

Underpinned by its unique social history, built heritage and riverside setting, the growing town of Sixmilebridge will benefit from improved local shops, community facilities and employment opportunities. Existing heritage buildings will be brought back into productive use and new river crossings and public open spaces will radically improve the relationship between the town and the O'Garney River.

Supported by measures designed to limit the impact of through traffic, the town's key public spaces will be transformed. A new market square and river crossing in the commercial heart of the town will help to attract more people and activities to the centre; a new space at The Green will help to bring together and support key local community facilities; and the space on Frederick Square will be a high-quality new gateway to Sixmilebridge alongside an expanded industrial and business campus.





Q5 Additional comments on movement and access




There were 81 additional comments about movement and access

Most additional comments concerned topics and areas covered by the sustainable movement and access objectives, including the narrow bridge and lack of pavement, parking issues by Centra and the desire for more cycling infrastructure and better walking environments.

Additional comments included ensuring there was enough **disabled parking**, improving **public transport** to nearby towns, and the airport, as well as a few comments on promoting a **carfree** Sixmilebridge.

PR1. Improve access to and new routes across the river – Sixmilebridge's principal natural asset




There were 59 additional comments about the public realm and envionment

Security and maintenance were key concerns from survey respondents, especially in relation to **playgrounds**, which were also cited as being top priority for many.

Many commenters wanted to see better connections and **paths by the river** as well as parks to enjoy. A large number of comments were specifically about the need for more **bins**.



There were 45 additional comments about growth and investment


Most additional comments were about **town centre facilities** and echoed much of the growth and infrastructure objectives, including the call for more restaurants, facilities for young people and a bigger supermarket.

There were some concerns over how retail business growth would mean more cars in the town and how this would be balanced.

Some commenters wanted to see vacant buildings be brought back for **housing**.



Most comments were about raising awareness and celebrating the town's history. Many people wanted to see interpretation boards, information points and trails.


Others wanted to see **older buildings** be brought back into life.

Traffic calming and street improvements A number of potential improvements could be considered to help address these issues:

- a. Traffic calming some measures are already planned but more could be delivered including crossing facilities, 'raised tables' and carriageway narrowing/pinch points at key threshold approach locations.
- b. Extended street improvement some improvements have been delivered recently
- c. Pavement improvements a recent Walkability Audit identified a number of locations where pavement improvements could be delivered




d) Improving links to, and facilities at, the railway station



This limits the spaces available to support local shops and services. Should some parking controls to introduced to help address this behaviour? 
g. Bunratty - Sixmilebridge - Shannon Greenway




h. New Town Park



- **p.** Develop Sixmilebridge as a trail head for walkers and cyclists better facilities to accommodate cycling and walking groups passing through







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
In this context, what uses do you think have the greatest potential to help bring land and premises back into use in Sixmilebridge?

With the local population of Sixmilebridge set to continue to grow, to what extent would you support improvements to local community and youth facilities in the town?



With the local population of Sixmilebridge set to continue to grow, which facilities do you consider to be most important?










Would you be pleased to see more festivals, markets and events in Sixmilebridge?

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
