The Cathaoirleach, Cllr. Joe Cooney opened the meeting.

Apologies from Cllr. Pat Burke for his absence.

Item 1 Election of Cathaoirleach for the next 12 months.

Cllr. Cooney reflected on the last year in Killaloe MD. He thanked the Engineers and Council Officials for their assistance over the past twelve months. He added it has been a fruitful twelve months with the co-operation of officials. Programs such as Holy Island, Tulla Housing Scheme, Killaloe bypass and roadworks were highlighted. Cllr.
