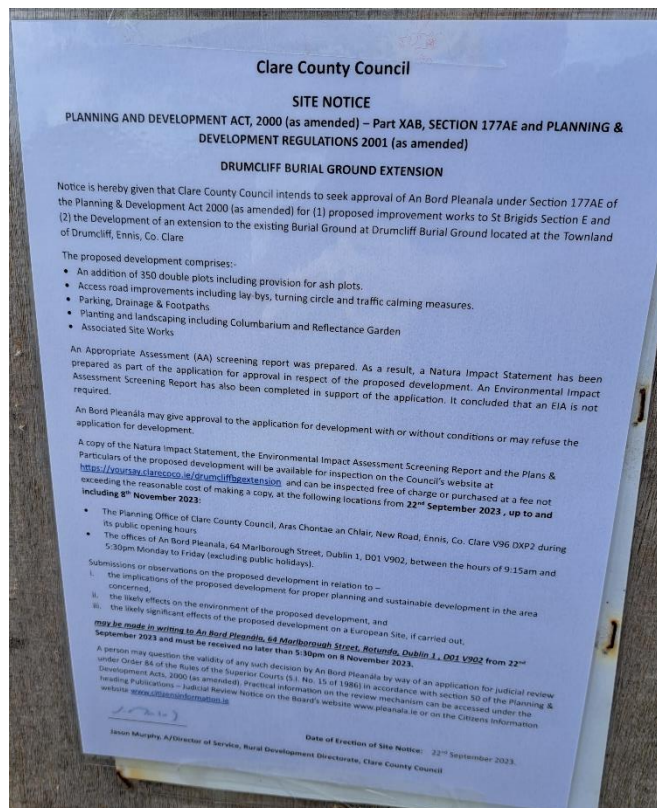
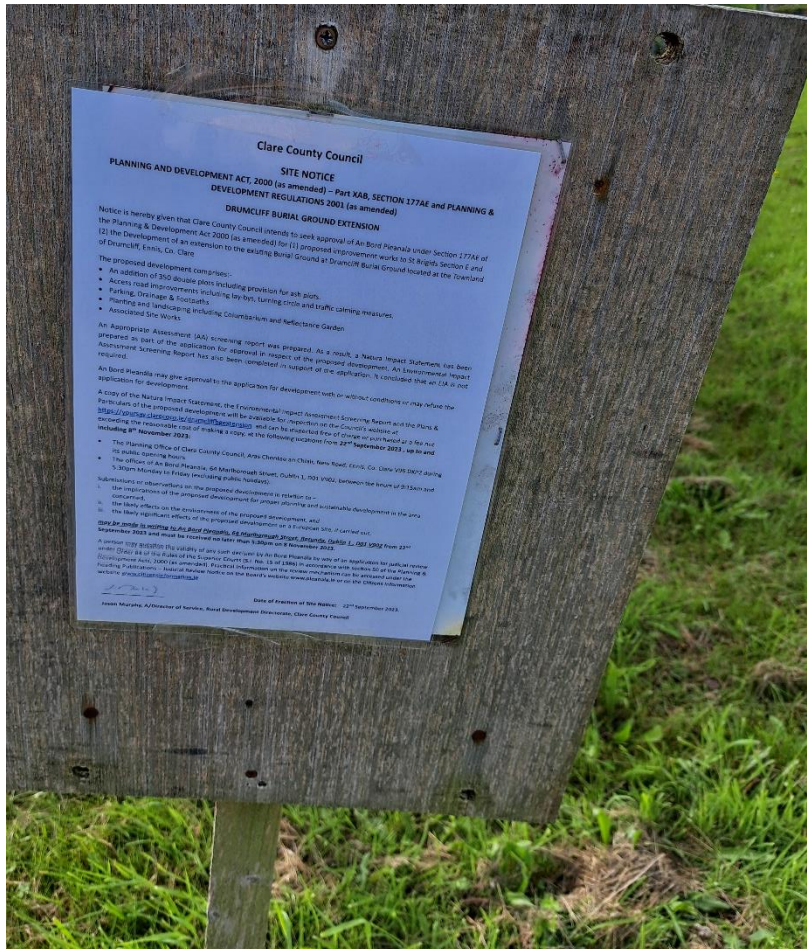


SITE NOTICE No. 1 at Entrance to Burial Ground

DRUNCLIFF BURIAL GROUND EXTENSION

Notice is hereby given that Clare County Council intends to seek approval of An Bord Pleanála under Section 177AE of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) for (1) proposed improvements to the existing burial ground at the Townland of Druncliff, Ennis, Co. Clare

The proposed development comprises:

- An addition of 300 grave plots including provision for ash plots.
- Access road improvements including lay bys, turning circles and traffic calming measures.
- Parking, Drainage & Footpaths
- Planting and Landscaping including Columbarium and Reflection Garden
- Associated Site-Works

An Assessment Assessment (AA) screening report was prepared. As a result, a Nature Impact Statement has been prepared as part of the application for approval in respect of the proposed development. An Environmental Impact Assessment Screening Report has also been completed in respect of the application. It concludes that an EIA or IEE application for approval is not required.

An Bord Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for development.

A copy of the Nature Impact Statement, the Environmental Impact Assessment Screening Report and the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) will be available for inspection at the Council's offices at Clare County Council, Ennis, Co. 1. The implications of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area concerned.
2. The likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
3. The likely significant effects of the proposed development on the environment.

Comments should be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála, 60 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1, D02 XN00 from 20th September 2023 and must be received no later than 12 noon on 27th September 2023.
