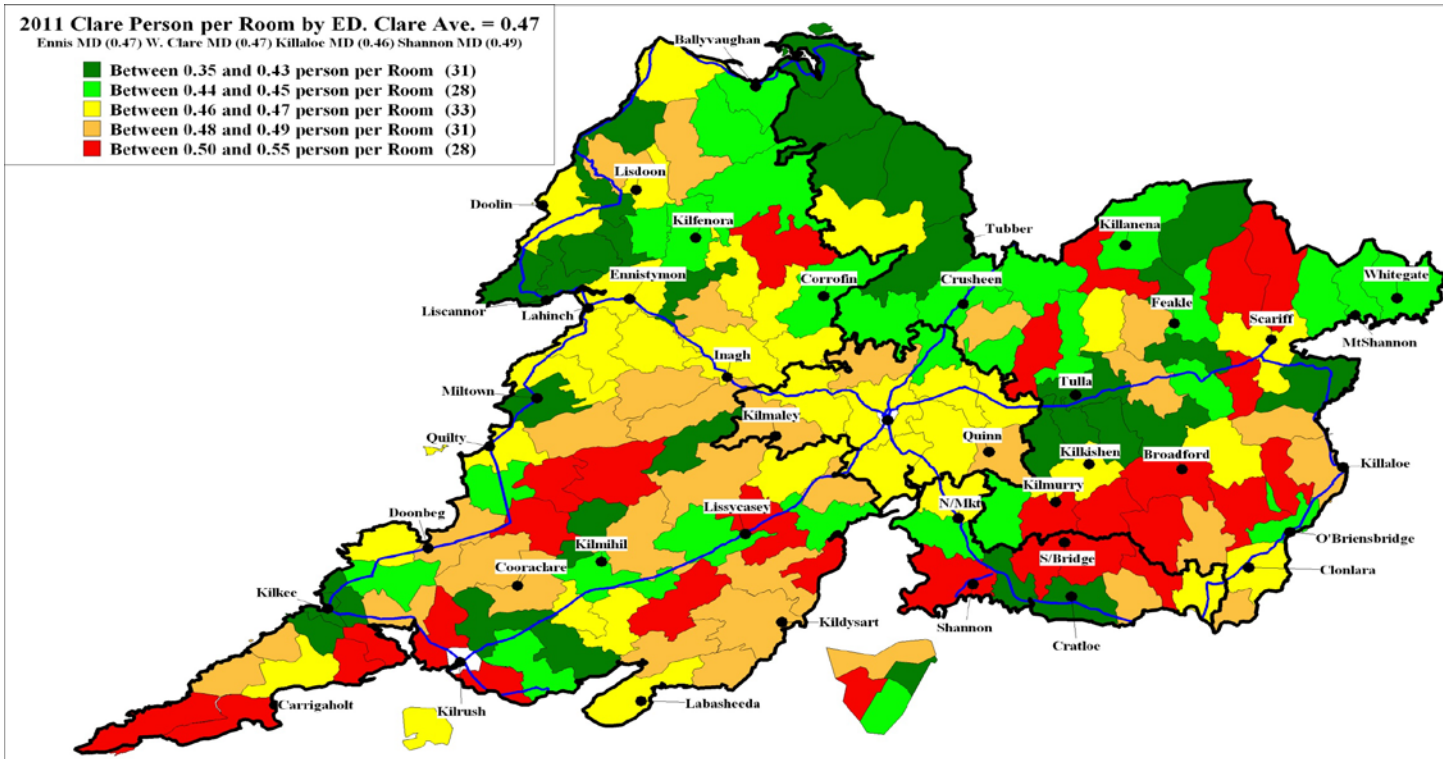
Map 5.3.1.2a Clare % Population which is High Class 2011



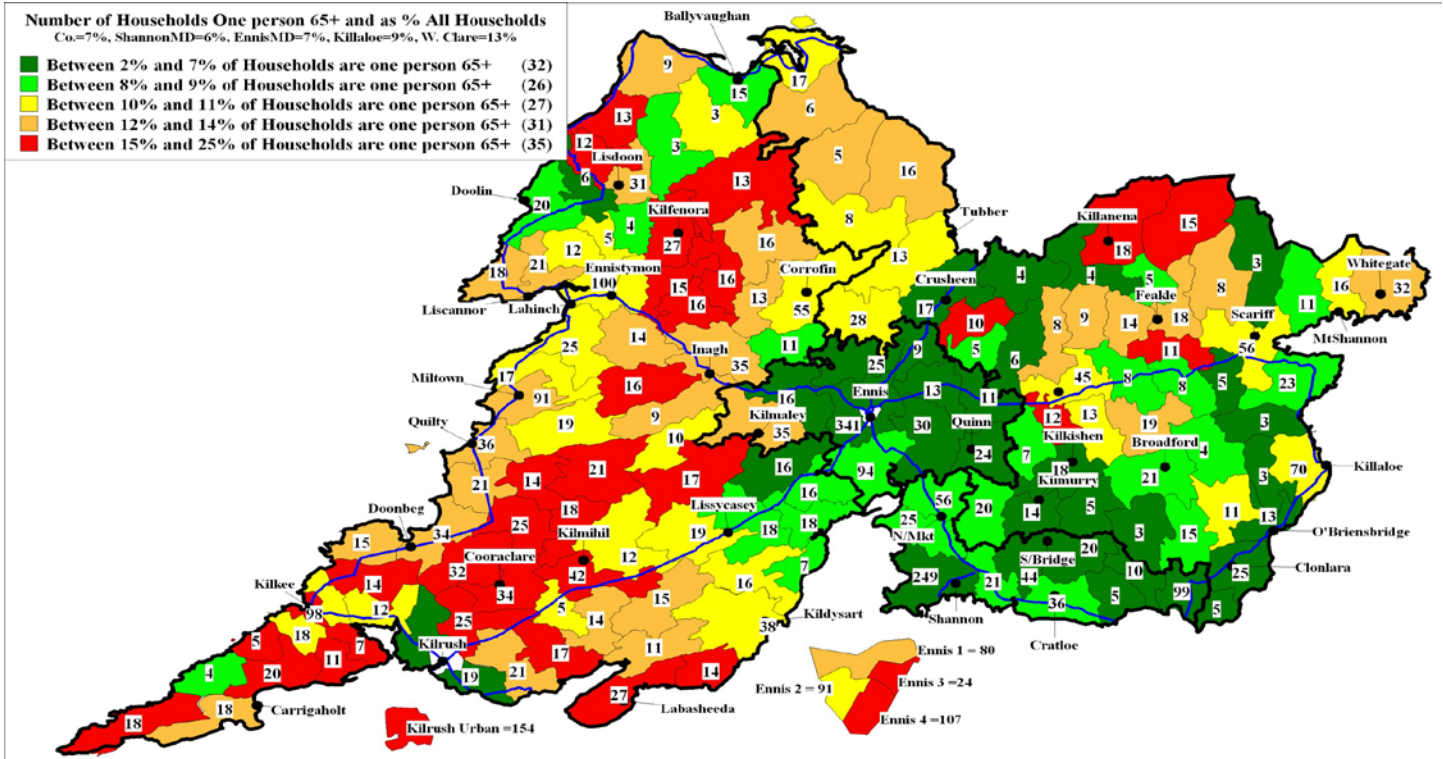
Map 5.3.1.2b Clare % Population which is Low Class 2011

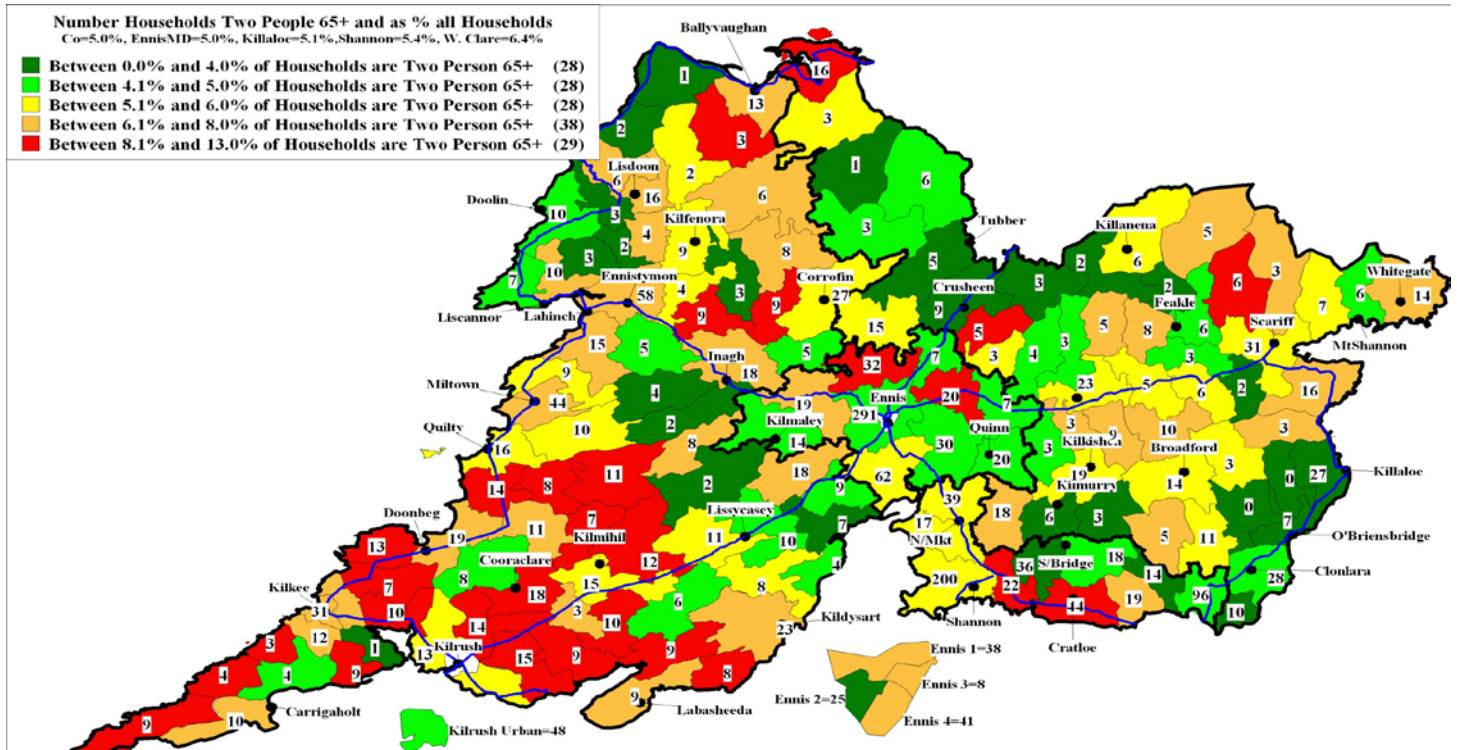


Map 5.3.1.7a. Number of Households with One Person 65 years +
