The Clare County Property Marking Scheme is part of a nationwide property marking programme which aims to **combat property theft** and assist in the identification and return of stolen property.

UNIQUE IDENTIFIERS CAN BE MARKED ONTO

- ✓ **Farm equipment**
- ✓ **Garage and garden tools**
- ✓ **Power tools**
- ✓ **Computers and electrical devices**
- ✓ **Equestrian equipment**
- ✓ **Golf clubs**
- ✓ **Musical instrument cases**
- ✓ **Bicycles**
- ✓ **And much more**

Where: Spanish Point Beach Car Park

When: Saturday 14 December 2019, 10am-4pm

What to bring: Your property, ID (i.e. Drivers Licence) or a unique identifier.



- The machine works by stamping your identification marking into the item to be marked, using a series of dots
- Property that is marked with identification is less attractive to thieves as it is difficult to sell and easier for An Garda Síochána to trace the owner
- **IT'S A FACT** - Property carrying permanent identification markings is less likely to be targeted by thieves
