1. Minutes of meeting held on 3rd July 2023.

3. Budget 2024

4. Any other business:

Pat Dowling provided updates on the following items:

 Moneypoint has signed a new licence agreement with government to make the output of Moneypoint available as an-out-of market generator of last resort from 2025 to 2029 and ESB will convert Moneypoint to run on oil for this period. This will involve the installation of additional storage tanks which will be subject to a planning process.

- The effective date for the transition to Uisce Éireann is 20th September 2023. Other than group water schemes the Council will not be in a position to report on water services in future monthly management reports to Council.
- Joe Cooney complimented staff and management who were involved in showcasing our county and supporting The KPMG Women's Irish Open. It was agreed by all that it was extremely successful and enjoyable event.
